YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Baysox, 5-3, in 11 innings. **Sean Roby** drove in the game's first run in the first inning with an RBI single. The Baysox tied the game, 1-1, with an RBI single by Donta' Williams in the sixth. In the eighth, Bowie jumped ahead, 2-1, with Jackson Holliday scoring on a wild pitch. **Donovan Walton** evened the score, 2-2, with a two-out single in the eighth inning. In the top of the 10th, Holliday moved the Baysox ahead with an RBI single, but **Ismael Munguia** tied the game, 3-3, with a two-out single in the bottom of the 10th. In the 11th, Bowie scored two runs with an RBI single by Silas Ardoin and an RBI double by Maxwell Costes to pull ahead, 5-3, and held Richmond off the board in the bottom of the winning.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. The two teams met for a six-game set in Harrisburg from April 11-14, with the Senators winning four-of-six, including three games by one run. The Flying Squirrels won five-of-six at The Diamond from June 20-25 to close the first half. Richmond dropped two-of-three in Harrisburg from July 14-16 coming out of the All-Star Break. Richmond is 1-2 against the Senators in the second half and 3-1 in its last four series-opening games.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 27-19 in their last 45 games since June 18 but they are 3-7 in their last 10 games, including dropping the final three games of last week's series against the Baysox. Over the last 51 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined for a 2.93 ERA (63 ER/193.2 IP) and have allowed 14 home runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.80 ERA is second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 395.0 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 537.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.63 ERA, which is the fourth-lowest in Double-A and the 10th-lowest of the 120 full-season teams in the minors.

THE SENATORS are 12-3 in their last 15 games dating back to July 28, including going 5-1 against the RubberDucks at FNB Field last week. They have won four consecutive series. Since July 28, they are leading the Eastern League with a .297 batting average (153-for-516) and with 94 runs scored (6.3 runs per game). Harrisburg's roster includes nine of Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects, including OF James Wood (No. 2, No. 7 overall), SS Brady House (No. 3, No. 63 overall), OF Robert Hassell III (No. 4), 3B Trey Lipscomb (No. 15), RHP Cole Henry (No. 17), C Israel Pineda (No. 21), OF Jacob Young (No. 24), LHP DJ Herz (No. 25) and LHP Mitchell Parker (No. 30). MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospect list includes nine Harrisburg players, including Wood (No. 2, No. 7 overall), House (No. 3, No. 43 overall), Hassell (No. 8), Lipscomb (No. 14), Herz (No. 16), Henry (No. 19), Pineda (No. 22), Parker (No. 26) and Young (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Spencer Bivens** makes the fourth start of his affiliated professional career. He last pitched on Wednesday against the Baysox and allowed one run over 3.1 innings, holding Bowie hitless and tying his career high with six strikeouts. In his three starts with Richmond, Bivens has a 0.87 ERA (1 ER/10.1 IP) and two of those games have resulted in shut-outs. He has pitched against the Senators three times, all out of the bullpen, with an 18.00 ERA (8 ER/4.0 IP). Bivens was born in Virginia Beach but grew up mostly in State College, Pa. After high school, he spent two seasons at Louisburg College in North Carolina before transferring to Rogers State in Oklahoma for his final two collegiate seasons. Bivens spent 2019 pitching for Lions de Savigny of French Division 1, an eight-team league in France that plays a 28-game schedule from March through October. He had signed to play for Kotlárka Praha in the Czech Baseball Extraliga before the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020. Bivens was pitching for the Lemont Ducks of the Centre County League in the 2020 summer before joining a four-team, independent pod league in Washington, Pa. After pitching for the independent Washington Wild Things, West Virginia Power and Gastonia Honey Hunters for parts of two seasons, he was signed by the Giants in May 2022. Last fall, he pitched in the Arizona Fall League and was named to the Fall Stars team. *For more on Bivens, see page two.*

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Michael Cuevas makes his 18th start of the season and his third against Richmond. Last time out, he threw four hitless, scoreless innings against the RubberDucks last Wednesday in Harrisburg. He has not allowed a run over 6.2 innings in August, spanning two starts. Over his previous four starts from June 18-July 6, he went 0-3 with a 6.63 ERA (13 ER/17.2 IP). Cuevas did not pitch from July 7 through August 3. Cuevas made his Double-A debut on April 12 against the Flying Squirrels in Harrisburg and allowed five runs (four earned) over three innings. He pitched at The Diamond on June 24 and allowed two runs over five innings in a no-decision. Cuevas was selected by the Nationals in the 23rd round in 2019 out of Brennan High School in Texas.

STARTING STRONG: Against the Curve on the last road trip beginning August 1, Richmond starting pitchers opened the set throwing 20 innings without allowing a run until the third inning on August 5. Flying Squirrels starters have a 2.09 ERA (11 ER/47.1 IP) over the last 11 games since August 2. In that stretch, **Carson Seymour** is 1-0 with a 0.61 ERA (1 ER/14.2 IP), **Spencer Bivens** has a 1.23 ERA (1 ER/7.1 IP) and **John Michael Bertrand** has a 0.90 ERA (1 ER/10.0 IP). **Wil Jensen** also threw four scoreless innings in his start on August 10.

PLAYOFF CHASE: With 30 games remaining in the regular season, the Flying Squirrels are tied for second place the Southwest Division Second-Half standings, one game behind Erie SeaWolves, who have already clinched a spot in the postseason by winning the division's first half. Richmond is tied with Bowie and Harrisburg. Akron is in fourth, two games behind second place, and Altoona is in sixth, four games back. The winner of the second half in the Southwest Division will face Erie in the first round of the playoffs, unless the SeaWolves win the second half, which would lead to the second-place team (determined by winning percentage) in the second half advancing to the postseason. The Flying Squirrels are aiming to reach the playoffs for the fourth time in team history. They reached the postseason in 2011, 2014 and 2022.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels are leading the Double-A level in total attendance (353,334) and average attendance (6,424) this year. They are also 13th in the minors in average attendance. Last year, Richmond led all 30 Double-A teams in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history.

DONNIE'S IN HIS ELEMENT: **Donovan Walton** has hit safely in each of his six games since being assigned to Richmond last week, combining to hit .364 (8-for-22) with a double, two walks and three RBIs, adding two stolen bases. In his 14 games for the Flying Squirrels this season, he is batting .319 (15-for-47) with two homers and nine RBIs. Covering his two stints with Richmond, Walton has reached base in 13 consecutive Eastern League games and has hit safely in seven straight games.

ALL ABOARD THE SHANE TRAIN: **Shane Matheny** has reached base 40 times in his last 18 games since July 25 (20 hits and 20 walks), hitting .328 (20-for-61) with two homers, four doubles, two triples and 12 RBIs adding a .488 on-base percentage. He was riding a 12-game on-base streak and a seven-game hit streak prior to going 0-for-4 on Saturday night. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 128 walks, moving ahead of **Ricky Oropesa** (112, 2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails **Jacob Heyward** (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career.

GLOW SHOW: Over his last 26 games since July 1, **Jimmy Glowne** is batting .310 (27-for-87) with four homers, seven doubles, 20 RBIs and nine walks. On July 18 at Akron, he closed the game a triple shy of the cycle and went 3-for-6 with a three-run homer, a two-run double and an RBI single, picking up a career-high six RBIs. On July 29 against the Sea Dogs, he hit a lead-off double to start the bottom of the ninth in Richmond's comeback win. He is hitting .389 (7-for-18) in his last six games since August 2 with two doubles, three walks and six RBIs.

OLD FRIENDS: Harrisburg's roster includes two former Flying Squirrels players. First baseman Frankie Tostado was selected by the Mariners in the minor-league phase of December's Rule 5 Draft and later traded to the Nationals. In 2021 and 2022, Tostado played 177 games for the Flying Squirrels, batting .264 with 104 RBIs. His 25 career homers with Richmond are tied for fifth-most in a career in franchise history. Reliever Patrick Ruotolo joined the Senators after being signed by the Nationals as a free agent on July 1. He spent parts of three seasons with Richmond (2018, 2021, 2022), going 4-2 with a 2.45 ERA and 16 saves in his 64 appearances. On May 13, 2021 at Harrisburg, Ruotolo worked the ninth in the Flying Squirrels' first nine-inning no-hitter in franchise history. Other former Flying Squirrels playing in the Eastern League this year include outfielder Diego Rincones (2021-22) with Erie, pitcher Gray Fenter (2022) with Somerset and pitcher Matt Seelinger (2021) with Reading.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP **Carson Whisenhunt** (No. 5 - on IL), OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 7), RHP **Hayden Birdsong** (No. 12), RHP **Carson Seymour** (No. 16), RHP **Landen Roupp** (No. 17 - on IL) and RHP **Ryan Murphy** (No. 28). Baseball America rates Brown as the organization's best hitter for average and best athlete, rates Roupp as having the best curveball and **Jose Cruz** as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes five Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 3), Birdsong (No. 10), Brown (No. 13), Roupp (No. 15) and Seymour (No. 23).

THIS DATE IN SQUIRRELS HISTORY

In 2010, the Flying Squirrels beat the Portland Sea Dogs, 5-4. The Sea Dogs scored one in the fourth and three in the fifth to pull ahead, 4-0. The score stayed there until the bottom of the ninth. Sharlon Schoop and Tyler La-Torre hit RBI singles to get Richmond on the board. Clay Timpner brought in a run with a fielder's choice. Brad Boyer tied the game, 4-4, with an RBI single. Darren Ford followed with a walk-off single, capping the five-run inning.

IN OTHER WORDS...

Manager **Dennis Pelfrey** on the tight playoff race:

"There were a couple games last week that we feel like we should've won and we didn't. That has put us in a position where we are tied for that playoff spot. In all reality, I wouldn't want it any other way. Every game is important. When you start putting some implications on the games, that starts to show the character of the players and how they're built. Everybody has talent. Everybody has tools. It's a matter of how we put those things together and win games. The last couple series have put us in a spot where we've really got to tighten some things up. There's a sense of urgency, but that's how it should be every game. There's nothing better than playing meaningful baseball in late-August."
