### Syracuse Mets News and Notes

Turning It Around: Since May 24th, the Syracuse Mets rank seventh in the 20-team International League with a .258 batting average and rank second with 159 runs scored in 26 games. From the beginning of the season to May 23rd, the Mets were last in the league with a .205 batting average and ranked second to last with 154 runs scored in 40 games.

Giveaways: Syracuse leads the International League with 80 errors this season. Norfolk ranks second with 70. The Mets have allowed the third-most unearned runs in the League with 51 of 366 total runs allowed being unearned. Norfolk leads the lead with 63 unearned runs allowed out of 381

Streaking: Travis Blankenhorn has reached base in 25 of his last 29 games, including hits in 22 of 29. During his last 29 games since May 12th, Blankenhorn is hitting .308 (33-for-107) with 15 RBIs, three home runs, eight doubles, eight walks, 27 strikeouts, and a .362 on-base percentage

From the beginning of the season to May 11th, Blankenhorn hit .167 with 12 RBI, 4 homers, three doubles, four walks, 28 strikeouts, and a .216 on-base

Power Surge: Since May 2nd, Mark Vientos is hitting .308 (33 for-107), with 23 RBIs, ten home runs, three doubles, 12 walks and a .388 on-base percentage in 27 games. Vientos was on Syracuse's 7-day Injured List from June 3rd until he was activated on June 12th, hitting four home runs in his first three games back.

From the beginning of the season to May 1st, Vientos was hitting .164 (9-for-55) with seven RBIs, a home run, four doubles, a triple, nine walks, 22 strikeouts, and a .288 on-base percentage in 18 games.

Lee Isn't Playing Little: Since May 25th, Khalil Lee has found a groove at the plate. In 12 games, the 23-year-old is hitting .354 (17-for-48) with 12 RBIs, four home runs, seven doubles, nine runs scored, and a .446 on-base percentage.

In his first 23 games, Lee hit .141 with no home runs, three doubles, 12 walks, 34 strikeouts, and a .264 on-base percentage. Last season, Lee hit .274 in 102 games with Syracuse, adding 20 doubles, 14 home runs and 37 RBIs with 8 stolen bases.

Do the Palka: Since reaching a season-low batting average of .205 on May 28th, Daniel Palka has reached base in 20 consecutive games. During this stretch, the 30-year-old is hitting .367 (29-for-79) with 20 RBIs, five home runs, six doubles, 16 runs scored, nine walks, 21 strikeouts, and a .432 onbase percentage.

From the beginning of the season to April 29th, Palka hit .288 (15-for-52) with 20 RBIs, six home runs, five doubles, 13 runs scored, 11 walks, 12 strikeouts, and a .413 on-base percentage.

From April 30th to May 28th, Palka hit .150 (12-for-80) with seven RBIs, four home runs, ten runs scored, nine walks, 27 strikeouts, and a .236 on-base percentage.

Timelier Hitting: The Syracuse Mets are 15th in the league hitting with runners in scoring position out of 20 teams with a .243 batting average with runners at second and/or third. Syracuse has been trending better the last five
