History vs. South Bend

The Lugnuts are 205-184 all-time vs. South Bend, 96-85 in Lansing and 109-99 in The Bend. Last year, the Lugnuts went 2-4 at Four Winds Field... but in the series finale, the Nuts' last road game of the year, September 4, Jorge Juan, Jack Owen, Shohei Tomioka and Osvaldo Berrios combined on a 2-1 no-hit win, the third no-hitter in franchise history.

Tonight: The Lugnuts play the fifth game in a six-game series with the Cubs, the only meetings of the year for Lansing with the defending Midwest League champions. The two teams have split the first four games, with the Nuts riding crucial late home runs from **Max Muncy** and **Danny Bautista, Jr.** to wins on Tuesday and Friday respectively.

Last Night: Lugnuts 5, Cubs 4. **Danny Bautista, Jr.** broke a 4-4 tie in the top of the eighth with a two-out blast to deep left, his first home run of the year, and **Tyler Baum** sewed up a four-out save finished off by the fourth double play of the game turned against South Bend, disappointing the crowd of 7,037.

Starting Matchup: Nuts right-hander **Jack Perkins**, a native of Kokomo (87 miles due south), the Athletics' fifth-round selection in 2022 and No. 30 prospect, makes his 10th appearance and ninth start of the year, opposed by South Bend right-hander **Manuel Espinoza**, making his seventh appearance and sixth start. Espinoza made 17 appearances for the Cubbies last year, but none against the Lugnuts.

On the Air: Today's game is available on Bally Live and MiLB TV with **Brendan King** and **Max Thoma**, and via StreamGuys with **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** and **Adam Jaksa** on the call.

On Deck: The Lugnuts and Cubs wrap things up tomorrow, and then the Nuts return to Lansing to welcome in the Peoria Chiefs for a six-game homestand running from June 13-18.

LUG•NOTES

Pitcher's Best Friend: With four double plays yesterday, the Nuts tied the West Michigan Whitecaps with 48 double plays turned this season, tying for first in the Midwest League.

Locking it Down: With a four-out save yesterday, right-hander **Tyler Baum** is now 6-for-6 in save chances this season, tying the former UNC Tar Heel for the second most saves in the Midwest League. His six saves also lead the entire Athletics organization.

Among the MWL Leaders: Outfielder **Jonny Butler** is second in the Midwest League with five triples. Starting pitcher **Jack Perkins** is second in the league with a .188 batting average allowed, second with a 1.03 WHIP, third with a 2.89 ERA, and 11th with 46 2/3 innings pitched. Catcher **Daniel Susac** is tied for third with 55 hits and sixth with a .297 batting average. Outfielder **Junior Pérez** is ninth with 13 steals.

Master Noda: The No. 2 pick in the 2022 Rule 5 Draft, 2018 Lugnut **Ryan Noda** is leading the American League with a .410 on-base percentage in his rookie season (fourth in the Majors behind only Luis Arraez, Lamonte Wade, Jr., and Juan Soto), and ranks second in the A.L. with 43 walks (tied for sixth in the Majors). At this time, he is the likely Oakland Athletics representative for the All-Star Game in Seattle. Noda's magical year began when he made his MLB debut on his birthday, March 30. His time in Lansing was notable five years ago for setting the franchise's single season walks record at 109.

Don't Forget About Bo: 2017 Nut **Bo Bichette** leads the Major Leagues in total bases (145) and base hits (90) and ranks fourth in batting average (.324)

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 22-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); **Euribiel Angeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); **Junior Pérez** (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo); and **Alexander Campos** (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17, for Ryon Healy).

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2012: Lake County SS Francisco Lindor enjoyed his finest game against the Lugnuts, going 3-for-5 with a caught stealing in the Nuts' 4-1 victory in Lansing. The future MLB star finished the season hitting .266 (17-for-64) with only two extra-base hits, both doubles, against the Lugnuts, and was just 1-for-4 stealing bases.

2018: In one of the worst shutout losses in franchise history, the Fort Wayne TinCaps steamrolled the Lugnuts, 15-0, in a 19-hit attack on Sunday afternoon at Parkview Field. 'Caps southpaw MacKenzie Gore, the No. 3 pick in the 2017 draft, started and pitched two scoreless innings, issuing a walk and hitting a batter.

2019: The Lugnuts tied a Midwest League record (set by Peoria in Lansing on May 3, 2017), plunking six Lake County Captains – three apiece by Josh Hiatt and Mike Pascoe – in a 10-4 loss at Classic Park.

In a Nutshell: One of five 2022 draftees on the roster, joining Daniel Susac, Clark Elliott, Jacob Watters and Jake Garland... scouted and signed by Rich Sparks, who also was responsible for scouting/signing Lugnuts teammates Clark Elliott and Mariano Ricciardi and such other notables as Max Schuemann (promoted to Triple-A Las Vegas), Blake Beers (promoted to Double-A Midland) Jeff Criswell (traded in the offseason to Colorado) and Jack Weisenburger... unrelated to former Phillies MiLB pitcher of the same name who split 2022 between Lehigh Valley and Reading... agent is Sam Samardzija, Jeff "Shark" Samardzija's brother... has over 40 family members and friends attending today's game.

Prospecting: Moved into the No. 30 slot on the A's MLB Pipeline Top 30 Prospects list; fastball 60, curve 50, cutter 50, control 40, overall 40... the summation: "After a solid high school career in Indiana and being taken late in the 2018 Draft by the Braves, Perkins first went to Louisville to continue his amateur pitching career. After two years of flashes of stuff without command, he moved to Indiana for the 2022 season. Better feel for the strike zone improved his stock and landed him in the fifth round with the A's. He had a brief summer debut and went to High-A Lansing, getting off to a strong start, as he began his pro career in earnest in 2023."

Glory Days: Starred at Kokomo High School, batting .525 as a senior while being ranked Perfect Game's No. 2 prospect in the state of Indiana and No. 1 right-handed pitcher and No. 61 overall in the nation.... all-state running back for Kokomo Wildkats football, earning three letters... taken in the 39th round by Atlanta, but elected to attend college instead.

Study Skills: Posted a 4.42 GPA in high school, graduating fifth in his class... graduated in three years from the University of Louisville, earning double major in finance and marketing, before pursuing business management in grad school at Indiana.

Life in Louisville: Pitched in 2019 and 2021 for the Cardinals... overall as a freshman, posted 4.18 ERA in 16 appearances, four starts, spanning 32 1/3 innings, with 18 walks and 37 strikeouts... missed 2020 due to undergoing Tommy John; suffered UCL tear while pitching against Clemson in the 2019 ACC Tournament... returned in 2021 and struggled, with 7.31 ERA in 11 games (1 start) over 16 innings, walking 22 and whiffing only 15.

Off to Bloomington: Transferred to Indiana in order to work with pitching coach Justin Parker, but Parker left for South Carolina the week after Perkins transferred in... ended up instead working with Dustin Glant, who had been the pitching coach at NYY Triple-A affiliate Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, whom he credits for his development... opened as the no. 2 starter for the Hoosiers in 2022, but moved into the Friday night role for Big Ten play, going 3-4 with a 5.10 ERA in 16 games, team-leading 15 starts... in a team-leading 83 innings, gave up only six homers and struck out 91 while walking 47, hitting 21 batters and tossing 12 wild pitches... 91 strikeouts ranks 10th highest all-time in school history... recorded six quality starts.

Draft Day: Selected with the 154th pick of the 2022 draft, Oakland's fifth-round selection and second pitcher taken (after fourth-rounder Jacob Watters)... signed for \$270,750... highest of three Indiana Hoosiers selected in the draft (12th-rounder Bradley Brehmer and 20th-rounder Reese Sharp, both to the Orioles)... the last impactful Indiana Hoosier to reach the Majors was Kyle Schwarber, taken fourth overall in 2014.

Pro Debut: Made Minor League Baseball debut on August 6, 2022, in the Arizona Complex League, striking out three while allowing two hits and one run in one inning at the Cubs... worked with catcher Daniel Susac; fellow Lugnut Caeden Trenkle was in right field and leading off in the game... six days later, made Stockton debut with two scoreless innings at San Jose, the first of three straight two-inning scoreless appearances for the Ports in which Perkins allowed only one hit, walked none, and struck out seven in total... whiffed four Giants in two innings on September 2 in fourth Stockton appearance before allowing two runs on two hits and two walks in one inning on September 8 at Modesto, his final appearance of the year... runners attempted two steals and were caught once... lefties hit .182 (2-for-11, 0 BB, 4 K) and righties hit .150 (3-for-20, 2 BB, 7 K).
