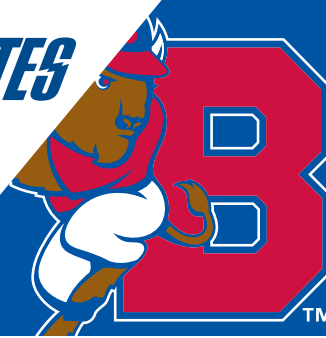

### NOTES AND NUGGETS

#### SEASON 57

2026 marks the 57th season (58th year) in franchise history and the 15th season (16th year) in the Storm Chasers era.

Omaha is coming off a 2025 campaign in which they went 62-86 (.419 winning %) to finish tied 17th in the 20-team International League ... the 2025 Chasers tied for the MiLB lead with 199 home runs, the 4th-most in a season in franchise history.

#### LONG TIME, NO SEE

This week, the Storm Chasers welcome the Bisons to Werner Park for the first time, with the series marking the Bisons' first trip to Omaha since 1997.

Omaha and Buffalo played in the Triple-A American Association together from 1985 until 1997 ... in 1998, Omaha moved to the Pacific Coast League and Buffalo joined the International League, with Omaha joining the IL in 2021.

In 1997, the Omaha Royals and Buffalo Bisons played 18 games against each other, including 9 at Rosenblatt Stadium ... the most recent trip for Buffalo to Omaha was July 18 to 20, 1997 ... Buffalo went 10,481 days between games in Omaha, between July 1997 and this week.

#### DOUBLE THE TROUBLE

Today, the Storm Chasers play a doubleheader against Buffalo, Omaha's first twin-bill of 2026 and the Bisons' second.

Omaha played 3 doubleheaders last year, after playing 7 in 2024 and just 1 in 2023 ... this doubleheader ties for the earliest in the season Omaha has played a doubleheader, after splitting a doubleheader in Columbus on April 4, 2024.

In the Modern Omaha Era (since 2005), Omaha is 101-117 in doubleheader games ... last year, the Chasers were swept twice and split once, with a Game 2 win on June 6 vs. Iowa snapping a stretch of 8 straight doubleheader games lost.

#### SEARCHING FOR NUMBER ONE

Wednesday, the Chasers finally secured their first win of the 2026 season, after being swept over the weekend in Louisville and dropping the home opener to Buffalo.

Offensively, infielders **Josh Rojas** and **Peyton Wilson** have both recorded hits in all 5 games they've played this season the season, while **Abraham Toro** has reached base in each of Omaha's first 6 games.

A strong suit for the team so far is the team's bullpen ... 15 of 23 relief appearances through the first 6 games have been scoreless, with 4 relievers combining to offer 6.0 innings to finish a combined shutout Wednesday ... **Eli Morgan** has retired all 10 batters he's faced this season, while **Eric Cerantola** has gotten out 10 of 13 (77%), **Mason Black** has retired 15 of 20 opposing hitters (75%) and **Shane Panzini** has retired 12 of 16 faced (75%), including 2.0 perfect innings Wednesday.

#### OS-BORN FOR THE JOB

**Patrick Osborn** begins his 2nd season in Omaha and 1st as manager of the Storm Chasers in 2026, bringing a championship resume to Werner Park.

Osborn served as Omaha's bench coach in 2025, before being named the 20th manager in Triple-A Omaha franchise history in January 2026 ... he is the 4th manager in the 15-season Storm Chasers era of the club (2011-present).

2026 marks his 7th season as a Minor League manager, owning a 375-309 (.548) career record with 5 postseason trips in 6 Yankees-system seasons (2014-19).

He led Double-A Trenton to the 2019 Eastern League championship and was named 2016 Florida State League Manager of the Year with High-A Tampa.

Is a former 2nd-round pick by Cleveland and professional infielder ... recently served as a Marlins pro scout (2020-21) and Miami's Field Coordinator (2021-24).

#### ROSTER RUNDOWN

The Storm Chasers active roster is made up of 27 players, 12 position players and 15 pitchers.

Outfielder **Gavin Cross** made his Triple-A debut last week, the only player on the Breaking Roster who had not yet done so ... the 9th overall pick by the Royals in the 2022 MLB Draft out of Virginia Tech, he has appeared in 217 games with Double-A Northwest Arkansas over the past three seasons.

Only 11 players from last year are represented on the active roster ... 13 of the 27 players are newcomers to the Royals, including 3 acquired by Kansas City via trade and 10 Minor League free agents signed by the Royals in the offseason.

15 of 27 players on Omaha's roster have reached the Majors, combining for over 57 years of MLB service ... 7 members of the roster have 4+ years of MLB service.

Sanchez has played parts of 8 Major League seasons with Toronto (2014-19), Houston (2019), San Francisco (2021), Washington (2022) and Minnesota (2022) ... he has also played parts of 7 years in Triple-A and Omaha is his 6th Triple-A team.

THE SANCH FACTOR

- ✓ **ROAD BACK TO THE SHOW:** Sanchez last appeared in the Major Leagues 1,278 days ago on October 4, 2022 with the Minnesota Twins, as he worked 1.2 innings of relief ... he has since pitched 36 games (34 starts) in the Minor Leagues, but has not pitched in the Majors the last 3 years.
- ✓ **ROTATION MAINSTAY:** Sanchez has largely pitched as a starter in his professional career, with 113 of 174 Major League outings coming as starts as well as 140 of 160 Minor League appearances ... his last relief appearances came with the St. Paul Saints in June and July, 2023.

LAST OUTING: SUNDAY, MARCH 29 @ LOUISVILLE

- ✓ Tagged for 6 runs in the bottom of the 1st inning in his season debut, on a pair of walks, hit batter, two sacrifice flies, a single and a home run ... worked scoreless 2nd and 3rd innings, but his start ended after hitting his first batter of the bottom of the 4th, a baserunner that came around to score.
