#### **NOTES AND NUGGETS**

#### **CLIPPING COLUMBUS**

With yesterday's 8-7 win over the Clippers, the Storm Chasers have won the season series with Columbus for a 4th straight season, taking 10 of the first 17 games between the two teams.

- The Storm Chasers and Clippers split the season series 9-9 in 2021 ... since then, Omaha won 11 of 18 in 2022 and 2024, while winning 13 of 18 in 2023. Since joining the International League in 2021, Omaha has won 31 of 53 games at Huntington Park (.585 winning percentage) ... the Storm Chasers have won 54 of 89 overall games with the Clippers (.607 winning percentage).
- The Storm Chasers' .607 winning percentage against Columbus is the club's 2nd-best against the 12 IL teams they have played at least 12 games against since 2021 ... it is tied for the 7th-best winning percentage of IL teams with at least 85 games against an opponent since 2021 (of 38 matchups).

#### **HOMER HAPPY**

The Storm Chasers have hit 198 home runs in 2025, 3rd-most in the Minors.

- The Storm Chasers rank 3rd both at the Triple-A level and in the Minors, behind the Albuquerque Isotopes and Charlotte Knights at 199 homers.
- 198 homers rank 4th-most in a season in franchise history (since 1969) ... the 2025 Chasers have passed last year's team that hit 193 homers ... the franchise record of 231 is shared by the 1999 Omaha Golden Spikes and the 2021 Omaha Storm Chasers.
- The 2021 Storm Chasers led Minor League Baseball with 231 home runs, the only time in the modern era (since 2005) Omaha has led its league, the Triple-A level or Minor League Baseball in homers.
- The Las Vegas Aviators (Athletics Triple-A) led the Minors in 2024 with 232 home runs ... the 2025 season is on pace to have the Minor League leader hit the fewest homers since the 2018 Rancho Cucamonga Quakes hit 202 long balls.

#### **PUSHING 20**

Storm Chasers outfielder **MJ Melendez** completed a 20/20/20 season last night with a steal of 2nd base in the 1st inning, his 20th steal of the year.

This year, Melendez has hit 33 doubles and 20 homers while stealing 20 bases.

- Melendez is the 5th Triple-A Omaha player to complete a 20/20/20 season, joining Bombo Rivera (1982), Dwayne Hosey (1994), Dee Brown (2000) and Brewer Hicklen (2022) ... he is the 9th IL player to do so since 2021 and the 3rd this year, joining Louisville's Rece Hinds (26 2B, 24 HR, 21 SB) and Columbus Milan Tolentino (20 2B, 21 HR, 20 SB).
- Since 2005, Melendez is the 5th Royals Minor Leaguer to go 20/20/20, joining **Alan Moye** in 2005 (23 2B, 24 HR, 20 SB), **Alex Gordon** in 2006 (39 2B, 29 HR, 22 SB), **Bobby Witt Jr.** in 2021 (35 2B, 33 HR, 29 SB) and **Brewer Hicklen** in 2022 (30 2B, 28 HR, 35 SB).

  - Castro was the IL's August Player of the Month, hitting .433 (39-for-90), with a Minor League-best 76 total bases ... he hit a league-leading 10 homers and ranked 1st with 39 hits and 28 RBI ... he ranked tied 3rd in homers and was 5th in RBI.

#### **BOBBY BARRELS**

- Storm Chasers infielder **Bobby Dalbec** is on his 3rd team of the season, but has combined to produce one of the top offensive seasons in the IL this year.

  Between Charlotte, Nashville and Omaha, Dalbec is hitting .269 (108-for-402) with 27 doubles, 24 homers and 82 runs batted in, with a .874 OPS.

  Dalbec ranks 5th in the IL in extra-base hits (53), tied 6th in homers and tied 8th in runs batted in (72) ... among IL qualifiers, he's 8th in slugging percentage (.525).

  He has a hit in 22 of 32 games with the Chasers, with 8 multi-hit games and 8 multi-RBI games ... he leads the Storm Chasers with 143 plate appearances since his first game on August 9 and has started 32 of Omaha's 36 games in that stretch.

#### THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

The Storm Chasers are not near the league lead in stolen bases, but Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

Ø Omaha has successfully stolen 167 bases this year, and only been caught 32 times ... 167 steals ranks 8th in the International League and 13th in Triple-A.

- 167-for-199 in steal attempts is a 83.9% success rate, the 3rd-best stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and is the 7th-best among the 120 full-season Minor League teams (1st: South Bend & New Hampshire tied, 85.9%).

Turnbull is making his 4th start with the Storm Chasers, his 12th Triple-A start this year and his 19th overall appearance ... signed with the Blue Jays in May, DFA'd and released by Toronto in June ... signed with the Cub in July, then released by Chicago on August 28 ... signed with the Royals and assigned to Omaha on August 30.

Playing his 11th professional season this year ... Royals are Turnbull's 5th MLB organization, has previously spent time with the Tigers, Phillies, Blue Jays and Cubs ... has appeared in 81 Major League games (68 starts) from 2018 to 2025, debuting and primarily pitching with Detroit while also pitching for Philadelphia and Toronto.

In his 3rd outing with the Storm Chasers, faced a season-high 25 batters but took his 1st loss with Omaha ... worked a 1-2-3 inning in the 1st ... allowed a 2-run homer to Johnathan Rodriguez to open the 2nd, before loading the bases ... a bases loaded hit batter and sacrifice fly added 2 more runs for a 3-run 2nd inning ... threw a scoreless 3rd inning, then allowed 2 runs in the 4th on a double, walk and 2-run single ... worked a scoreless 5th inning, but did not come out for the 6th.

#### **2025 HIGHLIGHTS**

- Signed a Major League deal with the Blue Jays in May and made 5 starts in the Minors 3 with the Dunedin Blue Jays (A) and 2 with the Buffalo Bisons (AAA) ... pitched 3 games for Toronto between June 11 and 20 (2relief appearances, 1 start) ... Designated for Assignment June 25, released June 27.



Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game since  $\underline{2000}.\ Green\ squares\ represent\ Omaha\ wins, while\ red\ squares\ represent\ Omaha\ losses.\ The$ number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.

Since 2000, there are 58 results in Triple-A Omaha games that have only happened once. 34 of those results (wins or losses) are a true scorigami, a scoring combination that has only happened once. Recent scorigami occurrences are listed to the right, with true scorigamis in bold.
