FRES-NOTES

BEAR MARKET: Fresno has done its best work against familiar North Division opponents, entering Thursday with a 19-14 record inside the CAL North. The Grizzlies have winning records against both Stockton and Visalia, including a 7-5 season-series edge over the Rawhide. With Fresno still chasing San Jose in the first-half race, these head-to-head games carry extra weight, and the Grizzlies have continued to keep themselves in the mix by handling business within the division.

RAW NUMBERS: Fresno's offense has consistently found answers against Visalia pitching this season, hitting .283 with a .365 OBP and .794 OPS across 12 meetings. The Grizzlies have piled up 77 runs, 117 hits and 74 RBI in the season series while forcing 48 walks. Fresno has also outscored Visalia 77-66, showing the lineup has been able to create separation even in a rivalry series that has featured plenty of back-and-forth scoring.

THE VERY GOOD K CORRAL: The Grizzlies' pitching staff has missed bats at a high rate against Visalia, striking out 121 Rawhide hitters in 106 innings this season. That works out to more than a strikeout per inning, with Fresno holding Visalia to a .253 average in the matchup. Even when the games have gotten chaotic, the swing-and-miss has remained a clear separator for the Grizzlies in the Highway 99 Rivalry.

CLOSING ARGUMENTS: Fresno now has two relievers tied near the top of the California League saves leaderboard, with Seth Clausen and Dylan Crooks both sitting at five saves. Crooks owns a 1.54 ERA while Clausen carries a 1.80 ERA, giving the Grizzlies two late-inning options who have handled leverage work throughout the first half. In a season filled with tight games, Fresno's ability to shorten the finish has become a major part of its identity.
