LAST TIME OUT: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats pitched excellently and received just enough offense in a 3-1 win over the Binghamton Rumble Ponies on Wednesday night at Mirabito Stadium. Starting right-hander Chad Dallas matched his career-high with seven innings pitched, allowing just one run on six hits and one walk while striking out five, receiving the win. New Hampshire scored all three of its runs in the fourth inning, despite being outhit by Binghamton eight to five. Will Robertson snapped the Fisher Cats 20-inning scoreless streak with an RBI double off the right-field wall to bring home Phil Clarke. Steward Berroa reached base for a 24th consecutive game with a walk in the third and a two-run double to the wall in left-center to extend the New Hampshire lead 3-0. Left-hander Mason Fluharty struck out two in 1.1 scoreless innings of relief before being taken out in the ninth with one out after giving up a double to Rowdey Jordan. With the tying run at the plate, right-hander Connor Cooke induced a fly out and a strikeout of Agustin Ruiz to pick up his third Double-A save and seal the victory.

STEWARD THE SWIPER: With another stolen base yesterday, OF Steward Berroa continues to own the Eastern League lead in stolen bases with 39 on the season, two ahead of Portland's Corey Rosier. Berroa still holds the longest active on-base streak in the Eastern League at 24 games, five games ahead of the next longest active on-base streak in Akron's Juan Brito. The 24-year-old outfielder has matched the longest Fisher Cat on-base streak this season set by Leo Jimenez at 24 games.

PEAKS AND VALLEYS IN JULY: New Hampshire hit .273 in July, which was the best in the Eastern League. The Fisher Cats also posted a .358 on-base percentage, good for second in the circuit. However, the pitching staff put up an ERA of 5.57, which was last in the league and gave up the most homers in the month (29).

CAN'T STOP CLARKE: C Phil Clarke has been hitting the ball extremely well over the last several games. The 25-yearold catcher has had six two-hit games in his last nine starts dating back to July 8. His average has jumped from .217 to .259 in that span. Over the nine games, he has only struck out twice, both vs Portland on July 23. Clarke has hits in eight of his last nine contests.

YOU CAN CALL HIM "Q": RHP Luis Quinones makes his sixth start of the year and his 22nd overall outing after starting out the season in the bullpen. The 26-year-old righty's last start at Mirabito Stadium was July 27, 2022 where he pitched five innings of one-run ball and struck out a season-high nine in a no-decision. This year, opponents are hitting just .185 against the Puerto Rican native but he has yet to make it through five innings in each of his five starts.

COLLEGE CONNECTIONS: RHP Chad Dallas, Blade Tidwell and Drew Gilbert were all teammates at Tennessee in 2021 that made it to the College World Series....Dallas and Tidwell combined to strike out 212 hitters in 201.2 innings pitched while Gilbert drove in a second-best 62 RBI on the team...OFs Alan Roden and Will Robertson were teammates with Dylan Tebrake at Creighton in 2019. Robertson was a junior while Roden and Tebrake were both freshmen...C Andres Sosa played with Dom Hamel at Dallas Baptist in 2021.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (August 3, 2008) - The Fisher Cats finished off a three-game sweep of Connecticut with an 8-0 win. Brandon Magee tossed a complete-game four-hitter. He walked two and struck out four. New Hampshire hit three consecutive homers in the bottom of the fifth. Andrew Pinckney hit a two-run shot, followed by David Smith and Kyle Phillips.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (60-49) played this afternoon against Baltimore looking for a series split. Jays won 4-1 last night despite having only three hits. A strange sixth lifted them to a win after back-to-back bases-loaded hit-by-pitches to Matt Chapman and Danny Jansen...Buffalo (52-51) is above .500 after a 6-3 win at Lehigh Valley. Paxton Schultz (2-3) allowed one run in 5.2 IP with six strikeouts to earn the win. New shortstop Mason McCoy had his second consecutive multi-hit game, driving in three with a single and double. McCoy was dealt to the Jays organization for pitcher Trent Thornton last week...Vancouver (61-36) shut down Hillsboro on the road 8-0 last night. Adam Macko went the first five innings to improve to 4-4 on the season...Dunedin (45-53) lost at home 5-2 to Fort Myers. Angel Del Rosario had two hits and an RBI for the Jays.
