Today: It's the first Capital City Market Kids Day of the year as the Lugnuts look to avoid a three-game sweep against Lake County. Former Michigan Wolverine Jeff Criswell makes his season debut, opposed by Lake County right-hander Tommy Mace, a product of the University of Florida.

Familiar Opponent: This is the fifth season all-time that the Nuts have opened against Lake County, following prior engagements at Lake County on Opening Day 2013 (a 5-4 loss), at Lake County on Opening Day 2014 (an 8-2 win), at home against the Captains on Opening Day 2015 (a 3-2 win), and last year, May 4, Opening Day 2021, in which the Nuts bested the Caps, 8-1, behind a first-inning home run from Jordan Diaz and seven strikeouts in four scoreless innings from Seth Shuman.

On Deck: The Nuts enjoy an off-day tomorrow before traveling to West Michigan for a six-game road trip. Then the Lugnuts return home to welcome in the Fort Wayne TinCaps from April 19-24.

Capital Clash: On Friday, April 15, with the Lugnuts playing on the road at the Whitecaps, the Michigan State Spartans will host the Michigan Wolverines at Jackson® Field™ in the Capital Clash. First pitch is set for 5:05 p.m., with tickets available at lansinglugnuts.com. MSU and Michigan played the first game in the history of Jackson® Field™, then called Oldsmobile Park, on April 3, 1996. Michigan won, 5-4, in 10 innings.

### Lug•Notes

Crosstown Showdown presented by Delta Dental: The Nuts unofficially opened 2022 with their 14th exhibition against the Michigan State Spartans, triumphing 3-2 on Wednesday night behind a **Jack Winkler** two-run double and an **Euribiel Ángeles** sacrifice fly. **Joey Estes** struck out five batters in four two-hit innings and **Osvaldo Berrios** notched a three-inning save, whiffing three, to lock down the Nuts' ninth straight win in the series, improving to 12-2 against Michigan State.

Meet the Boss: 31-year-old Phil Pohl is the 17th manager in Lugnuts team history. Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Pohl grew up in Cooperstown, starring at Cooperstown Central High School and earning the honor of 2008 New York High School Baseball Player of the Year. Pohl turned down the Tampa Bay Rays' contract offer as a 44th-round draft pick to attend Clemson University, where he distinguished himself as a two-time team captain and three-time ACC Academic Honor Roll selection. Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012, the same draft that netted Oakland Matt Olson and Max Muncy, and rose as high as Triple-A Sacramento in four MiLB seasons. Upon retiring following the 2015 season. Pohl rejoined the A's as MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his coaching debut.

Historic: With Pohl hailing from Cooperstown, the Hall of Fame has asked for his game-worn baseball cap from the start of this season for its archives

Talent Rich: The Nuts boast the No. 1 prospect in the Athletics' organization in 2020 first-rounder Tyler Soderstrom, a 20-year-old catcher drafted out of Turlock H.S. who is considered MLB Pipeline's No. 56 prospect in all of baseball. Soderstrom is one of six Top 25 A's prospects on the roster, joining teenager Brayan Buelvas (No. 10) and Euribiel Ángeles (No. 11), tonight's starting pitcher Joey Estes (No. 19), first baseman/outfielder Lawrence Butler (No. 21) and pitcher Jeff Criswell (No. 22).

Welcome Back: The 2022 Nuts return two coaches (hitting coach Javier Godard and pitching coach Don Schulze) and 12 players from last season, namely pitchers Osvaldo Berrios, Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels and David Leal; catcher Jared McDonald; infielders Brett Harris, Patrick McColl and Drew Swift; and outfielders Lazaro Armenteros, Austin Beck, Jonny Butler and Lawrence Butler.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The lvy League is well represented on the Lansing roster, thanks to first baseman Patrick McColl (Harvard) and reliever Kumar Nambiar (Yale). This comes a year after Michael Danielak (Dartmouth) and catcher William Simoneit (Cornell) joined McColl on the Lugnuts' roster; both begin this season with Double-A Midland.

Recent Acquisitions: Three Lugnuts – pitcher Joey Estes, infielder Euribiel Ángeles and outfielder Gabriel Maciel – join the Athletics organization for the 2022 season from outside the system. Estes was picked up from Atlanta in a four-player package for first baseman Matt Olson on March 14, 2022; Ángeles was acquired from San Diego with a fellow prospect for pitcher Sean Manaea on April 3, 2022; and Maciel was selected in the Rule 5 Draft Triple-A portion from the Minnesota Twins on December 3, 2021. Both Ángeles (Fort Wayne TinCaps) and Maciel (Cedar Rapids Kernels) faced the Lugnuts in 2021, with Maciel hitting a walk-off grand slam against David Leal on June 23, 2021, one of his two home runs during the season.

International Appeal: In addition to the 15 states plus Puerto Rico represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, the Nuts hail from Brazil, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Panama and Venezuela.

2022 Champ: Outfielder Brayan Buelvas, the youngest player on the team at 19 years old, has already won a title this year. Buelvas started in all seven games in center field for Team Colombia, champions of the 2022 Caribbean Series, where he hit .273 (6-for-22, all singles).

**Prospecting:** Criswell is currently Keith Law's No. 12 overall A's prospect, MLB.com's No. 9 A's pitching prospect and No. 22 overall prospect, and Fangraphs' No. 15 A's prospect... MLB Pipeline's grades: Fastball 60, Curve 50, Slider 55, Change 55, Control 45, writing about him, "Criswell's success as both a starter and reliever at the University of Michigan led to him landing a \$1 million signing bonus from the A's as a second-round pick in the 2020 Draft. After injuries limited him to just 12 innings pitched at High-A – editor's note: that's us, the Lugnuts! – in what would have been his first full season with the organization, he did manage to end his year on a high note by returning in time to play in the Arizona Fall League and ranking among the league's top strikeout leaders.... He's been described as Bassittish in reference to Chris Bassitt for similarities in their athletic builds."

**Fall Ball:** Made six appearances, three starts, for the Mesa Solar Sox: 2-1, 6.75 ERA, 22 2/3 IP, 26 H, 17 R/ER, 5 HR, 12 BB, 32 K, 3 HBP, 1 balk, 1.68 WHIP... 12.7 K/9 IP.

Last Year: Began 2021 as the highest ranked prospect on the Lugnuts' Opening Day roster: Keith Law's No. 5 overall A's prospect, MLB.com's No. 3 A's pitching prospect and No. 14 overall prospect, and Baseball America's No. 14 A's prospect. Wrote Law, "Criswell was mostly a two-pitch guy up to 95 mph at Michigan, but was showing four pitches and hitting 97 mph in instructs, with a cleaner delivery than the violent one he'd had before the shutdown. Criswell's slider was a swing-and-miss pitch in college and it's gotten sharper now, while his changeup, which he barely used in school, was flashing plus in instructs too." ... started the fifth game of the Lugnuts season, May 8 vs. Lake County, and tossed two easy scoreless innings, but then spent May 12-August 27 on the Injured List, limiting season.

**Personal:** Criswell played the trombone, cello and guitar while growing up "but I didn't have any serious musical talent, that's probably why I took the career path I did"... his father, Brian, was drafted by the A's in the 17th round in 1984 from Western Michigan and pitched in the Midwest League for the Madison Muskies, today's West Michigan Whitecaps, eventually reaching Double-A Huntsville, where he was teammates in 1986 with Mark McGwire... Jeff's mother, Patti, has written books for the American Girl company... Jeff's sister, Natalie, was a record-setting swimmer at Bowling Green State University.

Hail to the Victors: Rated Perfect Game's No. 1 high school right-hander in Michigan in 2017 while at Portage Central, Criswell was drafted by the Tigers in the 35th round in 2017... turned them down and went to Ann Arbor... named All-Big Ten First Team as a sophomore (2.72, 116 K in 106 IP) and was a key contributor in leading the Wolverines on their run to College World Series Runner-Up to national champion Vanderbilt... in all, went 10-4, 2.88, 50 G, 162 1/3 IP, 174 K at Michigan.

The Run to Omaha: A look at how important Jeff was to the Wolverines in their 2019 path to the College World Series National Championship:

NCAA Regional: Struck out nine in 7 2/3 innings in a 10-4 comeback victory over Cincinnati. Michigan went on to eliminate No. 22 Creighton to advance.

NCAA Super Regional: Facing No. 1 UCLA, relieved Karl Kauffman with the potential tying and game-winning runs aboard in the bottom of the ninth and dispatched Jake Pries with a pop-up and Jack Stronach with a strikeout to secure a thrilling 3-2 win. Started the very next day and allowed one earned run in 5 1/3 innings, departing with a 3-2 lead, only to see the Bruins win 5-4 in 12 innings. Michigan went on to eliminate UCLA in Game 3, advancing.

College World Series: Pitched the final two innings scorelessly, earning the save, in a 5-3 CWS-opening win over No. 8 Texas Tech, striking out Brian Klein with the tying runs aboard to end the game. Earned another save in a rematch with Texas Tech six days later, firing the final three innings scorelessly with six strikeouts to complete a 15-3 romp, sending the Wolverines into the CWS Finals against No. 2 Vanderbilt. Secured the final two outs in Game 1 against the Commodores, a 7-4 UM win. Worked the final five innings in relief, striking out seven, in Michigan's Game 3 series-clinching 8-2 loss to Vandy.

National Pride: Following the 2019 college baseball season, Jeff was invited to pitch for the Team USA Collegiate National Team. GHe recorded yet another crucial save, firing the final three innings against Taiwan in Game 2 of their three-game series. In all, he limited opposing batters to a .120 average, best of all pitchers on the team.
