TODAY'S HEADLINES

LAST TIME OUT: The Saints pounded out 19 hits, the most they have ever recorded at Fifth Third Field in a 11-3 victory over Toledo on Saturday. The Saints scored four runs on five hits in the second inning and never looked back. Wynton Bernard, Anthony Prato and Patrick Winkel each recorded three-hit games and Prato also drove in four runs in the win. Adam Plutko picked up his fourth win of the season, allowing two runs while striking out six over 5.1 innings. The Saints capitalized by going 10-for-16 with runners in scoring position in the victory.

DESTINATION, ZEBULON: Zebby Matthews will make his Triple-A debut this afternoon. Matthews is ranked the Twins' #5 prospect by Baseball America and #19 by MLB Pipeline. St. Paul will mark the third level of the Twins' system Matthews has pitched at this year, going 5-1 with a 1.85 ERA in 14 appearances (13 starts) between High-A Cedar Rajds and Double-A Wichita. He has struck out 91 batters to six walks across 78.0 innings this season.

PRATO POWER-UP: Anthony Prato reached base in all five plate appearances on Saturday, doing so for the second time this season. He's one of three Saints to reach base in five-or-more plate appearances this year (Holland, 4/23 and Castillo, 5/14). He is the only one to do so multiple times. He also becomes the 12th player in franchise history to reach in five-or-more plate appearances and is the first in franchise history to repeat the feat.

TOLEDO TURNAROUND: The Saints dropped 11 runs on 19 hits in Toledo on Saturday night. The 19 hits are the most the club has ever recorded at Fifth Third Field and the 11 runs are tied for the most in Toledo. The Saints scored double-digit runs twice in Toledo in their first three years in the International League. They have done so twice in 2024. scoring 11 on May 8 and July 20.

\$ The 11 runs and 19 hits are also the most in franchise history without hitting a home run, surpassing the previous highs of 10 runs (done three times, last June 30) and 18 hits (August 28, 2021 @ Toledo (14 innings)).

WILLIAMS RECORD WATCH: Chris Williams hit his 11th home run of the season on Friday and the 42nd of his Saints career. He is now just one away from tying Mark Contreras for the franchise lead at 43.

\$\frac{\pi}{\text{In the month of July, Williams has clubbed six home runs, tied for the most in the International League. He also ranks among league leaders with his 33 total bases, the third-most in July. His 717 slugging percentage is good for fourth in the IL. His 1.087 OPS this month is the best of any month he's had in 2024 and nearly double his .544 OPS in June.

BRIGHAM BRINGING IT: Over his last five appearances, Jeff Brigham has been locked in, allowing one earned run over his last 7.2 innings (1.17 ERA), striking out 10 in that span. All 10 of those strikeouts have come in his last three outings and also rank as the most among Saints' relievers in July.

REHAB ROUNDTABLE: After the Minnesota Twins reinstated Zack Weiss and sent him outright to St. Paul, the Saints now have one Major League Rehab assignment on their roster in Brock Stewart. Stewart has made three appearances, most recently on July 19. Over the three outings, he has pitched 3.0 innings, allowed one hit, one earned run, walked two and struck out five.

ELECTRIC EELES: Since joining the Saints on July 4, he has constantly found ways to get on base, sporting a .454 on-base percentage in Triple-A. He's reached base in nine of the 11 games he's played in, drawing six walks and been hit by a pitch four times. He is fourth among full-season minor league players in on-base percentage at .453 across three levels.

SUMMERTIME SEVERINO: In Yunior Severino's 44 games since May 21, he has hit .343 (57-for-166), with 10 home runs, drawing 33 walks to 47 strikeouts, owning a 1.022 OPS. Since June 1, Severino is second in the IL in batting average at .351, second in on-base percentage at .463 and second in OPS, at 1.036, ranking seventh in slugging percentage with a .573 mark. His 28 walks since the start of June are the fifth-most in the league.

TWINS UPDATE: The Twins came out of the All-Star Break with an 8-4 loss to Milwaukee in 12 innings. The Brewers scored five runs in the 12th to score the win after Pablo López dealt 7.0 innings of one-run ball, striking out seven.

LAST APPEARANCE: 7/9 @ SPR...made 13th start of the season and ninth with Wichita...allowed three runs (one earned) on two hits, walking two and striking out four over a season-low 3.0 innings...retired the first seven batters that he faced before allowing a one-out single in the third inning...after recording the second out, allowed a walk, single and another walk, followed by an error...threw 37 pitches in the third inning, charged with only the one run out of the three that scored...walked multiple batters for the first time this season and fifth time of his career...did not factor into the decision in a 7-6 Wind Surge loss in 10 innings.

APPEARANCE PRIOR: 7/3 v TUL...made 12th start of the season, allowing two runs on four hits, walking none and striking out six over 6.0 innings...marked his sixth quality start of the season...allowed first hit with one out in the third inning, was the first of three straight hits given up that scored both runs allowed...retired final nine batters faced...did not factor into the decision in a 3-2 Wind Surge loss in 10 innings.

TALK ABOUT A HOT START: Matthews opened the season on an incredible stretch without walking a batter. He issued his first walk of the season on May 22, seven starts into the campaign (also his 24th birthday). He struck out 49 batters before issuing a walk, facing 141 batters. Since 1893, when the mound was moved to its current position, only two Major League pitchers began a season with more strikeouts before issuing a walk: Kenley Jansen in 2017 (51K) and Corbin Burnes in 2021 (58K).

PROSPECTING: Matthews currently resides on multiple Twins' Top-30 prospect lists. He is ranked the #5 prospect in the organization by Baseball America and the 19th-best prospect by MLB Pipeline
