### Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Justin Campbell** to the mound tonight (16th professional game), looking to start the series 2-0 (3-1 after winning game one at home). Louisville will counter with LHP **Brandon Leibrandt**. Columbus is 8-16 (.333) versus left handers this year. Leibrandt has pitched against Columbus three times in his career, going 1-1 with a 3.07ERA (14.2IP, 9H, 5R, 5ER, 2BB, 8K).

### vs. the Bats

Columbus was 7-11 against Louisville last year, going 4-10 in the last 14G to lose the season series for the third straight year (4-0 from 2018-22). The Clippers took the series 3-2 in the first half of the season, with each team scoring 18 runs. **George Valera** has collected 6HR and 14RBI in 29G opposing Louisville, while **Kody Huff** owns 2HR and 12RBI in 17G.

### Making Do

Giving up 10 hits to the Bats, the Clippers evened their record to 15-15 when allowing the opposition to reach double digits (leads IL, 2nd is Gwinnett: .417). Additionally, they improved to 15-27 (.357, 2nd in the IL) when having as many hits or fewer than the opponents. Columbus is the only team in the IL with both a negative run (-14, 14th) and hit differential (-10, 12th) with a winning record (.556, 6th).

### Angel Ascendant

**Angel Genao** has turned in a 1.011OPS over his last 12G, batting .349 (15x43) while drawing 8BB in 53PA (15%) over that time (11BB in 139PA, 8%, in first 35G with Columbus). Genao has scored 10 times in those 12G, while collecting 9RBI and 5XBH (.558SLG). Most of that success has come later in the game, as he has slashed .303/.409/.528 off opposing relievers (17BB, has 2BB against starters).

### Brito Slump

**Juan Brito** is hitting .179/.326/.244 in his last 21G, though he is 6x19 (.316) over his last 6G. Last night's 2-run single to tie the game in the 9th marked his first multi-RBI game since 5/29 at Toledo (24G between). He has still not scored more than once in a game since 6/2 vs. Omaha (22G) and has just a pair of multi-hit games since producing a pair in his first 2G to start the month of June.

### Fourth and Two

**Ralph Velazquez** will be making his 32nd start at the cleanup spot tonight (all 36 starts with Akron were #2). His bomb on Sunday was just the second homer from the #4 Clipper in the last 50G (last team in MiLB to hit multiple homers since 5/2). While the .376SLG produced in that time ranks 18th in the IL, Columbus cleanup hitters have still managed the 4th best exit velocity (91.0mph).

### More Ralphy

**Ralph Velazquez** extended his career best on base streak to 21G last night (.387OBP since 6/3), while embiggening his hit streak to a perfectly cromulent 8G (.375, 12x32, since 6/20; 3G short of career high with Lynchburg in '24). His on base streak currently ranks tied for 6th longest among active streaks in the IL (**Kody Huff** is tied for 8th at 20G). Velazquez has just 1XBH in his last 13G (.400SLG).

### Not Walking or Running

**George Valera's** team-best 21G on base streak (.418OBP) was snapped with a pinch-hit strikeout on 6/11, and though he has reached in seven of eight since (.290OBP), he has drawn just 1BB (31PA; 14BB in last 50PA of streak). He has just one run scored this month (13G), following 10 runs in his last 14G of May. Valera has cut his strikeout rate to 17% this season (27% from 2022-25).

### Frias Feeling It

**Dayan Frias** is hitting .313 (10x32) in his last 9G, after having gone 2x27 (.074) in his previous 15G (5/6-6/16). On Sunday, Frias was successful on his seventh straight steal attempt (**Petey Halpin** has stolen 16 straight, dating to last season), tying **Kahilil Watson** for the team lead with 15SB. Frias has not seen his batting average rise above .200 since a season high of .208 on 4/8.

### Solid Trip

**Milan Tolentino** was 8x19 (.421) in 5G at Omaha, collecting hits on 67% of balls put in play (7K in 21PA). Dating to the nightcap vs. Scranton/WB on 6/19, he is 11x27 (.407) in his last 8G, collecting 6XBH (.741SLG) and 8RBI. Sunday's HR (31st off RHP in IL career, 0HR off LHP) put him halfway to his second 20-20 season (only Clipper ever to achieve the feat; currently at 9SB, none since 5/30).

# Columbus Clippers Game Information

Wednesday, July 1

## This Date in Clipper History

7/1/2016

**Ronny Rodriguez** hit a pair of go-ahead homers, a solo shot in the 3rd and a 3-run blast in the 6th, to lead the Clippers to a 5-4 win at McCoy Stadium in Pawtucket. After hitting 2HR through 6/30 (261AB), Ronny hit 8HR over the rest of the year (189AB) to turn in his 4th season of double digit dingers in six years. Unfortunately for the Clippers, he got hurt right before the IL Playoffs and appeared in only one game.

## First Half Wrap

Despite being eliminated from playoff contention on the penultimate Sunday of the first half, the Clippers were 41-33 and finished with their first winning record in the front half since the season was split in 2023 (averaged 32 wins from 2023-25, topping out at 34-38, .472, last season). From 4/22-6/17, they spent every day between 3.0 and 6.0 games off the lead, while occupying anywhere between 4th and 13th in the standings. A late push (15-6 from 5/16-6/9) got them to within 2.5 before derailing with a 3G losing streak at Indy to seal their fate. On the back half, Columbus has posted just one winning record, clinching a playoff berth in 2024 with a mark of 48-26 (.649).

## Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,447 to 1,396).

## Challenging Times

The Clippers are 118-99 (.544) in pitch reviews, with batters going 61-65 (.484) and pitchers/catchers going 57-34 (.626). They have run out of challenges in 36G and have not challenged in 3G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

## Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 5-3 in extra innings this year, after having gone .500 in each of the last two seasons. Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 55-36 when playing past regulation (.604, best in the IL; no other team above .571), including 27-17 at home (.614; 5-7 in last 12G). Of the 91G to require extra play, 72 have been resolved after one frame (including nine DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 on 9/20/22 at Toledo).

## On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to top 800 again (on pace for 822, would rank as 4th most all-time; record is 898 scored in 1983).

## On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 101 through the first 81G (on pace for 186SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 26CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the 4th most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (48; nabbed 51 times in 2024).

## Crazy Eighthths

From the 8th inning on, the Clippers have scored an IL-best 130 runs while crafting a .935OPS (over 100 points better than all other teams). On the flipside, Columbus has given up 65 runs from the 8th on, resulting in a +65 run differential (Clippers are getting outscored 194-127 from innings 5-7).

## Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 78 grand slams and 1,950RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

## In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.33 through the first 81G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). However, the staff is pacing to give up only 173HR (average of 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

## Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 8th in the IL this year (.980), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 43G this season (27-16, .628), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

## Good Baseball

**Milan Tolentino** bunted the winning run into scoring position in an extra-inning win at Indianapolis on 6/14. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 88-23 (.793) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 5-2 mark this season (.714, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

## To the End

The Clippers have the most last at bat wins this year (14, tied with Syracuse) while playing in the most games decided in the last at bat (23, tied with Omaha). Since the start of the 2024 season, Columbus has played in 97G decided in the last at bat (2nd most in the IL), going 48-49 (.495, 14th best winning percentage; 3rd most wins, 2nd most losses).

## Manager Profile

**Andy Tracy** made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 431-442 (.494), 401-396 with Columbus (.503).
