JACKSONVILLE SHUTS OUT GWINNETT 7-0

Troy Johnston lashed three hits, including a home run, and scored three runs, Jack Winkler matched a career-high with four hits and the Jumbo Shrimp blanked the Stripers on Friday 7-0. Adam Mazur struck out six in 5.2 innings before yielding to Josh Simpson, who worked 1.1 perfect frames. Patrick Monteverde tossed the final 2.0 innings to complete the second shutout of the season for Jacksonville. The Jumbo Shrimp also got multi-hit games from Albert Almora, who drove in a pair of runs with a third-inning single, and Joe Mack.

APRIL COME SHE WILL

With a 19-6 (.780) record, the Jumbo Shrimp already posses the most wins of any team in MiLB. With four games to play in April, the 19 wins Jacksonville has accumulated through March and April are a club record (2005-present) for most victories over the months of March and April. In the month of April alone, the Jumbo Shrimp have already recorded 17 victories; Jacksonville had not won more than 15 games in any prior April since at least 2005.

'PEN PALS

Jacksonville starters have gone at least 5.0 innings just 12 times in 25 games thus far this season. The club's bullpen, however, has responded to the added responsibility in a huge way. Jumbo Shrimp relief pitching has combined for a 2.59 ERA, the best mark in Triple-A. The club's bullpen also ranks second in the level in BAA (.183), fourth in fewest hits allowed (78) and fifth in strikeouts (128). Jumbo Shrimp relievers have combined to toss 118.1 innings through 25 games (4.7 per game), tied for fifth-most in Triple-A.

BE STILL, MY BEATING START

Jacksonville starting pitchers have tossed just 101.1 innings thus far through the season's first 25 games, a rate of just 4.1 per contest. Those innings, however, have been extraordinarily effective; Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have posted the best ERA in Triple-A at 2.93 and issued just 26 walks, the fewest in the level. The club's starters also rank tied for fifth in fewest hits allowed (85), sixth in BAA (.230) and seventh in strikeouts (111). Interestingly, Jacksonville starting pitching has the seventh-lowest groundout-to-airout rate at 0.84.

HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS

Jacksonville is now an extraordinary 14-2 at home this season. Of the other 119 Minor League Baseball teams, only four have double-digit wins at home, with each of those four at 10 home triumphs. In their home ballpark, the Jumbo Shrimp have allowed only 44 runs (2.8 per game), pitching to a Triple-A best 2.19 ERA and .190 BAA, which ranks second at the level. The Jumbo Shrimp have scored 78 runs at VyStar Ballpark (4.9 per game), collecting the fourth-most hits (129) at home in Triple-A.

MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the 2025 season opener, Jacksonville has recorded multiple stolen bases in 15 of their last 24 games. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp have five games with at least five stolen bases, including a club record (2005-present) with seven steals in game two of a doubleheader on April 12 vs. Charlotte; Jacksonville notched five stolen bases in a game just twice over the 2022-24 seasons combined. The Jumbo Shrimp currently rank second in the minor leagues and first Triple-A with 67 stolen bases.

HIGH FIVE!

After winning two of three in Nashville, the Jumbo Shrimp took four of six contests against Worcester, swept the Charlotte Knights, split a six-game set at Memphis and now have earned another series win over Gwinnett. Thus, with four series victories and a split, this marks the first time since at least 2005 that Jacksonville has started a season with at least five non-losing series'. Jacksonville's 19-6 (.780) record to begin the 2025 campaign is their best start to a season since at least 2005. That works out to a 126-win pace over a 162-game season. The 1906 Chicago Cubs and the 2001 Seattle Mariners are tied for the most wins in an MLB season, each winning 116 games.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville is 9-1 in one-run games this season. Those nine wins are by far the most in MiLB; no other team in the minor leagues has more than six one-run victories... The Jumbo Shrimp already own an eight-game winning streak this season and have currently won five in a row. The last time they had two six-plus-game winning streaks was 2022.

ABOUT JANSON

-Junk was originally selected by the New York Yankees in the 22nd round of the 2017 draft out of Seattle University.

-Junk began his career at Seattle University as a walk-on. He worked with Redhawks pitching coach Elliott Cribby, and during his three years, had improved his fastball velocity by more than 10 miles per hour.

-The Yankees traded Junk and fellow right-handed pitcher Elvis Peguero to the Los Angeles Angels on July 30, 2021, in exchange for left-hander Andrew Heaney. Junk made his major league debut for the Angels on September 5, 2021 with a start against the Texas Rangers.

-Junk earned his first major league win on July 27, 2022, when he tossed 5.0 scoreless innings in a start against the Kansas City Royals.

-On November 22, 2022, the Angels traded Junk, Peguero and left-handed pitcher Adam Seminaris to the Milwaukee Brewers for outfielder Hunter Renfroe.

-Junk remained in the Brewers' organization until he was claimed off waivers on August 2, 2024 by the Houston Astros. Twenty-nine days later, on August 29, Junk was claimed again, this time by the Oakland Athletics.

2024 SEASON
