PLAYOFF BOUND

The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.

Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.

This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.

The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

NOTES AND NUGGETS IN GOOD STANDINGS

While the standings reset for the start of the 2nd half on June 25, Omaha's enters today's game 26 games over .500 with a 68-42 record (.618 winning percentage).

- 68 wins are the 2nd-most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, just behind 72 from the Sugar Land Space Cowboys, Houston's Triple-A affiliate.
- Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .618 winning percentage overall this year is the 6th-best the Minors ... the top team in Minor League Baseball is Sugar Land (.72-39 / .649).
- The Storm Chasers have still been 1st or 2nd in the Minors in wins every day since May 25 ... Omaha previously held sole possession of the best winning percentage in full-season Minor League Baseball for 30 days, June 5 to July 5.
- Omaha is currently on pace for 91 wins ... the franchise record is 86 wins from the Omaha Royals in 1990 ... the best winning percentage in Triple-A Omaha history was .607 (85-55) in the inaugural 1969 season.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

68 of Omaha's 110 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 27 of 42 losses in 2024, with 14 of 42 losses by just one run (33%).

- Close games have been a struggle for Omaha in recent weeks, with the bullpen converting just 11 of its last 21 save opportunities, since June 5 (52%).
- Omaha is 20-14 in 1-run games this season, which ranks as tied for the 8th-most 1-run wins of any Minor League team ... 2 teams have 23 wins by 1 run this year.
- As a team, Omaha's 31 saves are the most in the league, 2nd-most at the Triple-A level and tied 6th in the Minor Leagues ... Evan Sisk has recorded the team's last 5 saves, but 7 different Storm Chasers arms have 2 or more saves this year.
- Omaha and Iowa have played many close games, with 14 of 19 games between the two teams decided by 3 runs or less ... Omaha has 7 of 8 games decided by 3 runs or more, while Iowa has taken 8 of 11 games decided by 1 or 2 runs between the two teams.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 598 to 495 this season, a +103 run differential.

- A +103 run differential this year ranks as the both the mark in the International League and at the Triple-A level as well, ahead of Sugar Land (+96).
- Omaha is 9th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Greensboro Grasshoppers lead the Minors at +161 (620 to 459).

COMEBACK KIDS

Omaha has 37 come-from-behind wins this season, meaning over half (54%) of this year's wins have been games where the Chasers trailed at some point.

- Omaha has trailed for three innings or more in 15 of the 37 comeback wins, with 6 victories where the club had to overcome multiple deficits ... the team has 10 wins in games where they trailed after the 6th inning.
- The Storm Chasers have come back from down as many as 5 runs to win and have overcome a 3+ run deficit to win on 10 occasions.
- 2 of Omaha's 7 comeback wins in July were games where they trailed for over half of the game ... by 8.5 innings July 21 vs. Indianapolis and 5.5 innings July 23 at St. Paul.

RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen has been one of the best across the entire Triple-A level in 2024.

- The Storm Chasers relievers lead all Triple-A bullpens with a 1.35 WHIP and 216/325/.352 opposing slash line ... a 3.78 bullpen ERA ranks 2nd in Triple-A.
- Omaha's bullpen has combined to not allow a run in 28 games this year, roughly one in every 3.93 games ... the bullpen also has 16 games without a walk as a relief corps, including 5 of the team's last 14 games, since July 25.

KICKSTART MY GAME

Storm Chaser starting pitchers have been some of the best in Triple-A in August.

- Omaha's starters have combined for a 2.25 ERA (10 ER in 40.0 IP) over 8 games this month, the 2nd-best in Triple-A this month ... a 0.80 WHIP from the starters in August ranks 1st in Triple-A and 2nd in Minor League Baseball (26 H & 6 BB).

TODAY'S START

Lamet is making his 3rd start with Omaha, his 1th Triple-A start in 2024 and his 15th overall appearance this season ... pitched 3 games in the Major Leagues for the Dodgers, then made 9 appearances for Triple-A Oklahoma City before electing free agency on June 4 ... signed with Kansas City on July 18, assigned to Omaha July 19 and made his Chasers debut July 28.

LAST OUTING: SATURDAY, AUGUST 3 @ ROCHESTER

In his 2nd outing with Omaha, threw 5.0 scoreless innings on just 62 pitches (12.4 pitches/inning) and faced the minimum (15 batters) in his first Omaha win, part of a combined 1-hit shutout ... worked 1-2-3 innings in the 2nd, 3rd and 4th innings ... leadoff single in the 1st inning (Rochester's only hit of the game) was caught stealing, leadoff walk in the 5th was erased on a double play.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Signed a Minor League deal with the Los Angeles Dodgers in free agency and broke camp in Triple-A, but had his contract selected by the big league club on April 1 without an appearance in the Minors ... pitched 3 games in relief for the Dodgers (2 scoreless), but designated for assignment April 6 and sent outright to Triple-A on April 8.
8 of his 9 outings with the Oklahoma City Baseball Club were starts ... 4 of his last 6 were at least 5.0 innings, once pitched into the 6th inning ... allowed 3 runs or fewer in 6 of 9 appearances, with a 14.1-inning scoreless streak between April 25 and May 14.
In his Omaha debut 7/28 @ STP, all 5 outs he recorded came via strikeout, his first appearance in a live game in 58 days.

CAREER NOTES

- Began the season in the Rockies organization before signing to a minor league contract with Boston as a free agent on June 27 ... pitched in Triple-A and in the Major Leagues with both orgs ... pitched 17 MLB games (4 starts) and 8 Triple-A games (7 starts).
Struggled with Colorado, going 1-4 with a 11.57 ERA ... went on a rehab assignment to Triple-A Albuquerque after having lower back stiffness, allowed just 1 earned run in 10.2 innings (0.84 ERA) in three rehab starts ... released by Rockies June 22.
Pitched 5 games (4 starts) with the Triple-A Worcester Red Sox, going 0-0 with a 3.72 ERA and 16 K ... had his contract selected 8/7, pitched one MLB game allowed 3 R in 2.0 IP on 8/8 vs. Kansas City ... DFA'd 8/9, sent outright 8/12, elected free agency 8/14.

Has accumulated a 1.8 bWAR in his 7-year Major League career ... 60 of 121 games he has pitched in the big leagues have been starts.
Spent parts of 5 seasons with the Padres (2017-22), going 82-56 with a 4.08 ERA (143 ER in 315.2 IP) in 82 games (56 starts).
First 50 MLB appearances with San Diego between 2017 and 2021 were starts ... only 10 of 71 MLB games since have been starts.
2022: Split his first full season as a reliever between the Padres and Rockies orgs ... acquired by the Brewers as part of a five-player deal for LHP Josh Hader on 8/1, didn't appear with Milwaukee, DFA'd on 8/3, before being claimed by the Rockies on 8/5.
2021: Began the season on the 10-day IL (right UCL sprain), his first of 3 stints on the Injured List ... Worked in relief for the 1st time in his career, making 13 appearances out of the pen (5.09 ERA, .231 AVG) in addition to 9 starts (3.99 ERA, .280 AVG).
2020: Earned All-MLB 2nd Team honors ... among all qualifying starting pitchers (1.0 IP/Team Game), ranked 2nd in H/9.0 IP (5.09), opponents' average (.161) and opponents' OPS (.496). 3rd in WHIP (0.86) and 5th in ERA (2.09) and K/9 IP (12.13) ... did not appear on the Padres' postseason roster for the Wild Card or NLDS series due to an arm injury ... fired 4 double-digit strikeout games.
2019: After 6 rehab appearances (3 in High-A, 3 in Triple-A, returned to MLB action on July 4 @ Los Angeles (NL).
2018: Missed the entire season after undergoing season-ending Tommy John surgery in April.
