COLUMBUS, OHIO – The Omaha Storm Chasers fell to the Columbus Clippers 3-0 in the series opener Wednesday night at Huntington Park.

- On a rainy night, both teams struggled to score in the first two innings of the game, but Columbus fought their way to reaching the scoreboard.
- In the bottom of the 3rd inning, a sacrifice fly gave Columbus a 1-0 lead ... the Clippers added in the bottom of the 5th inning, when Kyle Manzardo blasted a two-run home run to right center field off reliever Dan Altavilla to put Columbus up 3-0, as the Clippers first baseman drove in all three runs of the game.
- Both starting pitchers took over the series opener with a combined 10 strikeouts ... Clippers starting pitcher Xzavion Curry ended his day with 7 strikeouts over 2.2 scoreless innings, while Omaha's Jonathan Bowlan struck out 3 over 4.0 innings of one-run ball.
- The closest the Storm Chasers came to putting runs on the board was in the 6th inning ... Nick Pratto walked with one out, then stole second and Tyler Gentry walked as well ... CJ Alexander and Devin Mann each had a six pitch at-bat to bring home Pratto and Gentry but both struck out to strand the tying run at the plate.
- Omaha pitchers finished the with nine strikeouts between five pitchers, including two each from relievers Altavilla, John McMillon and Tyler Duffey ... Evan Sisk, McMillon and Duffey combined for 3.0 hitless and scoreless innings.
- Offensively, the Storm Chasers only mustered three hits – all doubles ... Tyler Tolbert doubled to open the game, his first Triple-A hit, John Rave doubled in the 5th inning and Cam Devanney doubled in the 7th, but all three were stranded on base, as Omaha stranded all seven baserunners the team put on in the game.
- The shutout was Omaha's second straight offensively, a stretch of 18.0 innings without scoring .. 18 strikeouts at the plate mark the most by the team's hitters in a game since the team struck out on September 18, 2022 at Columbus.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

ALL QUIET ON THE OMAHA FRONT

- Omaha has not scored in its last 18.0 innings offensively, with the last run the Storm Chasers scored being a game winning sacrifice fly in the 10th inning on Saturday.
- Last year, the longest scoreless streak Omaha had at the plate was 14.0 innings, which happened twice.
- The last time the Storm Chasers went 18 innings (or back-to-back games) without scoring a run was a 20-inning stretch in July 2022, that included back-to-back offensive shutouts on July 23 and 24, 10-0 and 7-0 losses to the Iowa Cubs.
- Since 2005, this is the 7th time Omaha has been shut out in consecutive games ... in the "modern era," Omaha's longest shutout streak lasted 24 innings in August 2009, a span of 85 plate appearances between August 8 and August 11 without scoring.

ANOTHER ONE BITES THE DUST

- 18 strikeouts offensively in last night's game marked just the fifth time since 2005 Omaha hitters struck out 18 times or more in a game and the second time it's happened in a nine-inning game.
- The last time Omaha had 18+ strikeouts was September 18, 2022, when Columbus pitchers struck out Omaha batters 19 times ... the 2022 and 2024 games against Columbus are the only times Omaha has had 18+ strikeouts at the plate in a 9-inning game.
- Last year, the Toledo Mud Hens had a 17-strikeout game against Omaha on August 18, 2023 @ Toledo, but that was the season high for the offense.
- Since 2005, the most strikeouts in a game by an Omaha offense was on July 19, 2014 against Iowa, when I-Cubs pitchers struck out Chasers hitters 20 times in 14 innings .

DOUBLE DUTY

- Today is Omaha's first doubleheader of the season ... the Storm Chasers played just two doubleheaders last year and split them both.
- The last time Omaha won both games of a doubleheader was August 28, 2022 vs. Scranton/WB, with 9-4 and 12-10 wins over the RailRiders.
- Omaha has split the last 3 road doubleheaders they've played: 1 in 2023, 2 in 2022 and their last road doubleheader in 2021 ... the team has won or split their last 6 doubleheaders when playing them away.
- The last time Omaha WON both games of a road doubleheader was in July 2021 in Indianapolis, when Omaha won 2-1 and 4-3 in a doubleheader against the Indians.
- The last time Omaha LOST both games of a road doubleheader was in August 2017 in Memphis, when Omaha lost 3-1 and 4-2 in a doubleheader against the Redbirds.

RELIEF AID

- The Storm Chasers bullpen is one of the best in the International League as Omaha's relievers have combined for a 3.00 ERA through the team's first four games.
- A 3.00 ERA (7 ER in 21.0 IP) ranks 4th out of the 20-team International League and 6th among the 30 Triple-A teams.
- Of the 19 individual appearances by Omaha relief pitchers, 16 have been scoreless.

TODAY'S START

- Veneziano is making his 1st start of the season after being optioned to Omaha on March 20.
Since 2019, his 395.0 innings are the most of any Royals Minor League arm ... also leads the system over the last 4 MiLB seasons in wins (25), strikeouts (427) and starts (83).
Ranked by MLB Pipeline as the No. 14 Royals prospect... Ranked by Baseball America as the No. 5 Royals prospect.

LAST OUTING: SATURDAY, MARCH 30 VS. IOWA

Made his first start of the 2024 regular season last Saturday against the I-Cubs ... allowed 1 run on 3 hits and 2 walks over 3.0 innings, on 47 pitches ... he allowed two singles and two walks in the first inning, then retired 7 of his last 8 Cubs hitters.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Appeared in 3 Cactus League games (0 starts) and went 0-1 with a 9.95 ERA (7 ER in 6.1 IP), with 7 strikeouts.

CAREER NOTES

- 2023: Opened the year with NW Arkansas (AA) and started Opening Day for NWA ... threw at least 5.0 innings and struck out at least 5 in all 8 Double-A starts, with four scoreless starts ... promoted to Triple-A on May 19 and was named Omaha's pitcher of the year, with a 4.22 ERA (42 ER in 89.2 IP) over 18 games (17 starts) ... combined to go 10-5 with a 3.55 ERA (52 ER in 132.0 IP) and 127 strikeouts (8.66 K/9) in the Minors, before he was called up to the big leagues on September 19 to end the year with the Royals.
Among Royals Minor League pitchers: ranked 2nd in wins (10), 2nd in innings (132.0) and 5th in strikeouts (127).
Threw 7 quality starts between the Naturals and Chasers ranked second in the system ... finished 2nd in Omaha with 5 quality starts, including 2 of his final 3 Triple-A outings before his MLB call-up.
Tied a career-high with 10 strikeouts on August 10 vs. Iowa (CHC) over 6.0 scoreless innings with a career-high 104 pitches ... his 22 swings and misses in the game were the most of any Omaha pitcher in a single game this year.
Earned his first Major League call-up on September 19, brought up with RHP Jonathan Bowlan ...waited a week to make his MLB debut on September 26 at Detroit and 2 unearned runs scored ... pitched 1.1 scoreless innings September 28 at Detroit.

- 2022: Spent the entire year with NW Arkansas (AA) and went 6-9 over 26 outings (25 starts) with a 5.72 ERA (78 ER in 122.2 IP) and 129 strikeouts ... made a team-best 8 quality starts and led the Naturals staff in games started and innings pitched ... 3rd among Royals farmhands in strikeouts, tied 3rd in the system in starts and 4th in innings.
All 8 of his quality starts came over his last 15 starts the season, beginning with a 7-inning complete-game shutout on June 9 at Tulsa (LAD), the first complete game of his career and most innings pitched ... was named the Texas League's Pitcher of the Week for June 6-13 after this start, with 5 strikeouts over 7.0 shutout innings.
After struggling in the first two months, improved in the final two thirds of the season ... over his first 9 games (8 starts) in April and May, went 1-4 with a 8.44 ERA (30 ER in 32.0 IP) with 25 strikeouts (7.03 K/9) ... over his last 17 starts from June to September, went 5-5 with a 4.76 ERA (48 ER in 90.2 IP) with 104 strikeouts (10.32 K/9).

- 2021: Spent the entire year with Quad Cities (A+), where he was named the River Bandits' Pitcher of the Year and appeared twice in the High-A Central All-Star team, recognized as the league's Pitcher of the Year, as well as the left-handed starting pitcher representative on the All-Star team ... across 22 starts, went 6-4 with a 3.75 ERA (39 ER in 93.2 IP), while striking out 127 and walking just 37.
His 127 strikeouts led the Royals organization, while 22 starts tied for second and 93.2 innings ranked seventh ... among Royals Minor League pitchers who threw at least 90.0 innings, ranked first with 12.20 K/9 and a 32.3% K%.
Tied for the High-A Central lead in strikeouts, tied for third in games started ... also ranked first in the league in K/9, K% and placed 13th in innings pitched.

- 2019: Spent his first season in pro ball with Idaho Falls (R) in the Pioneer League ... did not allow an earned run in the first 4 games (11.0 innings) of his career, a 4-outing (2 start) span between June 17 and July 3, striking out 9 along the way.

COLLEGE (2017-2019)
Attended Coastal Carolina University, where he pitched in 49 games (35 starts) across three seasons with the Chanticleers (Sun Belt Conference) and went 14-6 with a 5.04 ERA (99 ER in 176.2 IP) with 187 strikeouts ... his career average of 9.53 strikeouts per nine innings ranks eighth all-time.

MISCELLANEOUS
Graduated from Warren Hills High School (N.J.) in 2016, where he had a 0.74 ERA and 64 strikeouts in 47.1 innings as a senior, while leading his team in steals ... threw 9.0 no-hit innings with 16 strikeouts in a game that year, but got a no-decision in an 1-0 loss (11 innings).
