THREES COMPANY: Tyler Black finished the night 3-for-4 with 3-RBI, falling a single shy of the cycle to start the series against the Jumbo Shrimp. It was his first three-hit game for Nashville since June 20 and third overall this season, including the first 3-hit MLB game of his professional career on April 28 vs. Arizona. **Tuesday night was the first game of his professional career (501 G) with three XBH.** He had only previously had 15 games with multiple XBH in the same game entering Tuesday with his last coming during that June 20 performance against Memphis where he finished 3-for-5 with a home run, triple, and RBI. Tuesday's series opener against Jacksonville was his sixth 3+ RBI game this year between Nashville and Milwaukee. **Black is hitting .302 (19-for-63) with six XBH and 11 RBI in 18 games in August.** He has recorded multi-hit performances in back-to-back games and has a hit in 13 of the 18 games this month.

BROCKET POWER: Brock Wilken hit his team-leading 14th home run of the season on Tuesday night in Jacksonville and has three homers in the month of August (19 G). He's putting together his best month of the year, hitting .246 (17-for-69) with eight XBH, 14 RBI, 13 walks, and nine runs scored in August. He's riding a seven-game hitting streak with consecutive multi-hit games and has an XBH in four straight games. With five games remaining in the month, Wilken is looking to finish with the highest AVG in a single month this season after hitting .233 (14-for-60) across his 18 games in June. **He ranks T-6th in RBI (71) and walks (75) and sits 7th in doubles (22) in the Brewers farm system this season.** 38-of-70 (54%) hits in Triple-A this year for Wilken have gone for XBH.

GONE STREAKING: Brock Wilken is leading four different Nashville players riding current hitting streaks of 5+ games after all four recorded a hit on Tuesday night against Jacksonville. **Wilken has a hit in seven straight games since August 16,** including four straight games with an XBH. **Bo Naylor has a hit in each of his last six games** (.346 AVG, 3 HR, 9 RBI), **Eric Brown Jr.** (.438 AVG, HR, RBI) and **Ethan Murray** (.278 AVG, 2 HR, 4 RBI) each have a hit in five straight. Murray has crossed the plate in each of his last seven games and has reached base in each of his last 10 overall dating back to August 13. **Luke Adams is riding an 11-game on-base streak after finishing Tuesday night 3-for-5** with a triple and RBI for his first 3+ hit game since July 10 at Charlotte. After allowing a pair of runs on three hits in his first rehab game with Nashville on August 2 (0.2 IP), **Joel Kuhnel has rattled off eight straight scoreless appearances (8.1 IP) on four hits.** Right-hander **Blake Holub extended his current streak of appearances without an earned run allowed to six straight games** and has allowed just two earned runs over his last 19 games since the start of July.

NO-NO IN NOR: The Nashville Sounds recorded their first no-hitter since June 7, 2017, at Omaha, and eighth in franchise history as RHP Brandon Sproat and LHP Tate Kuehner combined to no-hit the Norfolk Tides across seven innings in game one of the doubleheader on Sunday. After recording the first five no-hitters in team history at home, each of the last three have come on the road. Sproat retired all nine batters he faced across 3.0 IP (5 K) with Kuehner covering the final 4.0 IP (4 K). Kuehner was a strike away from completing a combined perfect game before issuing a two-out walk to Rece Hinds in the bottom of the seventh. Three of the eight no-hitters for Nashville have been combined efforts with Chris Smith (6.0 IP), Sean Doolittle (1.0 IP), Tucker Kealy (1.0 IP), and Simon Castro (1.0 IP) combining for the last no-hitter in team history before Sunday. Jim Deshaies threw the first in team history on May 4, 1984, vs. Columbus (GA) and is the only other 7-inning no-hitter for Nashville. Sunday was the fourth no-hitter in the International League this season, and 19th overall among full-season teams in the minors. There have been 14 in rookie-ball this year as well for a total of 35 total including one in the big leagues.

YOU SHALL NOT SCORE: Nashville tossed back-to-back shutouts for the first time since August 30-31, 2025 against the Charlotte Knights. Sunday's 2-0 shutout win in game one was the eighth shutout of the season for the Sound, with three of the eight now coming against Norfolk including a 4-0 win on July 19 at First Horizon Park and last Thursday's 7-0 win. The Sounds are just the fifth team in the International League to earn back-to-back shutouts this season alongside Jacksonville, Rochester, Syracuse and Gwinnett. The Sounds went 27.0 IP without allowing a run from the third inning of last Wednesday's 7-5 loss to the Tides before Norfolk scored their first run in the bottom of the sixth inning of game two of Sunday's doubleheader. The 27 consecutive innings without a run allowed are the most in the International League this season, surpassing Jacksonville (23.1 IP), Rochester (22.1 IP) and Syracuse (18.0 IP). Nashville's eight shutouts are tied for the fourth-most in Triple-A this season.

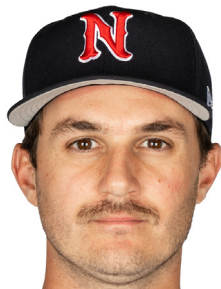
