**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Fightin Phils, 3-2, to close out the series in Reading. Johan Rojas gave Reading a 1-0 lead in the first with a solo homer. **Hayden Cantrelle** tied the game with a solo home run in the fourth. In the fifth, **Brandon Martorano** gave the Flying Squirrels a 2-1 lead with an RBI single. Nick Podkul tied the game, 2-2, with a solo home run in the seventh. The Flying Squirrels took a 3-2 lead in the top of the ninth when **Marco Luciano** scored on a passed ball.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The Flying Squirrels won four-of-five at Prince George's Stadium from April 25-29, with the finale postponed until June for rain. In their series in Bowie from June 13-18, the Baysox won four-of-seven. Along with this week's series, the Flying Squirrels will play a six-game series against the Baysox at The Diamond from August 8-13.

**FIREWORKS:** The Flying Squirrels have played at home every season on Independence Day since the franchise's first year in 2010, and each year the game has sold out. The team's first July 4 game was in 2010 and the Flying Squirrels beat the Erie SeaWolves, 4-3, with a walk-off single by Clay Timpner in the bottom of the 10th inning. They also won on a walk-off hit by C.J. Hinojosa in 2014, topping the SeaWolves, 4-3. Overall, the Flying Squirrels are 10-2 on July 4, with the only losses coming against Akron in 2013 and 2018. Tonight marks the first time the Flying Squirrels have played the Baysox on July 4

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 11-2 in their last 13 games since June 18, including taking five-of-six in last week's series at Reading to open the second half of the season. They won six straight from June 23 through Friday, their longest winning streak since a seven-game stretch from April 28-May 5, 2022. Over the last 13 games, the Flying Squirrels are batting a league-best .270 (117-for-434) with 15 homers, 26 doubles and have scored 75 runs. In that same stretch, the Richmond pitching staff has a 2.74 ERA (35 ER/115.0 IP) with 144 strikeouts. Over the last 19 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined to go 2-2 with a 2.02 ERA (15 ER/67.0 IP). For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.72 ERA is second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 2681 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 379.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.29 ERA, which is second-lowest in Double-A and tied for the sixth-lowest of the 120 teams in the minors.

**THE BAYSOX** opened the second half dropping four-of-six in last week's series against the Patriots. They are 2-5 in their last seven games since June 25. Bowie's roster includes six of Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects, including 3B Coby Mayo (No. 9), LHP Cade Povich (No. 10), OF Jud Fabian (No. 13), RHP Chayce McDermott (No. 15), OF John Rhodes (No. 26) and RHP Jean Pinto (No. 28). MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects list includes Mayo (No. 7), Povich (No. 11) and Fabian (No. 15).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Carson Seymour** takes the mound for his 11th Double-A start and his third against the Baysox. He last pitched on Thursday at Reading and allowed two runs over four innings with four strikeouts. He first faced the Baysox on April 25 in Bowie and surrendered two runs over three innings in a no-decision. He made a second start at Prince George's Stadium on June 16 and allowed one run over four innings. Among Eastern League pitchers (min. 50 IP), Seymour has the ninth-lowest ERA (3.43) and the fifth-highest groundball percentage (44.9). He also has the lowest HR/9 (0.31) in the Eastern League (min. 50). A native of Poway, Calif., Seymour was selected by the New York Mets in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Kansas State University. After making four appearances in 2021, he began the 2022 season with Low-A St. Lucie, where he went 4-0 with a 1.19 ERA in seven outings (four starts). He was promoted to High-A Brooklyn on May 23 for 11 outings before being traded to the Giants on August 2 as part of the deal that sent Darin Ruf to the Mets. Seymour closed the year with High-A Eugene, going 2-3 with a 3.99 ERA in six starts. Seymour is rated by Baseball America as the No. 12 Giants prospect and No. 17 by MLB.com. **For more on Seymour, see page two.**

**FOR BOWIE:** Right-hander Peter Van Loon makes his eighth start of the year and his third appearance against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, he surrendered four runs over four innings in a loss against the Patriots on Thursday. He first faced Richmond on April 29 in a start and threw two scoreless innings. He pitched out of the bullpen on June 16 against the Flying Squirrels and did not allow a run over four innings of work, striking out a season-high seven batters. Van Loon was selected by the Orioles in the 16th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of UC Irvine.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all of Double-A in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history. This year, the Flying Squirrels are again at the top of the level in average attendance (6,564) and total attendance (242,866). The team's average attendance is the 13th-highest among the 120 MLB teams.

**A BUNCH OF SELLOUTS:** Tonight's game marks the third sellout of the 2023 season for the Flying Squirrels. On May 17, the Flying Squirrels beat the RubberDucks, 11-4, in front of 9,810 fans. On May 31, they lost to the SeaWolves, 10-3, in 10 innings with another 9,810 fans in the house. The Diamond has seen five crowds of at least 9,000 fans this season. Tonight is the 57th sellout in Flying Squirrels history. Since 2010, they have gone 43-27 in sellouts, including four doubleheaders.

**THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:** **Andy Thomas** has picked up 11 RBIs over his last seven games since June 24. From June 24-29, he collected nine RBIs over a four-game span, including a two-run homer on Thursday night at Reading. On Sunday night, he added a sac fly and a solo homer. In his last seven games, Thomas is batting .370 (10-for-27) with two homers, three doubles, a triple and 11 RBIs. For the season, Thomas leads the Flying Squirrels with 38 RBIs. Thomas had at least one extra-base hit in six consecutive games, the longest active streak in the Eastern League, prior to hitting two singles on Monday night.

**VAUN GONE WILD:** **Vaun Brown** is riding an eight-game hit streak since June 22. He has homered three times in that stretch, including home runs in each of the first two games of this week's series. In his last eight games, Brown is batting .361 (13-for-36) with three homers, four doubles and nine RBIs, adding three stolen bases. Over his previous nine games from June 9-20, Brown hit .057 (2-for-35) with three walks and 16 strikeouts.

**LONGBALL LOGAN:** Since his promotion to Double-A on June 13, **Logan Wyatt** is batting .306 (11-for-36) with three homers, two doubles and eight RBIs. Between his time with High-A Eugene and with Richmond, Wyatt has homered 11 times this season in 64 games. Wyatt hit his first Double-A homer on June 23 at The Diamond against the Senators. He hit his second Double-A home run on Thursday night at Reading and finished the game with four RBIs, which tied his career high. Wyatt added another homer, a solo shot, in a two-RBI performance on Friday. He has driven in six runs over his last three starts.

**RETURN OF THE MECK:** In Game 1 of June 23's doubleheader, **Wade Meckler** closed his historic performance with a two-run, walk-off single, giving the Flying Squirrels a 9-8 win in extras. Meckler went 5-for-5 and tied the single-game franchise record for hits. It was the 11th time a Richmond player has collected five hits in a game. In his five games of last week's series, Meckler reached base 13 times with 10 hits, including four on Thursday, and three walks. Meckler has now reached base in all 21 of his Double-A games, including 32 hits and 15 walks. His on-base streak is the longest active streak in the league and the longest by a Richmond player this season. He also leads the league with eight consecutive games scoring a run. Meckler leads all MiLB hitters (min. 180 PA) this season with a .417 batting average, a .484 OBP and a .468 BABIP. On Friday, he hit an inside-the-park homer, his first Double-A home run. It was the fourth inside-the-park home run in Flying Squirrels franchise history, joining **Brandon Crawford** (2010), **Tyler Graham** (2014) and **Tyler Fitzgerald** (2023).

**RAGIN' CANTRELLE:** In his last 15 games since June 14, **Hayden Cantrelle** has reached base 24 times, posting a .429 on-base percentage. In that stretch, he has picked up 11 hits, walked 11 times and been hit by a pitch twice in 56 plate appearances. This season, he has been hit by a pitch 13 times, the most in the Eastern League. He also ranks tied for sixth in the league in on-base percentage (.395) and tied for sixth in walks (46). He is second among Giants minor leaguers in walks for the year. On Monday at Reading, he hit his third home run of the season.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Marco Luciano** (No. 2), LHP **Carson Whisenhunt** (No. 6), OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 8), RHP **Mason Black** (No. 9), RHP **Carson Seymour** (No. 14), RHP **Landen Roupp** (No. 15), OF **Wade Meckler** (No. 16), RHP **Ryan Murphy** (No. 27) and RHP **José Cruz** (No. 30). Brown is rated by Baseball America as the best hitter for average and the best athlete, Luciano as the best power hitter, Meckler as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best change-up. Luciano is also ranked as Baseball America's No. 55-overall prospect. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes nine Richmond players, including Luciano (No. 2), Whisenhunt (No. 4), Brown (No. 6), Black (No. 9), Roupp (No. 12), Seymour (No. 16), Murphy (No. 25), Cruz (No. 28) and Meckler (No. 29). Luciano is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 17 prospect in baseball.
