Today: It's the second game of a six-game set between the Lansing Lugnuts and the Great Lakes Loons. These are the Lugnuts' final road games of the year, and it began with a loss in the series opener last night, the Nuts' ninth loss in their last eleven road games.

Last Night: Loons 5, Lugnuts 4. **Jake Reinisch** homered and **Breyson Guedez** delivered a go-ahead RBI single in the 7th, but Great Lakes rallied in the 8th on a Victor Rodrigues sacrifice fly and an **Abel Mercedes** wild pitch to take a come-from-behind victory. **Jose Parra** allowed two runs in 3 1/3 innings in his Midwest League debut, receiving a no-decision.

On the Air: **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** and the Voice of Central Michigan University, **Adam Jaksa**, deliver the call on milb.streamguys1.com/lansing, while **John Vicari** and **Brad Tunney** call the game on Bally Live and MiLB TV.

On Deck: The Nuts play the Loons through Sunday, wrapping up the road schedule, before returning home on Tuesday, September 1, to welcome in the Fort Wayne TinCaps in a season-ending seven-game, six-day homestand.

LUG-NOTES

Transaction: The Lugnuts added pitcher **Chen Zhong-Ao Zhuang** today on Minor League rehab assignment from Triple-A. The Taiwanese right-hander, affectionately nicknamed "Z Man," posted a 2.56 ERA in nine appearances spanning 31 2/3 innings with the Lugnuts in 2024, with a remarkable 3:29 BB:K ratio. He spent all of 2025 in Double-A Midland (6-11, 4.08 ERA, 145 K in 145 2/3 IP) and was added to the A's 40-man roster entering 2026. But Zhuang landed on the 7-day IL from May 4-30 and was designed for assignment on July 31, going back on the Injured List on August 6. When he appears in a game for Lansing, it will be his first action since July 29.

Who's Streaking:

- **Jake Reinisch** went 2-for-4 with a walk, single and home run last night to extend his team-high on-base streak to 35 games. Reinisch is batting .299 with a .450 OBP and a .521 slugging pct. during the streak, with 35 base hits and 30 walks.
- **Daniel Bucciero** went 0-for-2 with two walks last night to extend his own on-base streak to 21 games. Bucciero is batting .274 with a .418 OBP and a .425 slugging pct. during the streak, with 20 base hits and 15 walks.

The Kid's Alright: 18-year-old **Breyson Guedez** went 2-for-3 with a walk yesterday, giving him 145 base hits this year. That ranks three behind Sacramento's **Sandy Bandura** for the most in MiLB. Great Lakes' **Mairo Martinus** has 146 hits, tied with 2026 Lugnut **Devin Taylor**.

Moving On Up: The Lugnuts have seen above-average roster movement, with 17 players moving to the upper levels of the minors...

- 2026 Nuts **Ryan Magdic**, **Jake Garland** and **Davis Diaz** have reached Triple-A Las Vegas.
- **Nathan Dettmer**, **Jay Dill**, **Steven Echavarria**, **Jackson Finley**, **Ben Hansen**, **Blaze Pontes**, **Zane Taylor**, **Logan Sauve**, **Bobby Boser**, **Ali Camarillo**, **Jared Sprague-Lott**, **Nate Nankil** and **Devin Taylor** are with Double-A Midland.
- **Kyle Robinson** was traded to Pittsburgh, then swapped again to the Angels at the deadline; he is now with Double-A Rocket City.

Major League Lugnuts: Ten former Nuts have made their MLB debuts this season: **Daniel Susac** for the Giants, **Junior Perez** for the White Sox, **Eduardo Rivera** for the Red Sox, and **Henry Bolte**, **Gage Jump**, **Kade Morris**, **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer**, **Tommy White** and **Yunior Tur** for the Athletics, and **Jack Weisenburger** with the NY Mets. In all 48 Lugnuts have appeared in a Major League game this season.

Organizational Showdown: The A's and Dodgers are meeting up for the next six days in... the California League (Stockton Ports vs. Ontario Tower Buzzers)... the Midwest League (Lansing Lugnuts vs. Great Lakes Loons)... and Texas League (Midland RockHounds vs. Tulsa Drillers). **Scoreboard check:** The Ports and RockHounds both won last night, 5-4 and 5-2 respectively, so the A's lead, 2-1.

Playoff Perspective:

- The Lugnuts trail the Loons by 7.0 games in the Midwest League East Division with only 12 games to go, giving Lansing an elimination number of 6: any number of Nuts losses and Loons wins equaling 6 would eliminate Lansing from postseason contention. So... a loss today would bring the number to 4. Pretty dire.
- Down in the California League, the Stockton Ports (30-25) are in good shape, leading Fresno (29-26) by one game for the final remaining North Division playoff berth. Ontario (32-23) leads the South Division by four games over Inland Empire (28-27), meaning this week's Stockton/Ontario series is a potential championship preview.
- In the Texas League, Midland (26-26) trails first place Amarillo (29-23) by three games, while Tulsa (29-23) already won the first half division title.
- And in the PCL, defending champion Las Vegas (28-24) is already in the postseason after winning the first half and is now waiting to see whom it will play in the championship series.

AUGUST 26 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2012: The Lugnuts tied the franchise record with their 78th win of the season (on their way to 82 in the season) and pitched their league-leading 16th shutout of the year, with Noah Syndergaard (5 IP, 4 K), Brandon Berl (2 IP) and Ian Kadish (2 IP) combining on a five-hitter at home over Fort Wayne, 4-0. Nick Baligod went 3-for-4 with a walk to lead the offense.

2013: Into every season drops an element of fun, and on one late August day, the Lugnuts' offense threw themselves a party. Dalton Pompey homered twice and tied the franchise record with five runs scored, Emilio Guerrero came a triple away from hitting for the cycle, Jordan Leyland (3-5, 2 R, 6 RBI) launched a grand slam, Chris Hawkins tied the franchise record with four walks, and the Lugs scored in every inning except the 2nd on their way to a home 18-6 thrashing of Dayton.
