FRES-NOTES

BEAR MARKET FOR OFFENSE: Fresno enters the Rancho Cucamonga series leading the California League in runs, RBI, walks, home runs and OPS. The Grizzlies have scored 294 runs through 40 games while posting a league-best .828 OPS. Fresno also has three of the top seven OPS leaders in the league: Ethan Holliday, Derek Bernard and Roldy Brito.

TALENT AT THE TOP: Roldy Brito and Tanner Thach are tied for the California League lead with 55 hits apiece. Thach leads the league with 46 RBI and 91 total bases, while Brito leads the league with 40 runs scored and ranks second with 41 RBI. Together, they have combined for 110 hits, 86 RBI and 69 runs.

HOLLIDAY TRAFFIC: Ethan Holliday is tied for the California League lead with nine home runs and leads the league with a .961 OPS. The Rockies' top prospect is also third in the league with a .564 slugging percentage and sixth with 31 RBI. His production has helped keep Fresno atop the league in both home runs and run production.

RANCHO REMATCH: Fresno is 2-5 against Rancho Cucamonga this season, but several Grizzlies have produced well in the matchup. Clayton Gray is hitting .538 with a 1.340 OPS against the Quakes, while Tanner Thach owns a .360 average and .993 OPS. On the mound, Seth Clausen has been dominant against Rancho, striking out eight over four scoreless innings.
