GRAY HOMERS AGAIN, BUT SHRIMP FALL 6-2

Tristan Gray homered for the fifth game in a row, but the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp dropped a 6-2 contest on Saturday to the Durham Bulls. Tristan Peters homered on the first pitch of the bottom of the first and the Bulls added another run later in the inning. Niko Goodrum smacked a two-run shot in the third before Gray answered with a two-run bomb of his own in the fourth. However, Durham added a run in the fifth on Ronny Simon's RBI ground out and another in the seventh when Ruben Cardenas tripled and scored on a balk to make it 6-2.

GRAY'S ANATOMY

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Tristan Gray**, who played 331 games with the Durham Bulls from 2021-23, has been on a tear since returning to the Bull City. The Missouri City, Texas native has homered in five consecutive games, the longest such streak for a Jacksonville hitter since **Peter O'Brien** went yard in six straight games from June 6-11, 2018. Against Durham, Gray is a combined 8-for-21 (.381) with a double, five home runs, eight RBIs, one walk and six runs scored. During his career with the Bulls, Gray batted .233/.300/.474/.774 with 59 doubles, five triples, 71 home runs. 220 RBIs and 179 runs scored.

THE CHICKS DIG IT

It took into the club's second series of the year to hit their first home run, but Jacksonville has launched eight bombs through five games in Durham. In 2023, the Jumbo Shrimp finished in the bottom of the IL in home runs (T-15, 160). Historically, Jacksonville has clobbered more home runs on the road since rejoining Triple-A prior to the 2021 campaign (82 vs 78 in '23, 109 vs 74 in '22 and 81 vs 55 in '21).

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Outside of a 10-0 loss to Gwinnett on March 31 and a 6-2 defeat to Durham on Saturday, all six of Jacksonville's contests in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp have gone 4-2 in those affairs thus far. Last season, 85 of the club's 149 games (57.0 percent) were determined by no more than three runs, with the club going 39-46 (.459) in those contests. Prior to that, Jacksonville had been over .500 in games decided by three runs or fewer in every season from 2019-22.

RAGING BULL

Dating back to last season, 13 of the last 17 games between Jacksonville and Durham have been decided by three runs or fewer. The clubs have nearly split these matchups decided by razor-thin margins, with the Jumbo Shrimp winning seven of those 13 closely-decided contests. From when the Jumbo Shrimp and Bulls first began playing each other in 2021 until this current 17-game stretch began on May 31, 2023, 33 of the 66 matchups between the clubs were decided by three runs or fewer. Jacksonville went 15-18 (.455) against Durham in those affairs.

SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through eight games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered only 30 runs, in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. Thus far during the 2024 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are a woeful 13-for-73 (.178/.307/.329/.636, ranking 29th, 29th, 24th and 28th, respectively, in Triple-A) hitting with runners in scoring position, stranding a total of 59 runners. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just .247/.336/.400/.736 with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th, 27th and 29th in Triple-A.

TROY MEETS WORLD

Jumbo Shrimp first baseman **Troy Johnston** is coming off an extraordinary season that saw him earn Marlins Minor League Player of the Year. Johnston finished the season leading all of Minor League Baseball in RBIs (116) while ranking fourth in extra-base hits (67), ninth in hits (157), tied for 10th in runs (102), 13th in OPS (.948), tied for 15th in doubles (36) and 17th in slugging percentage (.549). Over 134 games between Jacksonville and Double-Pensacola, Johnston slashed .307/.399/.549/.948 with 26 home runs and 24 stolen bases, becoming the first Marlins minor leaguer since 2008 to post a season with at least 20 homers and 20 steals.

SHRIMP BITES

Of the 16 innings Jacksonville in which has scored in this season, nine have been multi-run frames... A win on Sunday will net the Jumbo Shrimp their first series win of the year. Jacksonville has won their first road set in each of the last three seasons.

ABOUT BRAXTON

-The Miami Marlins' first-round pick in 2016, Garrett made his professional debut in 2017 but lasted just four starts until an injured elbow forced him to undergo Tommy John Surgery. Garrett went under the knife on June 20, 2017 and missed the rest of the 2017 campaign, as well as the entirety of the 2018 season. While rehabbing, however, he roomed with fellow Marlins prospect Jordan Holloway, who had underwent Tommy John Surgery just five days before Garrett did so.

-Garrett began his high school career at Foley High School in Alabama. However, he moved to Florence when his father. Steve, became the Florence Falcons' head baseball coach

-Under the tutelage of his father, Garrett was named Alabama's Mr. Baseball as a junior and the state's Gatorade Player of the Year and a first team USA Today All-American as a senior, when he posted a 0.53 ERA with 131 strikeouts in 65.1 innings.

2024 SEASON

-Began rehab assignment from a left shoulder impingement on April 5 for Jacksonville.

2023 SEASON

-Garrett began the 2023 season as a long reliever but joined the Marlins starting rotation in April 2023 after Johnny Cueto injured his right biceps.

-Right-handed hitters batted .261/.300/.448/.748 against him in 503 plate appearances, but Garrett held left-handed batters to a .211/.276/.324/.600 line in 156 plate appearances.

2022 SEASON

-In the major leagues, right-handed hitters batted .280/.346/.455/.801 against him in 284 plate appearances. However, Garrett held southpaws to a .173/.247/.235/.482 mark in 90 plate appearances.

2021 SEASON

-Garrett was promoted on May 15 to Miami. He made a three-inning relief appearance that night at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles before being optioned back to Jacksonville the following day. The Marlins have recalled and optioned Garrett several more times throughout the 2021 season

-Garrett's best major league start came on July 24 against San Diego, a game in which he yielded just two runs on four hits in 7.0 innings with 10 strikeouts against one walk.

2020 SEASON

-Garrett made his major league debut for the Marlins in game two of a doubleheader on September 13, 2020 against the Philadelphia Phillies. He ceded just one run on three hits in five innings, striking out six against two walks.

-The southpaw made one additional MLB start one week later, in the backend of a doubleheader against the Washington Nationals. However, Garrett surrendered five runs, four earned, on five hits and three walks in 2.2 frames.
