**ABOUT LAST TIME...** Rafael Lantigua homered twice to lead the Vancouver Canadians to an 8-4 win over the Spokane Indians (Rockies) on Sunday afternoon at Ron Tonkin Field.

Lantigua's second blast proved to be the spark the C's needed. After he went deep in the third to turn a two-run deficit into a 2-1 game, the Puerto Plata, DR native came up in the fifth with two on and one out. He wrapped a line drive around the right field foul pole for an opposite field, three-run shot that put Vancouver ahead for good.

Leading 4-2, the Canadians went on to score four more runs in the inning thanks in part to a two-RBI double from Davis Schneider and an Andres Guerra RBI single. When the dust settled, the C's had matched a season high with seven runs in the inning and established a new mark with seven hits.

Starter Alejandro Melean went four and two-thirds, allowed two runs on six hits, walked one and K'd five before Hayden Juenger (W, 2-0), Roither Hernandez and Hagen Danner combined on the final four and a third.

With the win, the C's earned a split with Spokane this week and finished their season series against the Indians having won 17 of 30 games. Lantigua's multi-homer game was the third such by a C's hitter this year. His four RBI and two runs scored accounted for three-fourths of the Vancouver runs this afternoon. Trevor Schewecke had three hits while Will Robertson and Guerra had two hits apiece.

**BATTLE FOR THE 'BORO:** The Canadians go toe-to-toe with Hillsboro for their fifth and final series of the season. These two teams last met August 24-29 when they split a six-game set; that week, the Hops got the first two, the C's the next pair then they went 50/50 over the weekend. All told, Hillsboro has a 13-11 edge in the season series and needs to win three games to take the inaugural (and hopefully last) Battle for the 'Boro. Vancouver has been outscored 121-108 by the Baby Snakes.

**HOME AWAY FROM HOME:** Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

**ROSTER MOVES:** RHP Andrew Bash, C Anthony Morales, UTL Rafael Lantigua and 1B Spencer Horwitz have been promoted to Double-A New Hampshire. PK Morris, Addison Barger and Harry Ray have been transferred from Low-A Dunedin to Vancouver.

**KEEP 'EM COMIN':** The C's have homered in 15 of the last 18 games they've played and hit 19 dingers over their last 12.

**PAIN = GAIN:** The C's have been hit by a pitch 92 times this year, the most in the High-A West by a wide margin. The second highest total is 76 (Everett/Eugene).

**OOPS, HE DID IT AGAIN:** Phil Clarke has been named the High-A West Player of the Week for September 7-12, the second consecutive week he's earned the award and the first player in the circuit to go back-to-back this year. After rapping out 13 hits in five games against Everett, the former Vanderbilt Commodore used six hits - including two doubles and a pair of homers - to drive in 12 runs, scored four times and worked two walks. The highlight of his week was an eight RBI game on September 9 against Spokane. That night, he started his line with a bases-clearing double to score three in the bottom of the first, clubbed a three-run bomb in the fifth and doubled home another two in the sixth to lead the Canadians to a 14-5 rout.

**ACE OF ON BASE:** Tanner Morris has reached base in a season-high 38 consecutive games since July 25. He's 48-for-159 (.302) with eight doubles, a triple, two home runs, 21 runs scored, 22 RBI and 16 walks. In an even greater accomplishment, he's reach in 55 of his last 57.

**ON THE HILL:** #8 Blue Jays prospect Adam Kloffenstein gets the ball for Vancouver in the opener. He last worked on September 8 against Spokane and allowed five runs on six hits with three walks and seven strikeouts in 4.1 innings. He's 0-1 with an 8.27 ERA in four starts vs. the Hops

The Hops have tabbed Collin Sullivan as their starter. His last start was 13 days ago vs. Eugene when he got the win with five innings of one-run ball. He's 0-1 in one start against the C's.
