Lake Elsinore Storm (21-23)



RHP Payton Martin (0-2, 4.63 ERA) vs. RHP Jose Luis Reyes (2-3, 6.59 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes continue their series at The Diamond in Lake Elsinore, taking on the Lake Elsinore Storm (SD) in game two of the six-game set. The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field at the completion of this series, opening a six-gamer against Visalia on Tuesday, June 4th. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE STORM: This is the 11th of 30 match-ups and the fifth of 15 here at LoanMart Field. The Quakes are 6-4 against the Storm in 2024, 1-3 here at The Diamond. Last season, the Quakes won the season-series (17-13).

LAST GAME: The Storm came from behind on multiple occasions, with Oswaldo Linares providing the game-winning hit in the bottom of the tenth, giving Lake Elsinore a 7-6 win over the Quakes on Tuesday afternoon at The Diamond. Rancho had leads of 2-0, 5-3 and 6-5 in the tenth, thanks to a two-out RBI double by Wilman Diaz. They weren't able to hang on though, as Callum Wallace (0-1) got in a bases-loaded jam. Noah Ruen then came on and gave up back-to-back hits, including the Linares walk-off single. Storm reliever Kobe Robinson (4-1) pitched the tenth and got the win. Rancho's Logan Wagner had two hits and a career-high three RBIs in the loss.

HOME STAND RECAP: The Quakes had a tough home stand, finishing 4-8 which included a seven-game losing streak, their longest stretch of futility this year. The Quakes scored 33 runs over their most recent series against Modesto and did not hit a single home run. Their team batting average entered the Modesto series second in the league at .259 and then entered this series against Lake Elsinore ten points lower at .249, now third in the league. Despite dropping five of six to Modesto last week, Rancho's lead in the South remained exactly where it began the week, at three over Lake Elsinore. Rancho's largest lead this year was a five-game lead over the Storm.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes made several roster moves prior to this series. RHP Jose Rodriguez, who has five wins to lead the team, has been promoted to High-A Great Lakes of the Midwest League. 1B Joe Vetrano was placed on the Injured List, retroactive to May 24. The Quakes have added just one player, RHP Jesus Luna, from the Arizona Complex League. The Quakes still have an open roster and are expected to officially add another player soon.

EVAN PHILLIPS: Dodgers' closer Evan Phillips pitched in his second rehab outing with the Quakes in Tuesday's loss at Lake Elsinore. Phillips came on with one out in the sixth and used nine pitches to retire two hitters, including a strikeout. He pitched a 1-2-3 fourth inning with two strikeouts on Sunday, marking his first appearance ever in a Rancho uniform. Phillips has been on the Injured List since May 6, due to a grade one hamstring injury. Phillips has a 0.66 ERA across 14 appearances this year, allowing one earned run over 13.2 innings, collecting eight saves along the way. Phillips was originally drafted by Atlanta in the 17th round of the 2015 draft out of UNC Wilmington. He was designated for assignment by Tampa Bay in August of 2021 and claimed by the Dodgers.

PAYTON MARTIN: Right-hander Payton Martin makes his fifth appearance of 2024 and first against Lake Elsinore. In his last start, he allowed two runs on two hits over three innings in a loss to Modesto on May 23. Martin made 14 appearances (12 starts) for the Quakes in 2023, going 2-1 with a 2.04 ERA over 39.2 innings, before being shut down with an arm injury in mid-July. Martin was a 17th-round selection by the Dodgers in the 2022 draft, out of West Forsyth High School in Clemmons, North Carolina. MLB Pipeline rates him as the Dodgers tenth best prospect.

JOSE LUIS REYES: Jose Luis Reyes makes his ninth appearance and eighth start, his third game against Rancho. In two appearances against the Quakes, he's 1-1 with a 9.00 ERA. In his last start, he allowed two unearned runs on three hits over 3.2 innings in a no-decision against San Jose on May 22. Reyes signed with San Diego in 2019 out of Mexico.
