RIDERS COMPLETE LATE COMEBACK IN WIN OVER MISSIONS:

The Frisco RoughRiders used a four-run eighth inning to springboard themselves to a 6-3 win over the San Antonio Missions on Thursday night from Nelson Wolff Stadium. Trailing 3-2, Frisco (5-1) began the eighth with an **Ezequiel Duran** double and had two on after **Sandro Fabian** walked with one out. **Kellen Strahm** then hit a ground ball to short that might have ended the inning on a double play, but it went under shortstop Koray Howell's glove, allowing Strahm to come into score the game-tying run. With two on and two out, **Jordan Procyshen** then hammered a three-run go-ahead home run, putting the Riders up 6-3. **Seth Nordlin** (1-1) earned the win with two scoreless innings and **Lucas Jacobsen** recorded his first save of the season with a 1-2-3 ninth. The Riders have now had a save in all five of their wins this season. Carlos Belen (0-1) took the loss for San Antonio (2-4). The RoughRiders started the scoring off in the first inning when Duran laced an RBI double down the first baseline and took a 2-0 lead on a **J.P. Martinez** RBI single in the second frame. San Antonio fought back in the third inning with an RBI single from Esteury Ruiz and then tied it up at 2-2 with Mitch Walding RBI groundout. In the sixth, the Missions took a 3-2 lead on a sacrifice fly from Brandon Dixon, setting up the comeback for Frisco.

KEEP YOU FRIENDS CLOSE AND YOUR ENEMIES CLOSER:

Through six games, the RoughRiders have won five contests, all by three runs or fewer. So, through those five close wins the Riders have collected five saves, tying them with the Triple-A Nashville Sounds (who have played nine games) for the most in all of Minor League Baseball. Though Frisco is 5-1, their run differential is just +8, which is still good for best in the Texas League and tied for third-best in Double-A.

YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT:

Over the last four games, the RoughRiders have banged out 10 hits in three contests and six hits on Thursday. Their 36 hits in the last four games are more than 13 teams in MiLB have all season. Overall, Frisco is hitting .260/.335/.380 to start the season, a batting average good for fifth in the Texas League. The Riders are also averaging 6.2 runs per game (third in the Texas League) while only hitting three home runs this season. Only the Northwest Arkansas Naturals (one) have fewer home runs in the Texas League this season, while the Springfield Cardinals lead the way with nine.

REARVIEW MIRRORS:

Since the 2019 season ended and the standings reset on September 3rd, 2019, the RoughRiders have not been in second place for 955 days. From the season-opening game in 2021, the RoughRiders held first place the entire season and have now been in first place for every game in 2022 as well.

THE COMEBACK KIDS:

After returning from down 3-2 in the eighth inning on Thursday against San Antonio, the RoughRiders have now had three come-from-behind wins this season in six games. On Opening Day, it was **Ezequiel Duran** with an RBI double as the go-ahead hit in the eighth, while **Jonathan Ornelas** played hero on Tuesday with an RBI single. On Thursday, the tying run scored on an error before **Jordan Procyshen** smashed a three-run home run. When trailing after the seventh inning, Frisco is 3-1.

OUT OF THE GATES:

In 2021, the RoughRiders began the season 3-0 and raced to a 14-6 record through their first 20 games. After starting the year 5-1, the RoughRiders have taken the opening series of the season in back-to-back years and have not lost an opening set since 2018. The 2016 squad started 9-1 through 10 games, 17-4 through 21 games and 23-7 through 30 games. After that, they struggled, going 40-69 the rest of the way, finishing the season in third place in the Texas League South.

WELCOME TO THE LEIT SHOW:

Rangers No.1 prospect, RHP **Jack Leiter** was as-advertised on Saturday in his first start of his professional career. Over his three innings, Leiter whiffed seven while allowing just one run on one hit with two walks. The second-overall pick out of Vanderbilt in the 2021 draft, Leiter was a unanimous First-Team All-American in his final season with the Commodores while tying the NCAA lead in strikeouts on the year. The son of two-time All-Star and two-time World Series champ Al Leiter, Jack is ranked as the No. 17 prospect in baseball by MLB.com.

VS. THE MISSIONS:

The RoughRiders dominated the Missions in 2021, going 13-5 against them in 18 games. To open their road slate last year, Frisco went 5-1 against San Antonio at Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Stadium and then swept them in a six-game series at home in June. The Riders owned a .711 OPS with 14 home runs against the Missions, but where they really dominated was on the mound. Frisco had a 3.58 ERA versus the Missions 4.70 ERA over the 18 games. Including 2022, the RoughRiders are 16-5 against the Missions and dating back to mid-June of 2018, Frisco is 28-13 against the Missions in their last 41 games head-to-head.

LOOK AT ALL THAT TALENT:

While Leiter headlines the top 30 prospects talent on the squad, the Riders back up him with plenty of players to watch. INF **Ezequiel Duran** slots in as the No. 4 prospect in the organization after the Rangers acquired him from the Yankees as part of the **Joey Gallo** deal at the 2021 deadline. OF **Dustin Harris** is the No. 6 prospect after his incredible 20-20 campaign a year ago. Another trade piece, Harris came to the Rangers when they dealt **Mike Minor** to the A's in 2020. A pair of returners from 2021's team round out the prospects in LHP **Cody Bradford** and RHP **Zak Kent**. Bradford, a former Baylor Bear from Aledo, Texas, led all Rangers farmhands in strikeouts last season while Kent finished third in the organization in strikeout rate (31.9).

ABOUT CODY

-Grew up in Aledo, Texas, just an hour away from Frisco. Valedictorian at Aledo High School while helping the baseball team to the state semifinals his junior season (owning a 1.37 ERA) and earning the 2016 All-District 8-5A MVP Pitcher award.

-Grew up a Rangers fan. Derek Holland was his favorite player.

-Married Madi O'Neal (a former softball player at Baylor) on December 15, 2019.

-At Baylor, missed almost his entire final season after being diagnosed with thoracic outlet syndrome, which causes the nerves that pass between the collarbone and first rib to become compressed. He received surgery in March of 2019 before being selected by the Rangers in the June draft. Ranked as a potential second rounder before the injury.

-After FR season at Baylor, spent a lot of time adding good weight to bulk up and it paid off. Following a freshman season in which he went 5-5 with a 5.52 ERA, he turned in a 7-5 season with a 2.38 ERA to earn Big-12 Pitcher of the Year honors.

-Teammates with former Riders infielder Davis Wendzel at Baylor.

2022 SEASON

-Enters season as the Rangers No. 20 prospect.

-Opening Day starter for the RoughRiders (April 8th), exiting in the fifth without allowing a run before both stranded runners scored and were charged to him.

2021 SEASON

-The No. 30 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB.com. Finished the season as a Texas Rangers Organizational All-Star by MLB.com.

-Led Texas farmhands with 128 strikeouts and was tied for second in innings pitched (96.1).

-Started the 2021 season with High-A Hickory, owning a 33.2 percent strikeout rate and a 6.5 percent walk rate.

-On July 22nd, 6.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 0 BB, 14 K against Ashville in a win.

-Whiffed nine over 5.1 innings in Double-A debut against Amarillo on August 5th.

-Struck out 23 before walking a batter over his first three starts with the RoughRiders.

-Seven-inning start against Arkansas on August 18th is the longest start for the RoughRiders on season and also a career-best for Bradford.
