ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Hudson Valley struck for four early runs and outlasted Brooklyn 5-2 in the series opener on Tuesday. Against Cyclones RHP **Junior Santos**, the Renegades struck for three-straight doubles to start the game, jumping out to a 3-0 lead in the bottom of the first inning. INF **Jose Peroza** answered for the Cyclones, drilling a two-run triple down the right field line in the top of the second against RHP **Blane Abeyta**, cutting the deficit to 3-2, but the Cyclones did not score for the rest of the game.

METS-YANKS: Brooklyn faces Hudson Valley 30 times this season, having already played 13 times. The Renegades have won seven of the 13 games. The Cyclones are hitting just .163 with a .282 on-base percentage against the Renegades over 13 games with a 33% strikeout rate. Against the rest of the league, the Cyclones are hitting .220 with a .312 on-base percentage with a 25% strikeout rate.

BOMBOSAS: Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs in Coney Island, Brooklyn has completely turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 28 home runs in the past 36 games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.

JT'S JUNE 1B JT Schwartz leads the team with 34 total bases in June, batting .303 with a .347 OBP. The No. 19 prospect in the Mets organization has raised his batting average from .241 to .266 this month. The tall lefty has played a team-high 65 games in 2022.

THE GRANT POOBAH: RHP **Grant Hartwig** earned his sixth save of the year earlier in the week, sitting one off league leaders Jason Ruffcorn of Jersey Shore and Joe LaSorsa of Bowling Green. Hartwig is a perfect six for six in saves and owns a staff-best

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: The New York Yankees farm club has won seven of the 13 games so far with 17 head-to-head games remaining. The Renegades host seven of the Yankees' Top 30 prospects, including a trio of Top 10 prospects: No. 6 SS Trey Sweeney, No. 8 RHP Yoendrys Gomez, and No. 10 OF Everson Pereira. The Renegades are managed by first-year skipper Tyson Blaser.

45% strikeout rate. The former Miami RedHawks pitcher has allowed just one run in 13 innings.

ARMS STRONG: Brooklyn arms have posted a 3.31 earned run average in 26 games with 15 home runs in June, after posting a 5.27 ERA in 23 May games with 20 home runs allowed. In April, the Cyclones pitching staff stood as one of the best in the minors, posting a 2.98 ERA with just four home runs allowed and a 27% strikeout rate.

MURPHY'S NEW LAW: OF **Tanner Murphy** has been on a tear over his past 10 games, going 12-32 (.375) with a double, triple, and two home runs -- good for an .656 slugging percentage over the stretch and a 1.115 OPS. Murphy is hitting .244 over 28 games with Brooklyn this year. Last year, Murphy hit just .181 through 23 High-A games.

FIVE MILLION: This past home series against Jersey Shore, Catherine Bruning was celebrated as the five-millionth fan. The Cyclones crossed over the plateau into 5,000,000 on Friday night.

SECOND HALF START: Thursday, June 24th, marked the start of the second half of the season in the South Atlantic League. Brooklyn finished the first half 30-36. Aberdeen won the North Division, while Bowling Green won the South. The final 66 games of the season determine the next two teams to make the playoffs.

THE HIGH-A DEBUT CONTINUES: Mike Vasil makes his first start against the Hudson Valley Renegades.

TOP 30: Vasil ranks as the No. 21 prospect in the Mets organization, according to MLB Pipeline, after his draft selection in 2021. The righty signed for \$181,200 after his 8th-round selection by New York (NL).

FLORIDA PHENOM: Vasil dominated his time in St. Lucie, pitching with the Low-A affiliate of the Mets. In eight starts with the Baby Mets, Vasil compiled a slim 1.80 ERA over 35.0 innings. Amongst qualified arms, Vasil departs the Florida State League with the lowest ERA (1.80) and a 2.29 FIP, marking the best metrics in the circuit at the time of his promotion.

TAMP DOWN: In his penultimate appearance with the St. Lucie Mets, Vasil struck out 11 Tampa Tarpons hitters over a career-high seven innings on May 17.

VASIL AT VIRGINIA: The 6-foot-5 Vasil pitched in the ACC with Virginia, making 34 career appearances and 32 starts. He posted a 4.74 ERA in 161 1/3 innings. In his 2021 season, his junior year on campus, Vasil made 16 starts which tied for second-most in the ACC, ranking fifth in strikeouts looking (33).

MASSACHUSETTS MIKE: The righty pitched at the University of Virginia after earning No. 1 overall player in the state of Massachusetts by Perfect Game in 2017. He was a First Team All-State pick by USA Today and the 2017 Massachusetts Player of the Year.
