The Fightin Phils begin a series with the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. It is the seventh-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and first-of-nine at FirstEnergy Stadium. Reading and Somerset split the team's lone series in Somerset from Apr. 8-13. Following this week's split series, the Patriots return to Reading from Sept. 9-14 to finish off the 2025 season.

### Game 73 Recap

The Fightin Phils rode another wire-to-wire victory on Sunday, in a 5-3 win over Richmond on Sunday. It was the second-straight win for the R-Phils and marked their second series win of the season, with the other coming May 13-18, against New Hampshire. Jean Cabrera started and was stellar again, allowing one run on two hits over five innings, with three strikeouts. Aidan Miller had two doubles and Carson DeMartini drove in two runs. Dylan Campbell also hit his first Double-A double and drove in his first run since his promotion. After John McMillon allowed two runs in the sixth inning, Andrew Walling and Andrew Bechtold slammed the door shut in relief to secure the series-clinching victory. It was the first save of the season for Bechtold.

The Fightin Phils started the second half off on a strong note in Richmond last week. Reading started the clean slate with a 4-2 record, which marks the first time the R-Phils have been two games over .500 in any half of play since Al Pedrique took over as Manager prior to the 2023 season.

### The Ball was Flying in June

The Fightin Phils finished June with 29 home runs on the month, which was ranked as most in the Eastern League. Second place was this week's openent, Somerset, who hit 28 long balls. Reading racked up tons of extra-base hits in June, as they had the second-most doubles in the league at 50 and were tied for the

Newcomers Starting Strong
Both Dylan Campbell and Jose Rodriguez joined the Fightin Phils prior to last week's series in Richmond and had great starts to their Reading tenures. After goboth Dylan Campbel and 1968 Rodgriguez posted a .353 average (6-17) over the next five games of the week, which included a home run, three RBI and two stolen bases. Campbell has a hit in all five games he played in last week, and is hitting .313 (5-16) so far, with two stolen bases and a RBI.

Alex Binelas continued his recent surge with a two-run home run on Wednesday and another hit on Sunday. Since June 11 (16 games), Binelas is slashing .352/.406/.648 (1.054 OPS). He's added 12 runs, four doubles, four home runs and 17 RBI. Since June 11, Binelas holds the following Eastern League ranks: 6th AVG (.352), T-2nd HR (4), 1st RBI (17), 4th SLG (.648), 5th OPS (1.054) and T-7th TB (35).

Felix Reyes' impressive 2025 season continued with a very strong month of June. Over 18 June games, Reyes slashed .324/.360/.620 (.980 OPS), along with 14 runs, five doubles, two triples, four home runs and nine RBI, along with two stolen bases. Reyes struck out just nine times over 75 plate appearances (12%). Reyes's June Eastern League rankings: 7th ABG (.324), T-6th HR (4), 4th SLG (.620), 4th OPS (.980), T-5th 3B (2), T-5th XBH (11) and T-7th XBH (44).

### It's Miller Time

After not playing much the two weeks prior, Aidan Miller reuturned to the lineup and played in the final five games at Richmond last week. Miller is currently riding a 10-game on-base streak, dating back to June 7, which is the longest active on-base streak by a R-Phil. Miller hit a season-high two doubles on Sunday, which marked the fifth two-double game of his career, and first since May 17, 2024, when he was with Clearwater against Daytona Beach. After another stolen base Sunday, Miller sits at 27 stolen bases, which is alone in second place in both the Eastern League and Phillies organization.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

July 1, 2004: At Reading, Ryan Howard belts two more home runs while scoring three and driving in three as the Phils pound Binghamton, 12-6. It is Howard's 7th two-HR game of the season. All nine R-Phils position players have at least one hit and eight of them score a run.

### Sup Somerset

Somerset enters tonight with a 37-38 overall record, and 2-4 record in the second half, which is tied for fourth in the Eastern League. The Patriots dropped four-of-six games against Erie last week to begin the second half, winning on Thursday and Saturday. Following this week, Somerset remains home and welcomes New Hampshire. The Patriots roster has eight of the Yankee's Top-30 prospects: George Lombard (1), Chase Hampton (7), Brock Selvidge (8), Rafael Flores (15), Carlos Lagrange (17), Trystan Vrieling (22), Roc Riggio (24) and Bredan Jones (29).

Rigthy, and Yankee's No. 17 prospect, Carlos Lagrange makes the start tonight for Somerset. Between Hudson Valley (A+) and Somerset this season, Lagrange is 6-4, with a 4.72 ERA (32 ER, 61.0 IP). He has struck out 88 over 61.0 IP (12.98 SO/9.0 IP). He took the loss against Erie last Wednesday, allowing four runs and walking seven, across four innings of work. Against Jersey Shore on Apr. 29, Lagrange earned the win, allowing two runs over 5.2 IP, with eight strikeouts. Lagrange split 2024 between Tampa (A) and the FCL-Yankees (ROK), combining to go 0-1, with a 6.86 ERA over nine appearances. The 22-year old signed with the Yankees in 2022 as an International Free Agent out of the Domincan Republic
