TODAY'S GAME: The Memphis Redbirds host the Norfolk Tides (Triple-A, Baltimore Orioles) for game two of a six-game series at AutoZone Park. Right-handed pitcher Hunter Dobbins is slated for an MLB Rehab Start for Memphis opposite left-handed pitcher Cade Povich for Norfolk.

LAST NIGHT RECAP: The Memphis Redbirds snagged the home opener of the 2026 season with a 10-5 score over the Norfolk Tides (Triple-A, Baltimore Orioles) on Tuesday night at AutoZone Park. Memphis opened the scoring with three consecutive two-out doubles in the second inning to jump ahead 3-0. After Norfolk tied the game in the top of the third, third baseman Blaze Jordan blasted his first homer of the season to grab the lead back. Shortstop César Prieto smacked a home run to right in the fourth to double the lead. Catcher Jimmy Crooks stamped the win with a three-run blast with two outs in the seventh. The three home runs are the most by the Redbirds offense this season. Designated hitter Matt Koperniak finished the win 1-for-3 with three RBIs and a double. Starting pitcher Hunter Dobbins (1-0) allowed three runs on three hits, walked two and struck out three over 5.0 innings in his MLB Rehab Start. The right-handed pitcher allowed all three runs before an out was recorded in the third. Gerson Moreno and Ryan Fernandez each worked a scoreless inning in relief.

2026 ROSTER: The Memphis Redbirds announced Friday the club's 28-man 2026 Opening Day roster. Memphis opens the season Friday night at the Gwinnett Stripers (Triple-A, Atlanta Braves). Eight of the top 30 prospects in the St. Louis Cardinals system open the campaign with Memphis. Outfielder Joshua Baez (No. 4 STL prospect) is the highest-ranked prospect to start the season with the Redbirds, followed by catcher Leo Bernal (No. 6), left-handed pitcher Quinn Mathews (No. 7), catcher Jimmy Crooks (No. 8), right-handed pitcher Tink Hence (No. 15), left-handed pitcher Brycen Mautz (No. 21), right-handed pitcher Luis Gastelum (No. 22) and infielder Blaze Jordan (No. 27). Baez (No. 87 overall prospect) and Bernal (No. 98) represent the Redbirds on MLB Pipeline's top 100 prospect list to start the season. 11 Redbirds find themselves on the Cardinals 40-man roster. Right-handed pitchers Gordon Graceffo, Richard Fitts and Ryan Fernandez, left-handed pitcher Nick Raquet, and infielders Bryan Torres and Cesar Prieto join Hence, Mautz, Bernal, Crooks and Baez. The 2026 Memphis roster includes 16 returners from the 2025 season and a total of 18 players who have previously appeared in a Redbirds uniform.

MANAGER BEN JOHNSON

Ben Johnson enters his eighth season as manager of the Memphis Redbirds and his eighth year in the Cardinals organization.

COACHING CAREER

- Became the all-time winningest manager in franchise history on May 21, 2025 (368 wins)
- 428 - 435 managerial record entering 2025 season, including postseason.
- Oversaw a franchise record 15-game winning streak in 2021 (7/9-7/25); tied for longest in MiLB that season
- Oversaw a franchise record 200 home runs in 2019; team won 29 of final 40 games and were in contention for division until 2nd to last day of the season
- Spent 2018 as third base coach for the Durham Bulls (Rays' Triple-A)
- Spent 2014-2017 as a scout in the Arizona Diamondbacks organization
- Coached at Millenium HS in Goodyear, AZ from 2011-2013
- Previously managed Arizona Centennials in the Independent League in 2012

PLAYING CAREER

- Drafted by the Cardinals in the 4th Rd. of 1999 Draft; traded to Padres in 2000
- Made MLB debut on June 26, 2005 with the Padres; played 98 games over next three seasons with the Padres and Mets
- Named Padres Minor League Player of the Year in 2005 when he hit a career-high .312 with 25 home runs and 83 RBIs as a member of the Portland Beavers
- Played 901 MiLB games over 10 seasons with Cardinals, Padres, Mets and Tigers; hit .262 with 115 career home runs and 473 RBIs

PERSONAL

- Born in Memphis and played baseball at Germantown HS; named Memphis-area HS Player of the Year in 1999; lives with his dad during the season
- He and his wife, Elizabeth, have two children, Ethan and Ruby; reside in Phoenix, AZ

PITCHING COACH DARWIN MARRERO

- Marrero is beginning his 14th season in the Cardinals organization and fourth with Memphis.

COACHING CAREER

- Joined the Memphis Redbirds coaching staff following five seasons (2018-22) with Double-A Springfield Marrero's career with St. Louis began as pitching coach for the Gulf Coast League Cardinals (Rookie) from 2013-14, followed by the same role with the State College Spikes (Class-A) from 2015-17.

PLAYING CAREER

- Marrero's playing career spanned seven seasons from 1998-2004 with the Montreal Expos organization, attaining his highest level at Double-A with the Harrisburg Senators in 2002 and 2004.

HITTING COACH HOWIE CLARK

- Clark is beginning his fourth season in the Cardinals organization and fourth with Memphis

COACHING CAREER

- In 2015, Clark was named the hitting coach of the Delmarva Shorebirds, the Class-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. In February 2017, Clark was named the assistant hitting coach for the Orioles. He was named hitting coach of the Charlotte Knights, Triple-A affiliate of the Chicago White Sox, for the 2020 season. [9] On December 1, 2020, Clark was named assistant hitting coach for the Chicago White Sox.

PLAYING CAREER

- Clark played parts of six seasons in MLB with the Baltimore Orioles, Minnesota Twins and Toronto Blue Jays from 2002 to 2008.
- Clark batted .262 with three home runs and 26 RBI in his career

CAREER

- Enters the 2025 season rated as the No. 2 prospect in the Cardinals organization by Baseball America (No. 41 in Top 100), behind INF JJ Wetherholt (No. 25).
- Rated as having the "Best Changeup" and "Best Control" in the organization in 2025 by the same publication.
- Also ranked as the 3rd-highest left-handed pitching prospect in 2025 by Baseball America behind Noah Schultz (White Sox) and Thomas White (Marlins).
- 2024 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year. Was the 4th to be recognized in his first pro season with Max Rajcic (2023), Anthony Reyes (2004), and Rick Ankiel (1998).
- 2024 Baseball America Minor League Pitcher of the Year. Joined Rick Ankiel (1999 Minor League Player of the Year) as the only two Cardinals to receive a year-end minor league honor from Baseball America.
- One of five starting pitchers named to Baseball America's 2024 Minor League All-Star First Team.
- Recognized as Minor League Baseball's Pitcher of the Year and winner of the Debut of the Year awards in 2024, as well as to the All-MiLB Prospect First Team (LHP).
- Led Minor League Baseball in strikeouts (202) in 2024 while splitting time between all four Cardinals full-season minor league affiliates.
- Is just the 2nd minor league pitcher to eclipse 200 strikeouts in a season since 2011, joining Diamondbacks RHP Brandon Pfaadt (218 in 2022).
- Is just the 10th Cardinals minor league pitcher to reach the 200-strikeout threshold and first since Rick Ankiel (222 in 1998).
- His 202 strikeouts tie for the 7th-most in Cardinals single-season minor league history (since 1962) and were 28 more than any other minor league pitcher in 2024.
- Two-time Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Month (April & June), becoming only the 3rd player ever to take home honors twice in his first professional season.

2024

- Completed his first professional season with an 8-5 record, 2.76 ERA, 0.98 WHIP and a Minor League-leading 202 strikeouts across 26 starts (143.1 IP) split between all four full-season minor league affiliates.
- Ranked among minor league full-season qualifiers in strikeout rate (35.4%, 2nd), average-against (.179, 4th) and WHIP (0.98, 7th).
- Finished among Cardinals minor league leaders in quality starts (14, 1st), innings pitched (2nd), WHIP (2nd), starts (T-2nd), opponents average (4th), SO/BB ratio (4.12, 6th) and SO/9 IP (12.68, 6th).
- Compiled seven starts with 11 or more strikeouts spread over three levels, including a dozen at Double-A on Aug. 23.
- His 12.68 SO/9 IP was the 2nd-highest by a Cardinals minor league starter since 2000 (min. 20 games started), behind Alex Reyes (13.41 in 2015).
- Began his pro career at Palm Beach (A) striking out 52 of his 117 Florida State League batters faced while allowing just 14 hits before being promoted to Peoria (A+) on May 13.
- Started 2-0 with a 0.50 ERA (1 ER/18.0 IP), 0.89 WHIP, and 38 strikeouts across his first four pro starts to be named Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Month for April.
- Twice named the Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Month (April and June), becoming only the 3rd Cardinal ever to take home honors twice in his first professional season.
- Logged a 2.68 ERA (42.2 IP) with 58 strikeouts and nine walks at High-A Peoria. Promoted to Springfield on June 24.
- Named to the All-Star Futures Game where he pitched a scoreless inning of relief and fanned two for the National League on July 13.
- Spent the majority of his season with Springfield, making nine starts in the Texas League (AA) to the tune of a 2.41 ERA (52.1 IP) and a .186 opponent batting average.
- Named Texas League's Pitcher of the Month for August.
- Promoted to Memphis on Aug. 28 where he made four starts to end the season.

BACKGROUND/PERSONAL

- Played high school baseball at Aliso Niguel High School in Aliso Viejo, Calif.
- Pitched four seasons at Stanford University (2020-24).
- Originally selected by Tampa Bay in the 19th round of the 2022 MLB Draft, but elected to return to pitch his senior season.
- Named 2023 Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year after going 10-4 with a 3.75 ERA (124.2 IP).
- Ranked 2nd in Division I with 158 strikeouts in 2023 behind LSU's Paul Skenes (209). Also was the 2nd-most in Stanford history.
- Threw a 156-pitch complete game in the Stanford Super Regional win against the University of Texas on June 11, 2023, striking out 16.
- His older sister, Remy, played soccer at Rice University.

- Added 25 pounds to his 6-foot-5 frame after being drafted by St. Louis in 2023.
- Boasts that he is the best player at any board game.
- Is interested in cryptocurrency, and before his baseball career, wanted to pursue being an investment banker.
- Resides in Aliso Viejo, Calif.

- Originally a 2nd round draft pick by the Kansas City Royals in 2014 out of Baker High School in Baldwinsville, N.Y.
- Signed by the Cardinals as a minor league free agent with an invitation to 2026 Major League Spring Training.
- Has been signed as a minor league free agent by the White Sox (2022), Braves (2023) and Twins (2024). Was traded twice from the Braves to Orioles and back to the Braves six weeks later.
- Played the second half of the 2023 season with the Uni-President 7-Eleven Lions with the Chinese Professional Baseball League.
- Pitched in 43 career Major League games posting a 4-1 record with a 4.21 ERA and 61 strikeouts over 72.2 innings. Made his Major League debut with the Kansas City Royals against the Milwaukee Brewers, Sept. 18, 2020.
- Earned his first Major League win versus the Boston Red Sox, Sept. 20, 2024, in a 12-inning affair for a 4-2 Twins win during the pennant run.
- Went 24 appearances without allowing a home run to start the 2024 season.
- Suffered two injuries in the minor leagues, a left shin contusion (6/25-7/11/19) and a right ulnar collateral ligament (7/13-8/13/21), both while with Omaha (AAA).
- Selected to the 2018 Texas League All-Star Game in Midland. Tossed a scoreless inning for the North Division.
- 2018 Arizona Fall League Pitcher of the Week (10/14-20).
- Tossed two complete games vs. Hagerstown, tied for the South Atlantic League lead.

CAREER NOTES

- 2023 Rule 5 pick from Boston spent his first full season in the Majors and appeared in a professional season high in games (62) and innings pitched (66.2)
- Became the first Rule 5 Selection to play an entire season with St. Louis since RHP Matt Bowman (2015).
- His 62 appearances led 2023 Major League Rule 5 Draft Picks and were the most by any Cardinals Rule 5 Draft Pick in the season immediately following his selection.
- His 62 appearances for St. Louis in 2024 were the most by a Cardinals rookie since Giovanny Gallegos (66 in 2016).
- Made Major League debut on April 3, 2024 at San Diego, striking out the side in the 9th inning. Became the 38th pitcher in MLB history and the 2nd Cardinal (Braden Loooper, March 31, 1998 vs. Dodgers) to strike out three in 1.0 inning pitched in an MLB debut.
- According to Baseball Savant, threw his Slider 48.1% of the time in 2024 (573 of 1,191 pitches), most of any pitch. Ranked among 2024 leaders in Run Value (9, T-11th) & Hard-Hit Pct. (23.5, 6th) among pitchers to throw 400+ sliders.
- Was one of 11 prospects invited to the 2023 Red Sox rookie development program.
