THIS DATE IN HISTORY

The last time the Sounds played against New Orleans on May 30 was back in 2005. The Sounds beat the Zephyrs 3-2 in the contest, as future Milwaukee Brewers Rickie Weeks, Prince Fielder and Corey Hart were in the lineup. Ben Hendrickson earned the win while Chad Paronto earned the save.

Today's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Columbus Clippers play the finale of a six-game series today at Huntington Park. Zach Green crushed two home runs to lead the Nashville Sounds to an 8-3 win over the Columbus Clippers Saturday night at Huntington Park. Right-hander Bowden Francis gets the ball for Nashville today against left-hander Tanner Tully for Columbus.

Bowden Francis: 25-year-old Bowden Francis starts for the Sounds in the series finale. Francis is making his first Triple-A start after being transferred from Double-A Biloxi to Nashville on May 29. The right-hander has gone 3-1 with a 3.86 ERA (9 ER/21.0 IP) in four starts with Biloxi. He has posted 26 strikeouts and held opposing hitters to a .222 average. In 2019, Francis went 8-9 with a 3.97 ERA (63 ER/142.2 IP) in 28 games (27 starts) between Advanced-A Carolina and Double-A Biloxi. He led all Brewers farmhands in strikeouts (165) and finished among leaders in starts (T-1st), opponent batting average (4th, .233) and innings pitched (5th). He also finished among Southern League leaders in starts (T-3rd, 24), strikeouts (4th, 145) and innings pitched (5th, 128.2).

Tanner Tully: 26-year-old Tanner Tully gets the ball for Columbus today. The left-hander is 1-3 with a 7.85 ERA (16 ER/18.1 IP) in 4 games between Double-A Akron and Columbus. He made his last start on May 25 vs. Nashville and pitched 6.0 innings and gave up 5 runs on 6 hits and struck out 4. In 2019, Tully went 9-12 with a 4.44 ERA (71 ER/144.0 IP) between Double-A Akron and Columbus. He was selected by Cleveland in the 26th round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft.

2021 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 5, Second: 5, Third: 1, Fourth: 13, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

On a Roll: Nashville's 11-game winning streak is the longest the club has had in nearly three years and is the longest active winning streak in Minor League Baseball. The Double-A Somerset Patriots (New York Yankees) won seven straight games. The last time a Sounds team won six or more games was the 15-game winning streak that matched a franchise record from July 29-August 14, 2018.

In The History Book: The Sounds have the clubs best record through the first 22 games of the season. The 2010 and 2003 teams held the previous best mark at 16-6.

Grass Is Always Greener: Zach Green recorded his 10th career multi-homer game in last night's win (last - 7/5/19 at Reno). He has hit 5 home runs and 10 RBI in his last five games. He is among Triple-A East leaders in home runs (1st, 9), RBI (1st, 25), slugging (2nd, .750), extra-base hits (T-2nd, 13), total bases (5th, 51) and OPS (6th, 1.088).

Ashby Rolling: Ashby is 2-0 with a 1.69 ERA (2 ER/10.2 IP) in his last two starts and posted season-highs in strikeouts (9), innings pitched (5.2), pitches (95) and strikes (62) last night. Nashville is 5-0 in his starts this season.

Road Warriors: The Sounds have won 8 straight games on the road and are averaging 7.75 runs per game during that span.

Going Back-To-Back: Tyrone Taylor and Jake Hager hit back-to-back home runs on May 28 in the 3rd inning. It was the first back-to-back homers for the Sounds since August 28, 2019 at Omaha (Matt Davidson and Jett Bandy, 5th inning).

Big Fly: Weston Wilson recorded his first multi-homer game of the season and the fourth of his career (last - 5/12/19 at Jacksonville) on May 28. It marked the first time this season that a Sound has had a multi-homer game and the first since August 10, 2019 (Patrick Wisdom at Sacramento).

Clutch Long Ball: Out of the 39 total home runs the Sounds have hit, 14 of them have been game-tying or go-ahead homers. Three of Zach Green's nine home runs are go-ahead blasts.

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,044-1,926. The 2,044 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.
