New England Double

The Fightin Phils remain in New England and continue a six-game series at the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays, on Thursday night. It is the 8th-of-17 matchups between the teams this season, and eighth-of-11 in Manchester. The Fisher Cats come to Reading for their lone series in Baseballtown from Aug. 13-18. Reading currenly leads the season-series over New Hampshire 5-2.

Double The Shutouts

The Fightin Phils picked up their second-straight shutout with a 7-0 win over New Hampshire on Wednesday afternoon. Matt Osterberg led the charge with five-scoreless innings, earning himself his third win. Dominic Pipkin and Carlos Francisco each tossed a scoreless inning behind Osterberg, and Cristian Hernandez posted zeroes across the final two frames. Carson Taylor and Cade Fergus each hit solo homers to make it 2-0 Reading. Then in the eighth, the Fightin Phils batted around of the seventh time this season, as they sent 10 to the plate, scoring five runs and getting a season-high eight hits in an inning in the frame.

About Yesterda

With their victory yesterday, the Fightin Phils have now won four-straight games, which matches a season-high. Additionally, everyone in the Reading lineup posted a base hit, marking the first time everyone in the linup had a hit since May 5, 2023, at Hartford.

Posting Zeroes

With their win yesterday, the Fightin Phils have posted nine-inning shutouts in back-to-back games. It was also the sixth shutout of the season for Reading, which by far and away surpasses last season's total of three. The last time Reading posted back-to-back nine-inning shutouts was from July 12-13 of 2022, against New Hampshire. Dating back to 2005, Reading has not had a shutout in three-straight games. Additionally, Reading piching has not allowed a run in 22-straight innings, which is a season best, and also their longest scoreless-inning streak since also going 22 in a row scoreless from July 10-14, 2022. Dating back to 2005, Reading's longest scoreless-inning streak was 24 innings from Aug. 19-22, of the 2013 season.

Swiper Yes Swiping

The Fightin Phils blew away a season high Tuesday night with nine stolen bases. Dating back to 2005, no Reading team had stolen nine bases in a game. Their previous team-high was six, which they did twice on Apr. 14, 2013 and May 16, 2023. Gabriel Rincones Jr. led the way with a career-high three stolen bases, which is also the most stolen bases by a R-Phils' player this season. The last time a Fightin Phil stole three bases in a game was Johan Rojas on June 20, 2023, at Portland. Carson Taylor also matched a season, and career-high, with two stolen bases, while Justin Crawford had two as well. Reading additioanlly pulled off two double steals in the ballgame.

Into The Wishing Well

Lachlan Wells was spectacular on the mound once again on Tuesday night. He tossed his second-straight outing of seven innings and no runs allowed. Wells matched a career-high with 11 strikeouts, with the last time he set that mark was on Sept. 1, 2016, with Cedar Rapids in the Twins system. It was just the third time in Wells' career he struck out 10+ batters in a game. With back-to-back seven-shutout innings outings, Wells has now not allowed a run in 14-straight innings. For the month of July, Wells is now 3-0, with a 1.44 ERA over four starts. Wells currently leads the Eastern League with a 1.03 WHIP, is seventh with a 3.55 ERA and 10th with 91.1 IP. He is second in the league in strikeout-to-walk ratio at 7.00. The only pitcher with a better stikeout-to-walk ratio than Wells in teammate Robinson Pina, who is at 7.42.

This Day in Baseballtown History

July 25, 2012: At Reading, the R-Phils (5-18 in July to that point) get a much-needed win over Altoona with some help from Cody Asche and Jonathan Pettibone. Asche goes 3-for-4 with 2 homers and 4 RBIs while Pettibone picks up the victory in his final start for Reading, giving up just 1 run on 3 hits while striking out 6.

Scouting the Fisher Cats

New Hampshire enters tonight after finishing in sixth place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division for the first half with a 30-38 record. They are sixth in the Northeast Division with a 4-17 record in the second half of the season. New Hampshire most recently dropped two-of-three at Harrisburg. Following this week, Portland heads to Binghamton. New Hampshire's roster features seven players ranked amongst the Toronto Blue Jays' top-30 prospects: Adam Macko (9), Josh Kasevich (11), Cade Doughty (13), CJ Van Eyk (16), Dahian Santos (20), Alex De Jesus (22) and T.J. Brock (28).

Fisher Cat Pitche

Righty Deveraux Harrison makes the start tonight for New Hampshire. This season, Harrison is 4-5, with a 4.25 ERA over 17 starts (82.2 IP, 70 H, 41 BB, 71 SO). In his last start July 19 at Harrisburg, Harrison took the win, going six-shutout innings with 10 strikeouts. Against Reading on June 18, he took the win, allowing three runs over five innings, with six strikeouts. He spent last season with High-A Vancouver, going 5-5, with a 2.95 ERA over 26 games/16 starts. He split 2022 between Single-A Dunedin and Vancouver in his first pro season. Toronto drafted the 23-year old out of Long Beach State in the ninth round in 2022.
