### PERICH'S WALK-OFF HOME RUN CAPS CRAZY, BACK-AND-FORTH RIDERS WIN:

With a ninth-inning walk-off home run from **Rafe Perich**, the Frisco RoughRiders came back from multiple deficits and beat the Springfield Cardinals 8-7 on Wednesday night at Riders Field. Springfield (24-28) struck first against Frisco (27-24) starter **Blake Townsend**, with a two-run rally in the second inning and added another in the fourth for a 3-0 lead. After going scoreless against Springfield starter Mason Molina in the first five innings, the Riders got on the board in the sixth with a two-run home run from **Wyatt Langford** in the second game of his MLB rehab assignment that drew the deficit to 3-2. The Cardinals got the two runs right back in the seventh inning with a two-run single from Zach Levenson for another three-run advantage. In the bottom of the seventh, the Riders scored four runs to take their first lead on four hits and three walks. **Frainer Chavez** tied the game with a single and **Arturo Disla** delivered the lead with an RBI walk. With the game tied 7-7 in the ninth inning, **Wiliam Bormie** (6-0) pitched a scoreless frame and Perich punished a hanging breaking ball from DJ Carpenter (0-1) over the right field wall to win it.

### RAFE AT HOME:

Riders infielder **Rafe Perich** has had a pretty solid introduction to his new team, homering twice in his first 5 games with the RoughRiders. On Sunday in Arkansas, he crushed a solo shot and added an RBI single in a 2-1 win before he blasted a walk-off home run on Wednesday at home. His 13 total home runs this year lead the Rangers organization. For High-A Hub City, he won South Atlantic League Player of the Month for May, hitting .345/.448/.747/1.195 with 10 home runs and 29 RBIs.

### REHAB CITY USA:

Both infielder **Corey Seager** and outfielder **Wyatt Langford** began their rehab assignments with the RoughRiders on Tuesday. Seager was placed on the 10-day injured list with lower back inflammation on May 18th while Langford was placed on the 10-day IL with a right forearm strain on April 22nd. Both Seager and Langford went 1-for-2 in their first rehab games Tuesday, with Langford also drawing 2 walks, stealing a base and scoring a run. On Wednesday, Langford homered, his 7th home run in 17 Double-A games.

### ONE-RUN MADNESS:

The RoughRiders are just 8-11 in one-run games this year. Out of the 11 one-run losses, the RoughRiders scored at least one run in the final inning to make it a one-run loss in 5 different games this season, just coming up short. Only 2 of the 11 losses featured a blown lead from the Frisco bullpen.

### THE BUFFALO HAS ARRIVED:

**Arturo Disla**, nicknamed "The Buffalo", has been amazing since joining the RoughRiders. He has hit safely in 13 of his 17 games, he is hitting .343 (23-for-67)/.429/.552/.981 with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 3 home runs and 15 RBIs. In his first 30 games of the season with High-A Hub City, Disla hit .314/.434/.559/.993 with 6 homers and 21 RBIs. Between both levels, he has dominated lefties, hitting .436 (17-for-39)/.540/.795/1.335 against southpaws. Among those with at least 35 AB vs. LHP, he is T-1st in the minors in batting average and 2nd in OPS against lefties.

### GET RICH OR DIE DREILING:

RoughRiders outfielder **Dylan Dreiling** has been hitting well recently. The No. 10 prospect is 9th in the Texas League in batting average (.291). On a 22-game on-base streak (longest active streak in TL), he is hitting .306 (26-for-85)/.417/.529/.946 with 4 doubles, 5 home runs, 17 RBIs, 17 walks and 16 strikeouts.

### GIMME THAT OFFENSE EARLY AND OFTEN:

The RoughRiders have been swinging the bat well in their last 33 games, going 19-14. During the stretch, they have scored 212 runs, second in the league (6.4 R/G), slashing .266/.368/.437/.805 with 41 home runs. Frisco's 44 runs in the first inning this year are tied for 6th in the minors, hitting .308 (62-for-201) in the first with 9 home runs. They have scored in the first inning in 20 games and have scored multiple runs in the first inning in 12 games this season. When scoring 7 or fewer runs, the Riders are 10-23 (including a combined 3-10 record when scoring 6 or 7 runs) and 17-1 when scoring 8 or more. Frisco is also 11-14 in 1 or 2-run games. The Riders have been shut out just twice this year, both in 7-inning doubleheader games.

### YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:

Through 51 games the RoughRiders are 2nd in the Texas League with 466 hits. They are second in the league in batting average (.269) and 2nd in runs (319, 6.1 runs per game). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. Frisco has scored 7 or more runs in 45 percent of their games (23-of-51). The Riders are 4th in the Texas League in homers (66) while they are 1st in SLG (.443) and 2nd in OPS (.808). For perspective, the Wind Surge led the league last year with a .780 team OPS.

### ABOUT WINSTON

- Signed by Rangers for \$10,000 in 2019.
- Worked on increasing his fastball velocity from the low 90s when he signed. He spent the fall of 2023 at the Rangers spring training facility and working out in the biomechanics' lab where the velocity was up to 99 mph.
- Looking to become the first player born in Payita to make MLB debut.

### 2026 SEASON

- Enters the 2026 season as the No. 4 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB Pipeline.
- Made best start of the season on May 29th at Arkansas, going 5.2 IP. 2 of the 3 runs he allowed scored after he left the game.

### 2025 SEASON

- Entered the 2025 season as the No. 5 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB Pipeline.
- Was named First Team All-Spring Breakout after throwing three perfect frames with six strikeouts on March 16th, 2025 against the Giants prospects.
- Was placed on the Injured List with a Back Stress Reaction on April 22nd. Activated on August 29th.

### 2024 SEASON

- After the graduation of Wyatt Langford from MLB Pipeline's Rangers Top 30, Santos went from unranked to No. 15.
- Named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week on April 23rd after striking out 12 in 5.0 scoreless innings during 5-3 win over Greensboro on April 19th.
- Owned 0.44 ERA over four April starts, striking out 31 over 20.2 IP to just seven walks.
- After striking out just 19.9% of batters in 2023, he recorded a 30.5% K-rate with Hickory in 2024.
- Poured in best Double-A start in second outing against Arkansas, allowing one unearned run over five innings with seven strikeouts in a win.
- Participated in the Futures Game in Arlington, allowing an unearned run over one inning pitched.
- In first career postseason start at Midland on 9/17, he picked up the loss, but struckout a career-high tying 12 batters over six innings while allowing two runs (one earned) on four hits and walking two. Frisco lost 2-0.

### 2023 SEASON

- 3.38 SO/BB figure was 2nd-best in TEX org. (3.84-Jose Corniell) and 9th-best in SAL (min. 75.0 IP).
- Placed on the 7-day I.L. on 5/10 with hamstring tightness; activated 5/16.
- Tabbed as the 27th-best prospect in the Rangers system by MLB Pipeline.

### 2022 SEASON

- Lauded for possessing the 'Best Fastball' in the TEX org. according to Baseball America's 'Best Tools' survey.
- Ranked among Down East staff leaders in IP (1st), GS (T1st), and SO (3rd).

## CHAD COMER

Years with Rangers: 10

Years with RoughRiders: 2 (1st as manager)

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

## THOMAS ST. CLAIR

Years with Rangers: 5

Years with RoughRiders: 1

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

## JASON HART

Years with Rangers: 13

Years with RoughRiders: 9

Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.

Hernandez joins the RoughRiders for his first season with the Rangers organization.

During 2020, Hernandez managed the Texas Collegiate League Frisco RoughRiders after the MiLB season had been canceled. In 2025, he served as a bench coach for Triple-A Jacksonville and spent 19 seasons with the Marlins as a coach and coordinator. As part of that stint, he served eight seasons as a manager, most recently in 2022 with High-A Beloit.

Hernandez started his coaching career at the University of Mobile in 1993 as a hitting coach and stayed there through 2001. From 2005-2006, Hernandez served as the hitting coach for the Independent Pensacola Pelicans.
