LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones won their 5th straight game on Saturday, an 8-5 victory over Winston-Salem that saw Brooklyn pull out in front with a 4-run 2-out rally in the 7th, including a go-ahead base hit from SS Jesús Báez...2B A.J. Ewing put together a three hit night, while C Ronald Hernandez knocked in 3 RBI...LF Chris Suero clobbeared his 7th home run of the year in the victory, while also making a web gem diving catch in left field...RHP Moah Hall toed the rubber for his 8th time this year, and tossed 5.1 innings of 2-run ball (1 earned)...The 'Clones also stole 6 bases in the game, as Ewing, Suero, and Baez each nabbed a pair.

OFF AND RUNNING: The Cyclones' 7-6 win over Wilmington on April 29 saw them nab a franchise record 9 stolen bases, courtesy of 7 different players...The mark topped a previous high of 8 set on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...On a night where 8 of Brooklyn's 9 starters were Top 30 prospects in the Mets organization per MLB Pipeline, C Chris Suero and DH Jesús Báez each swiped 2 bags, while 5 other players finished with a steal...Brooklyn continued to wreak havoc on the bases in a May 17 win vs. Winston-Salem, during which, the Cyclones stole 6 bases courtesy of 3 players...2B A.J. Ewing, Báez and Suero each stole two...Brooklyn enters play on Sunday with 86 steals, good for 2nd most in the South Atlantic League behind only Aberdeen (108).

RUNS AT A PREMIUM: This week's series against Winston-Salem has seen Brooklyn pitchers excel all week at keeping runs off the board...Coming into Sunday's contest, Cyclone arms have surrendered a grand total of 12 runs through 5 games (all wins), limiting the Dash to just 2.4 runs per contest...The most hits Winston-Salem has had in a game this week is 7, which came on Saturday night...Brooklyn's 11 earned runs allowed this week are tied for the fewest surrendered in all of High-A, and tied for 5th across Mills.

WHAT A RELIEF!: Brooklyn's bullpen has been dominant in the 2025 season...Entering play on Sunday, Cyclones relievers have a 14-5 record with a 3.37 ERA (63 ER in 168.1 IP), 8 saves, 88 walks, and an eye-popping 224 strikeouts...Brooklyn's relief staff holds the 3rd-best strikeouts-per-9-innings ratio in Minor League Baseball (11.89), Chicago-NL's Triple-A lowa is first (12.76)...The Cyclones have also held opponents to a .207 batting average, which is the 2nd lowest in the South Atlantic League and 3rd-lowest in High-A...Hudson Valley is 1st (.188)...On the year, Brooklyn relievers have a 29.86% strikeout rate.

SUPER SUERO: C Chris Suero has been unstoppable in 2025...On April 17, he delivered the go-ahead 2-run double in the 9th, in a 7-3 comeback win at Aberdeen...On April 15, the 21-year-old recorded the 2nd multi-home run game of his career in an 8-7 victory...Suero powered a 2-run blast in the 2nd and added another 2-run shot in the 3rd...The Bronx native homered in 3-straight at-bats dating back to his sole shot in the 6th inning on April 13 vs. Hudson Valley...Entering play on Sunday, Suero is 2nd in the South Atlantic League in hit-by-pitches (10), tied for 6th in home runs (7), tied for 9th in extra-base hits (13), and tied for 5th in stolen bases (15).

REIM TIME: INF Jacob Reimer remains scorching hot to start the 2025 season...The former 4th-round pick recorded more RBI (8) in the first 2 games of 2025 than he had in 25 outings (7) in an injury-plagued 2024...Reimer launched his 7th home run of the season in Thursday's win...Entering play on Sunday, Reimer is 4th in Minor League Baseball in slugging percentage (.652), 3rd in extra-base hits (25), 4th in OPS (1.085), tied for 4th in doubles (15), and tied for 6th in total bases (88)...The former 4th-round pick leads the South Atlantic League in total bases (18), slugging percentage (.652), runs (33), OPS (1.085), extra-base hits (25), doubles (15), hits (46), and is tied for 3rd in triples (3)...Reimer is also 3rd in batting average (.341), 4th in RBI (30), tied for 6th in home runs (7), and 6th in on-base percentage (.433)...Reimer enters Sunday on a 19-game on-base streak since April 24....In that time, he is hitting, 361/.4771.694/1.172 with 20 runs scored, 9 doubles, 5 home runs, 17 RBI, 13 walks, 4 steals, and 3 hit-by-pitches.

KEEPING IT ROLLING: The Cyclones have yet to drop a series through the first 37 games of the 2025 season...Through Brooklyn's first 7 series of the year, the Cyclones hold a 5-0-2 record...In home series, Brooklyn is 3-0-1, splitting their first full 6-game set with Hudson Valley from April 8-13...The Cyclones have not lost a series since they dropped 5-of-6 at home vs. Jersey Shore from August 20-25, 2024... Since then, Brooklyn is 7-0-2 in a series of any length...That streak includes this week's series against the Dash, with Brooklyn having taken the first 4 games...Brooklyn is off to its best start through 37 games since moving to the High-A level in 2021 and its best start at any level since beginning the 2009 campaign at 25-11.

LUCKY NO. 5: Brooklyn's streak of scoring at least 5 runs in 10-straight contests, dating back to May 2, came to an end on Thursday despite a 4-3 win...Brooklyn went 6-4 during the stretch...The 'Clones averaged an impressive 6.1 runs per game during that span...The 'Clones lineup has lexed its muscles, scoring at least 7 runs on 4 separate occasions during that span..Brooklyn arms held opponents to 4.7 runs per contest during the same span...The Cyclones enter play on Sunday with 217 runs scored, tops in the SAL and 2nd in all of High-A behind only Minnesota's Cedar Rapids (228).

NEW ON THE BOARDWALK: The Cyclones made several roster moves on Monday ahead of Tuesday's series opener vs. Winston-Salem...Brooklyn added RHPs Matt Allan, Nate Dohm, and Raimon Gómez from Single-A St. Lucie...RHPs Anthony Nunez and Dylan Ross were transferred to Double-A Bingham-ton...Prior to 2025, Allan's last pitch in an official contest was in the deciding Game of the 2019 New York-Penn League Championship Series vs. Lowell...Did not pitch in 2024 while recovering from injury, in 2023 after undergoing UCL revision surgery, in 2022 after ulnar transposition surgery, and in 2021 due to Tommy John surgery...In 7 starts this year, Allan was 0-2 with a 3.60 ERA (6 ER in 15.0 IP), 11 walks and 17 strikeouts...Dohm tallied a 2-3 mark with a 3.18 ERA (10 ER in 28.1 IP), 10 walks, and 34 K's in 7 starts with St. Lucie...Dohm was tied for 5th in the Florida State League in strikeouts (34) and tied for 7th in innings pitched (28.1) at the time of his promotion...Gómez returns to Brooklyn after serving as the team's Opening Day starter in 2023...He made 3 starts before undergoing season-ending Tommy John surgery...In 6 appearances (3 starts), the 23-year-old was 2-0 with a 0.69 ERA (1 ER in 13.0 IP), 10 walks, and 20 strikeouts.

MARCO POLO: IF Marco Vargas celebrated his 20th birthday on Wednesday and has not stopped hitting since joining the Cyclones at the end of April...The 19-year-old has reached safely in all 14 games played with Brooklyn, and in all 27 contests he has appeared in this year between the Cyclones and Single-A St. Lucie...During the 27-game on-base streak, Vargas is hitting. 302/.424/.385/.809 with 21 runs scored, 3 doubles, a triple, a home run, 14 RBI, 20 walks, and 9 stolen bases.

HOMER HAPPY: Brooklyn's offense erupted in the 2nd inning last Friday...RF Eli Serrano III, DH A.J. Ewing, and CF Carson Benge clubbed back-to-back-to-back home runs with 1 out in the frame off Asheville's RHP Yeriel Santos...It marked just the 2nd time Brooklyn had hit 3-straight home runs in Minor League Baseball's Digital Era (2005-present)...28 Luke Ritter, 18 Joe Genord, and C José Mena first accomplished the feat with back-to-back-to-back shots in the 6th inning on June 20, 2021, at Wilmington...SS Jesús Báez added a 4th home run in the frame, marking the first time in MiLB's Digital Era that the Cyclones powered 4 long balls in a single inning...The feat has been accomplished just 2 other times in MiLB this season...Miami's Double-A Pensacola accomplished the feat with 4 homers in the 3rd inning on April 26 vs. Knoxville...Chicago-NL'S Triple-A lowa blasted 5 home runs in the 7th inning on April 16 vs. St. Paul...Brooklyn enters Saturday tied for 2nd in the South Atlantic League in home runs (33)...Since 2005, only the 2021 team (35) has hit home runs through the team's first 36 games.

HALL PASS: After an injury-shortened 2024, RHP **Noah Hall** has returned to form in 2025...Over his first 8 starts, the Charlotte, N.C. native is 3-2 with a 1.82 ERA (8 ER in 39.2 IP), 42 strikeouts and only 26 hits allowed...Entering Sunday, Hall is 3rd in the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.82), 6th in batting average against (1.83), tied for 4th in innings pitched (39.2), and tied for 6th in double plays induced (3)...Hall's 55.6% groundball rate is also 2nd in the circuit...His 44.8% infield fly ball rate is 1st in the league...The University of South Carolina product became not only the 1st player in franchise history to start on consecutive Opening Days, but the 1st player in franchise history to start multiple Opening Days.

vs. WINSTON-SALEM: After a 3-3 road trip in Asheville, Brooklyn returns home for a 6-game series with the Dash...Winston-Salem enters the series after splitting a 6-game set at home vs. Bowling Green...This is the Cyclones only matchup with Dash in 2025...Winston-Salem is 4-13 on the road this season...The Dash boast 5 of the White Sox's Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline:
OF Braden Montgomery (4), LHP Christian Oppor (18),
INF Jeral Pérez (20), RHP Aldrin Batista (24), and UTL
Sam Antonagi (20), Batista is currently on the injured Sam Antonacci (29)...Batista is currently on the injured list...In 35 meetings since 2022, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 21-14 (.600)...Brooklyn is 12-5 (.706) in 17 games on Coney Island.

SIR SERANO: OF Eli Serrano III put together his best game as a professional in April 24's win at Jersey Shore...The 21-year-old went 5-for-6 at the plate, scored 3 runs, doubled twice, blasted a solo home run in the 8th, and drove in 3...Since 2005, Serrano was the 1st Cyclone to record 5+ hits, 3 runs, 3 + extra-base hits, a home run, and 3 + RBI in a single game...He is only the 2nd Brooklyn player to record 5-or-more hits, hit a home run, and drive in 3-or-more runs in a single game since 2005...B Luke Ritter also accomplished the feat with 5 hits, a home run, and 3 RBI in a 5-4 win vs. Lowell in 11 innings on June 28, 2019..Ritter's home run was a game-tying blast in the 9th...Serrano is also the 2nd Cyclone to tally a 5-hit game at the High-A level and 9th overall since 2005...IF Alex Ramirez was the last player to accomplish the feat with a franchise-record 6 hits on July 21, 2023, at Hudson Valley....Entering Sunday, Serrano is tied for 3rd in the South Atlantic League in doubles (10), tied for 4th in extra-base hits (16), tied for 9th in runs scored (24), 7th in total bases (58), 13th in slugging percentage (.464), tied for 10th in walks (23), and tied for 10th in home runs (5).

ALL ABOUT THE BENGE-AMINS: OF **Carson Benge** has been heating up at the plate over the last few weeks...The 2024 first-round pick enters Sunday tied for 6th in the South Atlantic League in runs scored (25) and tied for 7th in hits (36)...The 22-year-old is riding an 8-game hitting streak since Thursday in which he is 11-for-31 (355) at the plate with 6 runs scored, 2 doubles, a triple, a home run, 10 RBI, 6 walks, and 4 stolen bases...Benge has also reached base safely in 11-straight games since May 3 vs. Wilmington, hitting .317 (13-41) with 9 runs scored, 2 doubles, a triple, 2 home runs, 12 RBI, 9 walks, and 5 stolen bases.

EW CAN'T STOP HIM: IF/OF A.J. Ewing has had a marvelous start to his 2025 season...Entering play on Saturday, the 20-year-old is tied for 2nd in Minor League Baseball in triples (6), and is tied for 5th in stolen bases (24) and is 7th in batting average (.362)...Ewing has reached base safely in all 13 games he's played with the Cyclones and has reached in 20-straight games since April 18 vs. Tampa with Single-A St. Lucie... In that time, Ewing is hitting .333/.457/.533/,990 with 16 runs scored, 4 doubles, 4 triples, a home run, 12 runs batted in, 17 walks, and 17 stolen bases.

RWARD SEASON: The Cyclones swept the South Atlantic League Player and Pitcher of the Month awards that were handed out last Monday...INF Jacob Reimer was recognized as the SAL Player of the Month, and LHP Zach Thornton, now at Double-A Binghamton, was named as the SAL Player of the Month...In 21 games during April, Reimer hit. 318/.383/.659/1.042 with 18 runs scored, 8 doubles, 3 triples, 5 home runs, 21 RBI, 9 walks, and a stolen base...The 21-year-old paced the SAL in doubles (8), extra-base hits (16), triples (3), slugging percentage (.659), and total bases (56)...Reimer also was 2nd in OPS (1.042), tied for 2nd in RBI (21) and hits (27), 4th in hasting average (.318), tied for 4th in home runs (5), tied for 6th in runs scored (18)...The Yucaipa, Calif. native was also 5th in Minor League Baseball in slugging percentage (.659), tied for 5th in extra-base hits (16), and tied for 8th in total bases (56)...Thornon accrued a perfect 3-0 record with a 0.44 ERA (1 ER in 20.2 IP), 12 hits, 2 walks, and 25 strikeouts in 4 starts...Among SAL arms with 20.0-plus innings pitched in April, Thornton led the league in strikeout-or-walk ratio (12.50) and was tied with teammate RHP Joel Diaz for the league lead in ERA (0.44) and WHIP (0.68)...He also tied for first in wins (3) and sat 3rd in batting average against (162)...Additionally, IF/OF A.J. Ewing took home Florida State League Player of the Month honors in April...With Single-A St. Lucie, the 20-year-old hit. 400/.506/.15/1.121 with 15 runs scored, 3 doubles, 4 triples, a home run, 20 RBI, and 14 swiped bags... Ewing paced the FSL in steals (14), batting average (.400), and OPS (1.121), and was tied for first in triples (4)...The Springsboro, Ohio, native also ranked 2nd in on-base percentage (.506) and RBI (20), 3rd in situging percentage (.455) and hits (26), and tied for 5th in batting average (.378), 8th in OPS (1.052), and 10th in on-base percentage (.405) and hits (26), and tied for 5th in batting average (.378), 8th in OPS (1.052), and 10th in on-base percenta

BORN TO RUNS: The Cyclones tallied 15 runs and 16 hits en route to a 15-1 win vs. Wilmington on April 30...lt marked the 3rd time this season in which Brooklyn collected 12 or more runs and 16 or more hits in a single game, and the 2nd time they've hit the 15-run plateau...The Cyclones also accrued 15 runs and 20 hits in a 15-1 win vs. Wilmington on April 5...April 24's 12-5 win over Jersey Shore marked the 6th time Brooklyn had tallied 12-plus runs and 17-plus hits in a single game since moving to the High-A level before the 2021 season...It was also the first time since 2021 that the Cyclones have had multiple games with 12-runs and 17+ hits in the same season...Before this season, the Cyclones had not scored 15 or more runs in a game at home since putting up 16 runs and 19 hits in a 16-5 win vs. Hudson Valley on June 24, 2010.

BROOKLYN TO THE BIGS: After 4 former Cyclones made their Major League debuts in 2024, 5 alumni have already accomplished the feat in 2025...RHP Blade Tidwell (2023) became the 5th to debut this year, suffering the loss in a start for the New York Mets in Game 1 of Sunday's doubleheader at St. Louis...Tidwell punched out C Pedro Pagés swinging for his first MLB strikeout in the 2nd...OF Rhylan Thomas (2023) went 1-for-4 with a double and 2 RBI in his debut Friday night for the Seattle Mariners at Texas...C Hayden Senger (18, '21) came off the bench and became the 103rd former Cyclone to play in the Majors and the 68th to debut with the New York Mets on Opening Day, March 27 at Houston...Three days later, on March 30, OF Jake Mangum (19, '21) batted second and played right field for the Tampa Bay Rays and went O-for-3 with a walk...RHP Mike Vasil debuted for the Chicago White Sox a day later, tossing 2.0 innings of two-hit shutout relief, whiffing 1B Ty France for his first Major League strikeout...The franchise record for debuts in a single season is 9 in 2015 and 2017.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 11 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF Carson Benge (3), INF Jesús Báez (7), LHP Jonathan Santucci (12), INF Boston Baro (13), INF Marco Vargas (14), RHP Nate Dohm (18), INF Jacob Reimer (20), C Chris Suero (21), OF Eli Serrano III (22) and C Ronald Hernández (26), and OF A.J. Ewing (27)...Of those 11, 5 have previous experience playing in Brooklyn...The Cyclones also possess 10 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per Baseball America...The list features Báez (3), Benge (7), Baro (15), Santucci (16), Vargas (17), Suero (20), Reimer (21), Dohm (23), Ewing (24), and RHP Raimon Gómez (26)...Brooklyn also hotss 11 of SNY's Top 30 from Joe DeMayo...Benge (5), Báez (6), Baro (13), Santucci (15), Vargas (17), Dohm (20), Reimer (21), Serrano (22), Suero (25), Hernández (26), and Gómez (28).

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his 2nd loss of the season last Sunday vs. Clearwater...Surrendered a season-high 3 runs on 1 hit over 1.0 inning of work...Plunked a batter and walked 3 without recording a strikeout...Threw 27 pitches and 13 strikes (48.14%)...Relieved by RHP **Oliver Ortega** to start the top of the 2nd inning with St. Lucie trailing 3-1...Mets would ultimately fall to the Threshers, 7-3.

2025: Broke camp with Single-A St. Lucie...Tossed 2.2 innings and struck out a season-high 5 in his first start and appearance in an official contest in 2,035 days on 4/6 vs. JUP (2.2 IP, 2 H, BB, 5 K)...Hurled a season-long 3.2 innings of shutout ball in a no-decision on 4/12 @LAK (3.2 IP, 2 H, 3 K)...Posted a pair of shutout innings in a start on 4/30 @PMB (2.0 IP, 2 H, BB, 3 K)...Twirled 2.0 shutout innings in a no-decision on 5/6 vs. CLR (2.0 IP, H, 2 BB, 2 K)...Transferred to Brooklyn on 5/12.

LONG TIME COMING: Prior to the 2025 season, Allan last pitched in an official contest on September 10, 2019, for the Brooklyn Cyclones in the decisive Game 3 of the New York-Penn League Championship Series against the Lowell Spinners...Posted 3.0 shutout and no-hit innings, striking out 2...Cyclones would win the game, and the title, with a 4-3 win...Contest was the final game in NYPL history...Allan was scheduled to break camp with the Cyclones in their inaugural High-A season in 2021, but instead underwent Tommy John surgery in May...Missed the entire 2022 season due to ulnar transposition surgery in January...Did not pitch in 2023 after undergoing UCL revision surgery in January...Missed all of 2024, too, recovering from the injury...Allan officially returned to the mound after 2,035 days on 4/6/25 vs. Jupiter...Sunday will be his first start on Coney Island and with the Cyclones in 2,077 days.

PROSPECT RADAR: Allan entered the 2023 season ranked as the New York Mets' No. 15 prospect by *Baseball America* and No. 23 by MLB Pipeline...BA deemed him New York's No. 5 farmhand in 2022, No. 3 in 2021, and No. 4 in 2020...MLB Pipeline listed Allan as the Mets' No. 5 prospect in 2022, No. 3 in 2021, and No. 4 in 2020...Alan was also deemed the No. 75 prospect in all of baseball entering 2021 by MLB Pipeline, No. 79 by Baseball Prospectus, and No. 98 by *Baseball America*.
