Game 48 Recap The Fightin Phils fell to Erie in blowout fashion on Saturday night, 11-1. Jean Cabrera started and posted zeroes through the first three innings of the game. But, Cabrera ran into some misfortune in the fourth as three runs scored. Reading responded with a run in the bottom of the fifth after an Alex Binelas triple and Leandro Pineda sac fly. But, Erie broke it open with six runs in the top of the sixth inning, which included three home runs off Mitch Neunborn. In total, Cabrer a, who took the loss, went 5.1 innings, allowing five runs, but just two earned on six hits. He did strike out three and issue just one walk in the loss. Offensively, Aidan Miller had two hits, including a double, and Keaton Anthony also had two more hits and his league-leading 19th double of the season.

The Reading Fightin Phils remain home and continue a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. It is the fifth-of-six

Putting the Fight in Fightins

Reading's come-from-behind win on Friday night was the second time this week, and fourth time this season the Fightin Phils won a game when trailing entering the ninth inning. The other instances were May 25 at Portland, along with April 8 and 13 at Somerset. It was the first time they won a game when trailing after eight innings at home this year. This comes after the R-Phils won just once in 2024 when trailing after eight innings. Ironically, that lone instance was Sept. 4, 2024, at home against Erie, when the Fightin Phils won on a catchers' interfearance call 6-5, when they trailed 5-2 entering the bottom of the ninth inning.

It's Miller Time

Today's Game

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller luanched his fifth home run of the season on Friday night and had his third-straight two-hit game on Saturday, along with a double. The two-run shot traveled 413 feet and was 114 miles per hour off the bat. After hitting just .203 in April, Miller has posted a .284/.364/.432 (.796 OPS) slash line over 24 May games, along with 11 runs, four doubles, three home runs and eight RBI. Miller has proved to be a threat on the bases this season as well, as he ranks tied for fourth in the Eastern League with 16 stolen bases. He is well on track to blow pass Reading's season-high in stolen bases from 2024, which was 20 from Gabriel Rincones Jr.

Anthony Keeps Rolling

Keaton Anthony enters today with a team-best nine-game hit and 17-game on-base streak, the latter of which is a season-high. His 17-game on-base streak is second-longest active in the Eastern League, trailing only Eries Max Anderson. Anthony also trails Anderson for the best average in the Eastern League as well, with Anderson hitting. 339 and Anthony posting a .329 average. His other Eastern League ranks are: 5th OBP (.386), 9th SLG (.510), 5th OPS (.896), T-4th hits (49), 1st 2B (19) T-3rd XBH (22), T-8th TB (76). Anthony has been red-hot in the month of May, slashing .385/.442/.603 (1.045 OPS) over 22 games, along with 11 runs, 12 doubles, one triple, one home run and 12 RBI. This came after Anthony hit .268 over 19 April games.

Pineda's May

After a slow start to the season that saw Leandro Pineda hit just .104 in April, he has been red-hot in May. Over 24 games this month, Pineda is slashing .296/.351/.451 (.802 OPS), with 10 runs, eight doubles, one home run and six RBI. Pineda ranks T-4th in doubles during the month of May.

Pitching Powers

The Fightin Phils bullpen has been strong over Reading's last three wins (Sunday, Tuesday and Friday). Over those three games, the bullpen has combined for: 14.0 IP, 5 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 2 BB, 11 SO.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 1, 2024: At Hartford, the Fightin Phils beat the Yard Goats 6-1, behind the bat of Robert Moore. Moore matches season-highs in hits (2) and runs scored (2). He also sets a new season-high with two stolen bases. Moore hits two home runs in the game, in consecutive at-bats, with the second of which being a grand slam. It marks the first multi-homer game of Moore's career, along with first grand slam of his career. It also marked the first grand slam hit by Reading in a game since Cam Cannon did it on April 25, 2023, at home against Altoona. Matt Osterberg also earned his first win of the season, allowing one run over six innings, while the bullpen combines to hold Hartford scoreless and allows just one hit to finish off the win.

Fron One Corner of the State to the Other

Erie enters tonight trailing Akron by one game for first place in the Southwest Division, and for the best record in the Eastern League. The SeaWolves took fiveof-six from Hartford at home last week, winning the first five and losing on Sunday. After this week, Erie returns home and welcomes Richmond. Erie's roster fetures 10 of the Tigers' top-30 prospects: Thayron Liranzo (5), Jaden Hamm (7), Jake Miller (15), Joseph Montalvo (17), Roberto Campos (20), Max Andrerson (21), Justice Bigbie (25), RJ Petit (28) and Yosber Sanche (30).

SeaWolves Pitcher

Righty Garrett Burhenn makes the start today for Erie. This season, Burhenn is 5-1, with a 2.98 ERA (14 ER, 42.1 IP) He's allowed 39 hits, walked 13 and struck out 44. Burhenn took the loss at Reading on Tuesday, allowing one run on four hits over five innings, with four walks and six strikeouts. At Reading on Sept. 4, 2024, Burhenn allowed one run on four hits over five innings, with four strikeouts, in a no-deicsion. He split 2024 between West Michigan (A+) and Erie, going 6-4, with a 3.68 ERA. The 25-year old was a ninth round pick by the Tigers out of Ohio State in 2021.
