Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Memphis Redbirds play game two of a six-game series tonight at AutoZone Park. Memphis won the first game last night, 5-1. Left-hander Aaron Ashby starts for Nashville tonight against right-hander Angel Rondon for Memphis.

Aaron Ashby: 23-year-old Aaron Ashby makes his 21st appearance (12th start) for the Sounds tonight. In 62.1 innings, Ashby has allowed 54 hits and 32 walks to go along with 98 strikeouts. He last pitched on August 14 in a start against Pittsburgh and went 4.0 shutout innings in game two of Milwaukee's doubleheader. He allowed 3 hits and struck out 4. Ashby has made three appearances for the Brewers and is 0-0 with a 5.40 ERA (4 ER/6.2 IP). In Ashby's 2019 campaign, he went 5-10 with a 3.50 ERA in 24 games (23 starts) with Advanced-A Carolina and Single-A Wisconsin. He was named the Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Year and a Mid-Season Midwest League All-Star. He spent 2020 at the Brewers Alternate Training Site.

Angel Rondon: 23-year-old Angel Rondon starts for the Redbirds tonight. The right-hander is 5-4 with a 4.83 ERA in 15 games (12 starts) with Memphis in 2021. He has also pitched in two games with the Cardinals. Rondon last pitched on August 11 in a start against Norfolk and allowed 2 runs on 4 hits in 5.0 innings of a no decision. He went 11-7 with a 2.93 ERA in 28 starts in 2019 with Advanced-A Palm Beach and Double-A Springfield. He was named a Florida State League Mid-Season All-Star and a MiLB Organization All-Star. Additionally, he was named 2019 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year and led the Texas League in ERA. Rondon entered the season ranked as the No. 11 prospect in the Cardinals organization by MLB Pipeline.

2021 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 23, Second: 59, Third: 5, Fourth: 14, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

Ashby's Return: Tonight's start by Aaron Ashby is his first with Nashville since he dominated the Toledo Mud Hens over 6.0 shutout innings on August 5. Since then, Ashby has combined to toss 6.0 scoreless innings for Milwaukee (August 10 at Chicago-NL and August 14 at Pittsburgh). Ashby's 98 strikeouts are the second-most in the Triple-A East League behind only Omaha's Jackson Kowar's 99.

vs. Rondon: The Sounds faced Angel Rondon back on May 13 at First Horizon Park and handed him a loss. The following active Sounds have faced Rondon this year: Mario Feliciano: 0-1, RBI; Keston Hiura: 2-2, R, 2 2B; Dustin Peterson: 1-2, R, RBI; Corey Ray: 0-2, K; Daniel Robertson: 0-2.

Fourth Place: Last night's loss dropped the Sounds into sole possession of fourth place in the Southeast Division. They had not seen fourth place since beginning play in the slot on May 20 vs. Gwinnett.

Corey's Comeback: After missing the majority of the months of June and July, outfielder Corey Ray has returned with force. Since being reinstated from the injured list on July 30, Ray has played in 12 games in the month of August and is hitting .319 (15-for-47) with 10 runs, 2 doubles, 1 triple, 3 home runs, 6 RBI and 4 walks. His OPS in the 13 games is .968.

Hiura is Back in Action: Infielder Keston Hiura was reinstated from the 10-day injured list (covid) yesterday and has re-joined the Sounds. Hiura has played in 21 games with Nashville this year and is hitting .405 (30-for-74) with 15 runs, 8 doubles, 5 home runs, 14 RBI and 14 walks. He has reached base safely in every game he has played with the Sounds.

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,081-1,965. The 2,081 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.

LAST OUTING: Ashby last worked on August 14 in a start for the Milwaukee Brewers against the Pittsburgh Pirates at PNC Park. He tossed 4.0 shutout innings, allowed 3 hits and struck out 4. He threw 41 of his 58 pitches for strikes in Milwaukee's 6-0 win.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Ashby has faced Memphis once in his career, a May 12 start at First Horizon Park. He threw 2.2 innings in a no decision and allowed 1 run on 2 hits. He walked 5 batters and struck out 3 in Nashville's 9-6 win.
