SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Portland Sea Dogs, 7-2. The win paired with a loss by Akron against Harrisburg clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title for the Flying Squirrels. In Sunday's game, **Kyle Harrison** allowed two runs over seven innings with 11 strikeouts. The Flying Squirrels took a 1-0 lead in the second on a Portland error. The Sea Dogs tied the game with a solo homer by Nick Sogard in the top of the third. In the top of the fourth, the Sea Dogs took a 2-1 lead with a solo homer by Hudson Potts. The Flying Squirrels moved ahead in the bottom of the fourth with a two-run homer by **Sean Roby**. In the fifth, **Diego Rincones** hit an RBI double, Roby added an RBI single and a run scored on a wild pitch to open a 6-2 lead. In the bottom of the eighth, **Mike Gigliotti** extended the lead to 7-2 with an RBI single.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Today's game is the first game of the Eastern League's second half, with records resetting. This game begins a 69-game run for the league's second-half division titles. Richmond is 6-6 in series openers, including a 3-3 mark on the road. This series is the third this year between the Flying Squirrels and the Baysox. They opened the season with a three-game series at Prince George's Stadium from April 8-10, with Richmond winning two. The teams met for a six-game series at The Diamond from April 26-May 1, with the Flying Squirrels winning five games in the set.

TICKET PUNCHED: The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on Sunday afternoon paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron, but held the tiebreaker with a 7-5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019. After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffs for the third time in franchise history. In 2011, they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 17-8 since May 29 after losing nine of their previous 12. Last week, they split a six-game series at home against the Sea Dogs. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost three and split two this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 762 strikeouts and 58 HBPs. They are second with 89 homers. The Flying Squirrels are 18-15 on the road this year.

THE BAYSOX finished the first half with the worst record in the Eastern League at 27-42, 13.0 games behind Richmond in the Southwest Division standings. The Baysox are 2-6 in their last eight games, including dropping four-of-six in last week's series at Erie. Bowie's roster includes five of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including INF Cesar Prieto (11), SS Joseph Ortiz (14), OF Hudson Haskin (15), LHP Drew Rom (16) and INF Adam Hall (26).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Jake Dahlberg** makes his 13th start of the season and his fourth against the Baysox. He last pitched on Thursday against the Sea Dogs in Game 1 of a doubleheader and allowed two runs over 5.1 innings with seven strikeouts. He faced the Baysox on Opening Day in his Double-A debut on April 8 and worked 4.1 scoreless innings with eight strikeouts. He pitched against Bowie twice at The Diamond on April 26 and May 1, picking up wins in a pair of six-inning, scoreless starts. For the year, Dahlberg has pitched 16.1 scoreless innings against Bowie with 15 strikeouts. Dahlberg spent parts of three seasons with the independent Chicago Dogs before signing with the Giants during the 2021 season. He joined the High-A Eugene Emeralds in July and made 10 starts, going 2-5 with a 6.60 ERA. He closed the year with two outings with Triple-A Sacramento and tossed 9.0 scoreless innings. After being named Horizon League Pitcher of the Year twice at the University of Illinois-Chicago, he was selected in the 21st round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the St. Louis Cardinals. **For more on Dahlberg, see page two.**

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Matt Harvey makes a rehab start for the Baysox. He made his season debut with the Aberdeen Ironbirds on Thursday at Wilmington and pitched six scoreless innings. Harvey is currently serving a 60-game suspension, which lasts until July, but is eligible to pitch in the minors. He has pitched nine seasons in the majors with the Mets, Reds, Angels, Royals and Orioles. Harvey was the seventh-overall pick in the 2010 MLB Draft out of the University of North Carolina. In his first full professional season in the majors in 2013, Harvey went 9-5 with a 2.27 ERA and was selected as an NL All-Star. Last year with the Orioles, he went 6-14 with a 6.27 ERA in 28 starts, including going 3-4 with a 4.18 ERA in his final 10 starts of the year from July 18-September 8.

STRONG ARMS: Richmond pitchers have combined for a 1.94 ERA (22 ER/102.0 IP) in 12 games since June 14, the best in the Eastern League, with 127 strikeouts and 45 walks. Opposing batters are hitting .188 in that span.

THE STARTING LINE: Over the last 12 games since June 14, Flying Squirrels starting pitchers have combined to go 7-3 with a 1.87 ERA (15 ER/72.1 IP), picking up 77 strikeouts with 22 walks. Over that span, **Bryan Brickhouse** is 1-2 with a 1.59 ERA (3 ER/17.0 IP) in three starts, **Kyle Harrison** is 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA (3 ER/18.0 IP) in three starts, **Jake Dahlberg** is 0-1 with a 3.48 ERA (4 ER/10.1 IP) in two starts, **Matt Frisbee** is 2-0 with a 1.84 ERA (3 ER/14.2 IP) in two starts and **Kai-Wei Teng** is 2-0 with a 1.46 ERA (2 ER/12.1 IP) in two starts.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,198) and total attendance (216,919). Richmond is 11th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night is the largest crowd in all of Double-A this year and the largest of all non-Triple-A teams this season.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 89 home runs this season, which is second in the Eastern League behind Somerset (92). **Sean Roby** is second in the league with 19 homers on the season, with 16 coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 178 home runs. The Flying Squirrels have already hit more homers than entire seasons in 2010 (71), 2011 (83) 2012 (76), 2014 (74) and 2015 (61), 2016 (83) and 2019 (84).

GO, DIEGO, GO! After hitting .173 (22-for-127) over his first 35 games of the season, **Diego Rincones** is batting .370 (17-for-46) with four doubles, four homers and 15 RBIs over his last 12 games since June 7. He started the stretch with two doubles on June 7 against the SeaWolves and hit his first homer of the season the next day. He collected a season-high three hits in the series finale against the SeaWolves on June 12, capping the game with a walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning. It was his second walk-off hit as a member of the Flying Squirrels. He has homered in three of his last five games played.

SHANE TRAIN: Since May 1, **Shane Matheny** is batting .304 (35-for-115) with six homers, five doubles, a triple and 20 RBIs. He has picked up a pair of two-homer games, one on May 1 at The Diamond against Bowie and another on May 12 at Harrisburg. They were the second and third multi-homer games of his professional career and his first since 2019. From May 14-June 10, he posted a 13-game hitting streak, tied for the longest in the EL this season, even with a 13-game streak for Portland's Pedro Castellanos from May 6-22. From May 1-June 11, Matheny posted a 24-game on-base streak, which was the second-longest in the league this season. In the month of June, he has walked 15 times and struck out 14 times in 16 games. In the Eastern League this season, Matheny is ranked seventh in batting average (.291), third in OBP (.428) and eighth in OPS (.911). He is also ranked fourth in the EL in wRC+ (158) and wOBA (.409).

TOASTY: **Frankie Tostado** went hitless over his five-game stretch from June 9-15, going 0-for-19 in that span with six strikeouts before picking up ten hits over his last nine games since June 16, batting .313 (10-for-32) with three homers, two doubles and four RBIs. From April 22-June 8, Tostado hit .342 (51-for-149) with seven homers, nine doubles, a triple and 26 RBIs in 39 games. In the Eastern League, Tostado is ranked fifth in batting average (.298), fourth in hits (71) and seventh in total bases (117).

ROBUST: **Sean Roby** hit his 19th homer of the year on Sunday afternoon against the Sea Dogs, moving ahead of **Jarrett Parker** (2013) and **Mario Lissin** (2014) for the most homers in a season in team history, trailing only **David Villar's** record 20 homers last season. He is second in the EL in home runs this year, trailing Erie's Kerry Carpenter (22). He has hit 16 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by **Adam Duval** in 2013. It is also a new franchise record for the most career homers at The Diamond. He has also set the franchise record for the most multi-homer games in a season and a career with four.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Frankie Tostado** is ranked fifth in batting average (.298), fourth in hits (71) and seventh in total bases (117). **Sean Roby** is second in homers (19) and ninth in SLG (.507). **Shane Matheny** is seventh in batting average (.291), third in OBP (.428) and eighth in OPS (.911). **Mike Gigliotti** is 10th in OBP (.396) and tied for seventh in stolen bases (16). **Ryan Walker** is tied for first in wins (6). **Chris Wright** is tied for fifth in saves (6). **Matt Frisbee** is tied for first in complete games (1). **Kai-Wei Teng** is tied for first in starts (14), tied for sixth in strikeouts (76) and ninth in innings pitched (67.2). **Bryan Brickhouse** is tied for first in starts (14), 10th in strikeouts (72) and tied for seventh in innings pitched (68.0). **Jake Dahlberg** is 10th in ERA (3.77).

WHERE THE BAYSOX RANK: In the Eastern League, Gunnar Henderson is second in batting average (.312), first in OBP (.452), second in SLG (.573), first in OPS (1.025), tied for fifth in walks (41) and sixth in runs scored (41). Adam Hall is tied for seventh in stolen bases (16).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **R.J. Dabovich** (17), **Ricardo Genoves** (24) and **Chris Wright** (27). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." **Simon Whiteman** is listed as the system's "Fastest Baserunner." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Dabovich (16), **Brett Auerbach** (27), Genoves (29) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (30). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 64 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 45 overall prospect.
