TIME TO RESET After winning the first two games of the series with Lynchburg last week and dropping the final four in a row, including a 15-5 loss on Sunday, the FredNats hit the road again to face a familiar foe, the Delmarva Shorebirds. This is the first meeting of 18 scheduled meetings this year between the two Carolina League North rivals whose parent clubs make up the Beltway Series. RHP Bryan Polanco makes the first of two scheduled starts this week against the Shorebirds, and will look to build on his best start of the season last week against Lynchburg in which he pitched a season-long six innings of one-run ball. In a scheduling quirk, Polanco has also been the starting pitcher for all three 11:05 am games the FredNats have played this year. Polanco faces Delmarva lefty Luis De Leon, who is rehabbing with the Shorebirds from High-A Aberdeen. Fredericksburg was previously undefeated against left-handed starters this year prior to last week, when the team lost two games against southpaw starters. Today's game is the 33rd of the FredNat season, which marks the halfway point of the first half and means that the regular season will be 25% of the way done after the game.

ABOUT LAST GAME: Jorgelys Mota had two doubles and three RBIs, but the FredNat pitching staff was bitten by the walk bug on Sunday, issuing 12 walks and two hit-by-pitches in a 15-5 loss to the Hillcats in the series finale. Lynchburg sent 14 men to the plate and scored seven runs in the top of the 9th inning to pull away in what was otherwise a competitive game.

LET'S DO THIS AGAIN: The 2024 Carolina League Champion FredNat squad absolutely obliterated the Shorebirds all of last season. In 21 meetings between the two teams last year, Fredericksburg went a staggering 18-3 and outscored Delmarva 120-62. The FredNat pitching staff had a team ERA of 2.58 against the Shorebirds, and struck out a total of 199 Delmarva hitters. In 192 innings pitched against Delmarva, the Shorebirds only had 137 hits compared to Fredericksburg's 164. Fredericksburg also went 44/49 stealing bases against Delmarva last year.

NIGHT AND DAY DIFFERENCE: In the first two games of last week's series, the FredNats outscored the Hillcats 14-1 and outthit Lynchburg 23-6. In the four losses to finish the week, the FredNats scored a total of 12 runs. The team batting average the last four games is .212 and the team OPS is .569. The Freddie managed just seven extra base hits in those four losses.

HE'S A SLUGGER: FredNat infielder Jackson Ross leads the Carolina League in slugging after his fifth and sixth homers in Wednesday's game, and he continues to be near the top of the league leadeboard in several other categories. Ross is slugging .586 on the season, and his .946 OPS ranks fourth in the league and is eleventh in all of Single-A. Ross is also second on the FredNat team with seven doubles on the year.

DON'T EVEN TRY IT: The FredNat catching duo of Kevin Bazzell and Nate Rombach have been prolific at throwing out potential base stealers to start the season. Bazzell is throwing out 40% of base runners this year which is first in all of Single-A baseball among qualified catchers, and he ranks sixth in MiLB with 13 caught stealings. Rombach has 11 caught stealings, which is 17th in all of MiLB at any level. Lynchburg is second in MiLB as a team stealing bases, and they only have four stolen bases through the first three games of this series.

STREAKY: Nate Ochoa's single in the 1st inning Sunday extended his hitting streak to 10 games, which is the longest hitting streak of the season for a FredNat. Ochoa blasted his first home run of the season last Sunday in Salem, an opposite field three-run shot off the scoreboard in right center field. In the month of May, Ochoa is hitting .328 with a .879 OPS.

2024 CHAMPIONS: The 2024 Fredericksburg Nationals won the franchise's sixth total Carolina League championship last September, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to capture the crown. It was the franchise's first since moving to Fredericksburg in 2020, and the first since the Potomac Nationals won the Carolina League in 2014. The FredNats broke the Charleston RiverDogs' run of three titles in a row, and became the first non-Charleston team to win the league since MiLB realigned to its current leagues in 2021.

NEW SKIPPER IN TOWN: After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. Prior to joining the Nationals, he coached for over a decade in the Boston organization, managing at all four full-season levels and also spending three seasons (2016-18) as the organization's base running and outfield coordinator. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024.

GOT THE BALL: Polanco got the nod to start on Opening Day this year after making 22 appearances and 17 starts for the FredNats in 2024. His 17 games started tied for the 3rd most by any Fredericksburg pitcher last year and the most of any returning FredNat on the Opening Day roster this year.

LAST TIME OUT: Polanco had the FredNats’ longest start of the year in the Lynchburg series. He matched a career high with 6.0 IP, allowing just two hits and one run. Both of his six-inning starts in his career have come against the Hillcats.

TOUGH TO PICK UP: Polanco gave up 89 hits in 93.0 innings pitched last year, fewer than a hit an inning. Opponents hit .255 against the FredNat righthander. In his last three starts this year, Polanco has allowed just five hits in 15 full innings. Across the last three weeks, his five hits allowed are tied for the second fewest among all MiLB pitchers with at least 15.0 IP and fewest among Single-A pitchers.

AGAINST DELMARVA: Polanco has logged 34.1 IP in his career against the Shorebirds, allowing 14 total earned runs. One of those starts, however, was just 1.1 IP with seven earned runs. Outside of that start, Polanco has dominated Delmarva to the tune of a 1.91 ERA.

BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER

#41

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.



JUSTIN LORD - PITCHING COACH

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

1st Season | Previously: Manager, FCL Nationals

Ordez, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordez has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
