**LAST TIME OUT:** The Cyclones extended their win streak to 3 with a 4-2 victory over the IronBirds on Wednesday...CF **Stanley Consuegra** picked an RBI triple to make it 2-0 in the 5th...Aberdeen tied it in the 7th on a 2-run home run by 3B **Max Wagner**...Brooklyn jumped ahead for good thanks to 3 doubles in the home 7th...LF **Alex Ramirez** led off and scored on C **Kevin Parada's** 2-bagger...DH **Drake Osborn** brought in Parada to cap the parade...RHP **Jeffrey Colón** punched out a season-high 7 over a team-season-best 6.2 innings...RHP **Paul Gervase** stranded the bases loaded in the 9th to earn his first career save.

**WE'RE GOING STREAKING:** Brooklyn enters Thursday on a season-best 3-game winning streak dating back to last Thursday at Jersey Shore...Additionally, the Cyclones have won a season-high 3-consecutive home games...It is the first winning streak of 3+ games for Brooklyn since they won 6-straight to clinch the Second Half North Division crown from September 3-8, 2022, vs. Wilmington and at Winston-Salem...It is the 'Clones first 3+ game win streak at Maimonides Park since August 4-6, 2022, vs. Winston-Salem.

**HOME COOKING:** The Cyclones pitching staff has been marvelous through the team's first 10 home games in 2023...Entering Thursday, Brooklyn has the best ERA at home (2.44) in the South Atlantic League...Hudson Valley is second (2.61)...The Cyclones also hold the second-best batting average against in home games this season (.199)...Only Hudson Valley pitchers have held opponents to a lower average (.186)...Since Brooklyn's second homestand of the season vs. Wilmington began on April 18, the Cyclones hold the best ERA in the circuit (2.62) by nearly a full run...Hickory is second best (3.43).

**CHIEF COLÓN:** RHP **Jeffrey Colón** became the first Cyclone pitcher to work into the 7th inning in 2023 on Wednesday night...The 23-year-old was removed with 2 outs in the 6th frame, yielding a single run on 6 hits...He walked 1 and struck out a season-best 7...Colón is the first Brooklyn pitcher to work into the 7th inning since he did it himself in a win at Winston-Salem on September 9, 2022.

**BULLS ON PARADA:** C **Kevin Parada** registered a career-high 3 hits in Brooklyn's 4-3, 10-inning win over Aberdeen on Tuesday night...The 21-year-old singled in the 1st, doubled off the left-field fence and scored in the 6th, and added a triple into the right-center field gap in the 8th...Parada has 3 multi-hit games in his last 7 outings...In that span, the Pasadena, Calif. native is hitting .300 (9-30) with 5 extra-base hits and 2 RBI.

**STU-PENDOUS:** RHP **Tyler Stuart** has been as consistent as any starting pitcher in the SAL in 2023...The 23-year-old punched out a career-high 9 batters over 5 innings in a no-decision on Tuesday vs. Aberdeen...The 9 K's were the most by a Cyclones pitcher this season...Stuart's 9 punchouts were the most by for a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP **Dominic Hamel** struck out 9 vs. Wilmington on September 2, 2022...Entering Wednesday, Stuart leads the SAL in ERA (1.93)...He is 5th in batting average against (.203), 6th in strikeouts (27), and 10th in WHIP (1.23)...The right-hander is also 3rd in xFIP (3.15) and 4th in strikeout rate (34.6%).

**FEELING BULL-ISH:** Brooklyn's bullpen has been sublime over the last 4 outings dating back to last Wednesday at Jersey Shore...In the first 2 games of the series vs. Aberdeen, Cyclone relievers have combined to yield just 2 runs (1 earned) over 7.1 innings...Over the last 4 games, Brooklyn relief arms have accrued a miniscule 1.20 ERA (2 ER in 15.0 IP)...In 15.0 innings, Brooklyn relief pitching has permitted 9 hits, 13 walks, and struck out 21.

**SPEED DEMONS:** Brooklyn has habitually swiped bases in 2023...Coming into Thursday's matchup, OF **Omar De Los Santos** is 2nd in the South Atlantic League with 13 and IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is tied for 6th with 10...More importantly, both are a combined 23-for-24 on attempts...The 'Clones are tied for 6th in the league with 39 team stolen bases, but have the best success rate in the SAL at .886...Brooklyn has been caught stealing a league-low 5 times this year...

**vs. ABERDEEN** Brooklyn returns to Coney Island for a 6-game set against the Orioles' High-A affiliate...The IronBirds claim 5 of Baltimore's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*...2022 No. 1 overall pick — SS **Jackson Holliday** — is the top-rated prospect at No. 3 in the organization...OF **Dylan Beavers** (11), OF **Jud Fabian** (14), INF **Max Wagner** (19), and INF **Frederick Bencosme** (29) are also featured...The Cyclones were eliminated by the IronBirds, 2-1, in the 2022 South Atlantic League North Division Championship last September...Brooklyn is 118-105 (.529) all-time against Aberdeen.

Hudson Valley and Aberdeen are in 2nd with 7 runners caught.

**OMNIPRESENT OMAR:** In addition to his 13 stolen bases in 13 attempts in 2023, OF **Omar De Los Santos** remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 83 stolen bases in that span, which is the 3rd most in MiLB...Only Triple-A El Paso & Nashville OF **Esteury Ruíz** (85) and Double-A Portland & Triple-A Worcester INF **David Hamilton** (84) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 51 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 32...Omar is already 19 swipes shy of matching INF **Walter Rasquin's** franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) that was set back in 2017.

**DANIEL'S DOMINANCE:** LHP **Daniel Juárez** has been as dominant as can be out of the bullpen for the Cyclones in 2023...In his first 7 outings of the campaign, the southpaw holds a 2-0 record with 1 save...He has not permitted a run on 3 hits and 3 walks, striking out 12...In 12 regular season appearances with the 'Clones dating back to last season, Juárez has yielded only 1 unearned run in 11.2 innings...The 22-year-old has not surrendered an earned run in 20 straight appearances dating back to last year...Juárez last allowed earned runs on June 22, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie at Palm Beach...Since then, he is 4-0 with 8 hits allowed, 12 walks, and 27 strikeouts in 22.0 innings.

**NEW KIDS ON CONEY:** Brooklyn added INF **Mateo Gil** to the roster from Double-A Binghamton and RHP **Benito García** from Single-A St. Lucie on Tuesday...Gil, the son of 8-year Major League INF **Benji Gil**, slashed .143/.214/.204 in 14 games for the Rumble Ponies, adding 7 RBI...García made 5 relief appearances with St. Lucie, composing a 1-2 mark with a 3.86 ERA (4 ER in 9.1 IP) and 5 strikeouts...INF **Brad Malm** was transferred to the Development List.

**ATOP THE WONDER WHEEL:** Prior to Opening Day, *Baseball America* ranked the Brooklyn Cyclones as having the fourth most-talented roster in all of Minor League Baseball...The 'Clones are the highest rated non-Triple-A squad, falling just behind the Norfolk Tides (1), Durham Bulls (2), and Columbus Clippers (3)...Brooklyn is the lone South Atlantic League team and A-level club to be recognized within the Top 10.

**MEET THE 'NEW' BOSS:** Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18).

**PROSPECTS:** Brooklyn hosts 3 of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America* and 4 of the Top 30...They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 3 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF **Alex Ramirez** (4/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7/9)...INF **William Lugo** (27/26) also appears on both lists...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 21 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Picked up a no decision last Tuesday night at Jersey Shore...Permitted 3 runs on a career-high 7 hits over a career-best-matching 5.0 innings...Walked 4 and struck out 6...Hurlled a professional-high 92 pitches (48 strikes)...Did not allow a run and faced the minimum over his final 3.0 innings...Relieved by RHP **Jace Beck** in the bottom of the 6th with the Cyclones in front, 4-3...BlueClaws scored 2 in the 6th and added single runs in the 7th and 8th to win, 7-4.

**TOP PROSPECT:** Tidwell enters the 2023 season ranked as the Mets' top pitching prospect per MLB Pipeline...Comes at No. 7 overall on the Top 30 list...The 21-year-old is considered the organization's No. 9 overall farmhand by *Baseball America*...Only RHP **Kodai Senga** is a higher-ranked pitcher on their list...Selected as having the "Best Fastball" and "Best Secondary Pitch" in the Mets' 2022 draft class.

**2022:** Selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 draft...Signed for \$1.85 million on July 27...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 9...Tossed 1.0 scoreless inning vs. FCL Astros Blue before joining Single-A St. Lucie on August 16...Made 4 starts, registering an 0-1 record with a 2.16 ERA (2 ER in 8.1 IP) and 9 strikeouts...Hurlled 9.2-scoreless innings for St. Lucie in the Florida State League playoffs, helping the Mets to their first league title since 2006...Earned his first professional win in the decisive Game 2 of the Championship Series on September 20 vs. Dunedin (5.0 IP, 3 H, 2 BB, 7 SO).

**VOLUNTEER SERVICE:** Tidwell joined the New York system after an incredible career at Tennessee...As a draft-eligible sophomore in 2022, The Volunteer State native accrued a 3-2 record with a 3.00 ERA (13 ER in 39.0 IP) and 51 punch outs in 13 appearances (9 starts)...Missed the first two months of the season with shoulder soreness...Named to the 2022 Knoxville Regional All-Tournament team...As a freshman in 2021, Tidwell was recognized on the SEC All-Freshman Team and named a Freshman All-American by D1Baseball.com and Perfect Game.

**LORETTO LIGHTNING:** Tidwell is no stranger to being around talent...At Loretto (Tenn.) High School, the former second-round selection was teammates with 2018 first-round pick (No. 7 overall) and current San Diego Padres LHP **Ryan Weathers**...Ryan's father, **David**, who pitched for the Mets (2002-04) is also a Loretto High School alum.
