# SLINGING STARTERS: Against Greenville this week, Hub City's starters

have combined for 21 innings pitched, 31 strikeouts and 2 earned runs. However, only one win has been earned by a starter, and all of them have gone 5 or more innings.

DAILY SPECIALS

SCAR RISING: Rangers No. 8 prospect Caden Scarborough, now the top Rangers' prospect on the Spartanburgers, made his High-A debut Thursday and struck out a career-high nine in five innings. Scarborough led High-A last night with 18 swings and misses. The Floridian had been lights out in Low-A Hickory, holding opponents to 3 ER over his last 34.1 IP.

COMFORTS OF HOME: The Spartanburgers put up 10 hits in the series opener, their 11th game at Fifth Third Park with double-digits. At home, Hub City is batting .223 as a team, and Malcolm Moore and John Taylor, Tuesday's 3- and 4-hole hitters, are batting .170 and .080 points better at home, respectively.

FIVE ALARM CURRY: Since returning from the ACL, Aidan Curry has racked up 27 strikeouts and only allowed three ER in 18 IP. Curry hasn't allowed more than 1 ER in an appearance since May 14.

BULLPEN BLUNDERS: Over the two week road trip, the Spartanburgers' bullpen allowed 33 runs, 31 of which were earned, over 41.1 IP. Bullpen arms were 1-6 with 2 saves in 8 opportunities.

TOP 30 RESHUFFLE: With the addition of the latest MLB draft prospects, Hub City's top prospects have been part of a Pipeline rerank. Malcolm Moore [#11] and Dylan Dreiling [#15] are still the 'Burgers' top prospects, but pitcher Dalton Pence was nudged out. Anthony Gutierrez also dropped down to No. 25.

RACE TO THE FINISH: Tied at 9-9 in head-to-head, this week's results will be a major factor in determining whether the Spartanburgers or Drive take the 2H playoff spot. Greenville plays v. BG and @ WS in their final two series. The tiebreaker if HC wins four games week is win % over the last 20 games of the season (HC 1-1, GVL 1-1 coming in).

### CLUB INFO & COACHING STAFF



The Hub City Spartanburgers, High-A affiliate of the Texas Rangers, were first announced in 2023. Diamond Baseball Holdings purchased the Down East

Wood Ducks, the Single-A Rangers affiliate at the time, and announced they would move the team to a new ballpark in Spartanburg, SC for the 2025 season. In May 2024, the team was announced with the name of "Hub City Spartanburgers". Two months later, MiLB decided that the Spartanburgers would be a member of the High-A South Atlantic League and the Hickory Crawdads would move down to Single-A. Tyson Jeffers was announced in October 2023 as the team's first general manager, and Chad Comer serves as the first manager in Spartanburger's history.

Fifth Third Park is the crown jewel of downtown Spartanburg. With Fifth Third Bank serving as the naming rights sponsor, the brand-new ball-park seats over 5,000 people. The Johnson



Group provided oversight on the project while Overland Partners served as the architect and Robins & Morton as the general contractor. The ballpark is a part of a \$425 million development in downtown Spartanburg, S.C. Groundbreaking took place with a ceremony on November 1, 2023. The ballpark officially opened for baseball on April 1, 2025 when Wofford College defeated USC Upstate 5-2 in the ballpark's first game. The next night, the Spartanburgers hosted the Hickory Crawdads for a preseason exhibition. The first official Sprartanburgers game is the home opener in 2025 against Bowling Green.



#### Chad Comer - Manager

Chad Comer is the first ever manager of the Hub City Spartanburgers. He enters his tenth year as a coach in the minor leagues and joins Hub City after two seasons as the manager of the then-High-A Hickory Crawdads. Comer played collegiately for the University of Texas-Arlington. A four-year starter, he was named to the Buster Posey Watch List prior to his senior season. He was drafted in the 29th round of the 2011 MLB Draft by the Atlanta Braves, and he played two seasons of minor league baseball.



#### **Drew Sannes - Hitting Coach**

Drew Sannes joins the Hub City Spartanburgers as the hitting coach for the 2025 season after spending the past two years as the hitting coach for the Hickory Crawdads. In 2022, Sannes served as a development coach for the ACL Rangers. His coaching career began in 2020 when he served as the head coach at North Iowa Community College. As a player, Sannes started his collegiate career at the University of North Dakota. He finished it hitting .275 in two seasons with Concordia University-St. Paul.



#### Thomas St. Clair - Pitching Coach

Thomas St. Clair begins his fourth season as a coach in the Texas Rangers organization and first as the pitching coach for the Hub City Spartanburgers. St. Clair previously served as the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College. The Winston-Salem, NC native played his college ball at Lenoir-Rhyne. He was drafted in the 24th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the St. Louis Cardinals. St. Clair played two seasons in the minor leagues.



#### Jav Sullenger - Development Coach

Jay Sullenger has served as a player development coach in the Rangers organization since 2019. Previously, Sullenger spent five years as the head coach at Biola University and over a decade as the associate head coach at James Madison University.



#### **Elevys Gonzalez - Development Coach**

Elevys Gonzalez began his Rangers coaching career in 2020 as a hitting coach in the DSL. He served as the DSL Rangers manager for two years before coming to the states. Gonzalez is a native of Venezuela and played professionally for six years in the minor leagues.
