JACKSONVILLE SWEEPS NASHVILLE WITH 2-1 WIN

Andrew Pintar's go-ahead two-run single in the sixth inning coupled with outstanding pitching on Sunday helped Jacksonville sweep Nashville with a 2-1 win. After the Sounds scored a run two batters into the bottom of the first, the game remained 1-0 until the sixth. Pintar lined a two-out, two-run single to put the Jumbo Shrimp in front. Five Jacksonville relievers combined for 5.1 hitless innings to seal the victory. During the six-game sweep, the Jumbo Shrimp outscored the Sounds by a 37-11 margin to take the season series 12-3.

NOBODY'S HOTTER...

The Jumbo Shrimp have now won seven in a row and 12 of their last 13 contests, pushing their overall record to 71-42. Thus, Jacksonville has climbed 29 games over .500 for the first time since September 4, 2006, when the Jacksonville Suns concluded that campaign with an 86-54 record. The Jumbo Shrimp are coming off their fourth sweep of the season, the first time a Jacksonville club has recorded four sweeps in a campaign in the club's recorded history (since at least 2005). If Jacksonville wins Tuesday, it would mark the first campaign in recorded club history with three separate winning streaks of at least eight games.

GUNS AND SHIPS, AND SO THE BALANCE SHIFTS

Dating back to their July 27 contest at Durham, Jacksonville has won 12 of the last 13 games in mostly dominant fashion. During this stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp have out-hit their opponents 116-79, out-homered them 16-10 and earned 67 walks and hit-by-pitches compared to 35 for their opponents. It has added up to a massive 78-35 advantage in run differential over these 13 games.

THE MORE, THE MERRIER

In 2024, Jacksonville shattered the city's previous Double-A/ Triple-A era (1962-present) record of 20 different starting pitchers over the course of the season and used 28 different starters in 149 games. Meanwhile, through 113 games this season, the Jumbo Shrimp have already tied that record by using 28 different starting pitchers. Perhaps unsurprisingly, Jacksonville starting pitchers have totaled just 441.2 innings (3.9 per start) this season, the third-fewest in Triple-A. That said, their 3.59 starters' ERA ranks second at the level.

IT GETS LATE EARLY

Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have worked 543.2, or 55.2 percent, of the club's 985.1 innings this season. Despite the huge workload, which marks the third-most innings of any bullpen in Triple-A, Jacksonville relievers have posted the level's best ERA (3.56) and BAA (.209). Over the last 18 games, the club's bullpen has worked 88.2 innings (4.9 per game), yielding only 25 runs, 23 earned, on 48 hits (4.9 H/9) for a 2.33 ERA (104 K, 10.6 K/9, 29 BB, 2.9 BB/9).

MEN OF STEAL

Over the last three seasons, Jacksonville ranked 23rd, 21st and 29th, respectively, in Triple-A in stolen bases. The club's 226 this season not only lead the entire level, but they rank seventh in all of Minor League Baseball. Of the top 22 MiLB teams in steals, only two are Triple-A or Double-A teams (Jacksonville & Nashville, 217, 11th). The Jumbo Shrimp's 226 steals are the most in a campaign for any Jacksonville team in the club's Double-A/Triple-A era (1962-present). No Jacksonville club has finished in the top five in their respective level in steals since at least 2005.

THE CHICKS DIG IT

Over the first 63 games of the season, Jacksonville cracked only 52 home runs, tied for the 26th-most in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp have blasted 72 round-trippers over the last 50 games since June 10, the third-most in Triple-A during this span. Jacksonville has plated at least four runs in 35 of these 50 games, a rate of 70.0 percent. In comparison, the Jumbo Shrimp had plated four runs or more in just 30 of their first 63 games (47.6 percent).

SO, BABY, PULL ME CLOSER

The Jumbo Shrimp are a remarkable 46-22 (.672) in games decided by three runs or fewer this season, by far the most such wins in Triple-A (the closest team has 42 such victories). In one-run affairs, Jacksonville is 24-9, the most such wins in Triple-A and just one behind Montgomery's 25 for the most in MiLB.

SHRIMP BITES

Patrick Monteverde has yielded three runs or fewer in 17 of his 19 outings this season... The Jumbo Shrimp are 8-1 in the month of August.

ABOUT PATRICK

-Monteverde is the youngest child from a massive family. He is the youngest of 27 grandchildren on his dad's side and the youngest of 18 grandchildren on his mom's side. Both of Monteverde's parents are the youngest of twelve.

-A native of Pittsburgh, Monteverde started his collegiate baseball career at Division III Virginia Wesleyan (Norfolk, Va.) for a season, posting a 1.96 ERA in 82 2/3 innings. In 2018, he moved up a rung, transferring to Division II Seton Hill in Greensburg, Pennsylvania, about 45 minutes from Monteverde's home. He had a solid first year there in 2018 (3.04 ERA), but three starts into his second season with the Griffins, he heard a pop in his elbow and underwent Tommy John surgery. Monteverde made just one more start for Seton Hill in 2020 before the COVID pandemic then shut down the season for him.

-Monteverde completed his collegiate career by transferring to Texas Tech University for the 2021 season. He went 7-4 with a 3.75 ERA, leading the Red Raiders in wins, starts (16), innings pitched (86.1) and strikeouts (101).

2025 SEASON

-Monteverde made his major league debut on April 19 for the Marlins in a game at the Philadelphia Phillies. He pitched 3.2 innings, striking out four.

2024 SEASON

-Held left-handed batters to a .247/.286/.425/.711 line in 158 plate appearances. However, right-handed hitters slashed .264/.340/.508/.848 against him in 335 plate appearances.

-With the bases empty, opponents had a .227/.288/.433/.721 batting line against Monteverde. However, with runners on, that swelled to .314/.383/.566/.949.

2023 SEASON

-Monteverde was promoted to Jacksonville on July 25 from Double-A Pensacola. At the time of his promotion, he led the Southern League in wins (8), ERA (2.44) and WHIP (1.11) while ranking second in both innings pitched (84.2) and batting average against (.207), tied for eighth in strikeouts (90) and tied for 14th in games started (14).

-Made 21 total starts with Pensacola in 2022. Led team in wins (10), innings pitched (114.0), strikeouts (114), double plays (T-1st, 11).

-Monteverde's favorite pitcher growing up was Clayton Kershaw.

-His favorite book is "To Kill a Mockingbird" and favorite movie is "American Pie."
