The Reading Fightin Phils won 2-1 in the tenth inning over the Harrisburg Senators

The Reading Fightin Phils won 2-1 in the tenth inning over the Harrisburg Senators. on Friday night. A pitcher's duel had it tied at one going in to the ninth and Reading picked up a big road victory. Billy Sullivan took his fourth win, while Brian Marconi recorded his 17th save of the season. Herbert Iser was the hero, coming away with both RBIs tonight. Iser slammed his first Double-A home run in the fifth to take an early lead.

SECOND HALF SUCCESS:

The Fightins have come on strong in the second half. They have hit over .500 ball with 19 wins and 18 losses after June 26. They are 7-3 in the month of August.

This puts them in fourth place. Portland leads the way, four games out in front, and the first half for the North East Division of the Hartford is in second. Somerset won the first half for the NorthEast Division of the Eastern League.

MARCONI MAGIC:

Brian Marconi took hom his career-high and Eastern league leading 17th save of the seaason last night. This was his second in two games. It puts him third in all of Minor League Baseball. He has not been able to keep the win for the Fightins just twice this season. Marconi also has notched four wins this season in 41.1 innings pitched. The southpaw has struck out 54 batters. Last summer, he recorded the save in 15 of 16 attempts for Reading.

SNAG 'EM:
The Reading Fightin Phils picked up speed on the base paths lately. In Tuesday's win, the R-Phils notched another two stolen bases. The Fightins have nabbed four bases two times in a game. Once against Hartford on 8/6 in a 5-4 win and another came against Binghamton on May 28, a game in which Reading claimed an 11-2 victory. Rijo leads the team with 17 stolen bases, a career high, while Johan Rojas has 13. The Phillies' No. 3 prospect, Rojas swiped 46 bags so far in 2022 between in Reading and High-A Jersey Shore. The speedster has only been caught twice this season. Kevin Vicuna and Jhailyn Ortiz are in second place for the Fightins with eight bases taken this summer.

Herbert Iser has been hot since being called up to Double-A, going 2-4 in both games he has played in. Aldrem Corredor haas been enjoying his time in his old stomping ground. In his last ten games played, the righty is batting .364, he has driven in nine runs and scored six times himself. Wendell Rijo has batted .316 in the last week and a half. Rijo has brought in eleven runs and came across the plated ten times. He has also stolen three bases.

The Fightins roster boasts many top prospects in the Phillies farm system. Johan Rojas (#3), Griff McGarry (#7), Erik Miller (#9), Jhailyn Ortiz (#10) and McKinley Moore (#26).

BIG LEAGUE CLUB WATCH:
The Phillies beat the New York Mets 2-1 in the tenth in a very important Divisonal victory. Both Max Scherzer and Ranger Suarez both went impressive seven inning outings giving up just one run apiece. Alec Bohm drove in both of the runs for the Phillies as Bryson Stott crossed the plate twice. Matt Vierling recorded in an outfield assist to end the game and secure the victory for the Fightins.
