The Fightin Phils continue a six-game series at the Richmond Flying Squirrels on Thursday night. Following Tuesday's postponment, the teams will play a doubleheader at The Diamond. Richmond holds the 1-0 edge in this week's series after winning the series in 2023 8-1. Reading was swept in their lone trip to Richmond last season, a series-opening three game series. This is the lone series between the teams this season as their won't be a trip to Reading.

LHP Matt Osterberg vs LHP John Michael Betrand RHP Robinson Pina vs RHP Carson Ragsdale

The Fightin Phils fell at Richmond 6-4 on Wednesday night. Reading struck first with two runs in the top of the first, thanks to hits from Robert Moore, Carson Taylor and Caleb Ricketts. Richmond responded with two runs in the second, with only one being earned. The game remained tied until the bottom of the eighth, when Richmond scored four runs off Mitch Neunborn, but all were unearned. Reading fought back with two runs in the top of the ninth, thanks to an error and doubles from Robert Moore and Carson Taylor, but it was too little too late.

Reading set a new season-high with five doubles in last night's game. It surpassed the Fightin Phils previous season-high of four doubles in a game. Reading's season-high for doubles in a game last season was five, which they did five times. Carson Taylor and Robert Moore each had two doubles in the loss, tying the most by a R-Phils player in a game this season. Moore leads Reading with seven doubles this season, and Taylor is right behind him at six two-baggers.

Carson Crushin' It

Carson Taylor's red-hot season continued on Wednesday night. Taylor had three hits, a run, two doubles and two RBI. His .341 average is tied for the Eastern League lead and ranks tied for third in Double-A. His 29 RBI also lead the Eastern League and all of Double-A. His other Eastern League ranks are third in OBP (.427), fourth in SLG% (.585) and fourth in OPS (1.012).

Pinpoint Pina

Robinson Pina pitched six innings for the second time this season, and has now earned a winning decision in his last four starts. Pina is tied for the Eastern League lead in wins with four, which also ranks as tied for second in Double-A. Pina has the best strikeout to walk ratio in the Eastern League by a wide margin at 12, with second place sitting at 6.40. That mark also leads all of Double-A and is tied for sixth in all of Minor League Baseball. Pina's 10.8 strikeout-per-nine ratio also ranks as eighth in the Eastern League. Over his last four starts Pina is: 4-0, with a 2.86 ERA (22 IP, 3 BB, 29 SO).

Noah Skirrow has put together the two best outings of his season over his last two starts. After a month of April that saw Skirrow go 0-2, with an 11.81 ERA, Skirrow did not pitch for 10 days, as he was on the Development List during Reading's series in Portland from Apr. 30-May 5. Since coming off the Development List, Skirrow has been locked in during his two May starts. Following six-strong innings last night, Skirrow is 1-0, with a 0.82 ERA in May.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 16, 2007: At Reading, Kyle Kendrick goes 8.0 innings, giving up 8 hits and one run and Javon Moran is 3-for-5 with a homer, two runs and two RBI as the Phils beat New Hampshire, 7-4. Mike Zagurski enters in the 9th inning only to throw three pitches (two balls and one strike) before rain causes a 41 minute delay. When play resumes, Allen Davis issues a walk to Aaron Mathews, which is charged to Zagurski. Mathews later scores, becoming the only run credited to Zagurski's record in 7.0 innings of work as an R-Phil that season.

Richmond enters today with a 13-21 record, which is fifth in the Southwest Division. The Flying Squirrels were swept on the road at Erie last week, and entered this week's series on an eight-game losing streak, which was snapped on Wednesday night. After this week, Richmond is back on the road at Bowie. Last season, Richmond finished 74-64 and lost to Erie in the first round of the playoffs. Richmond's roster features seven of the Giants top-30 prospects, including: Hayden Birdsong (6), Grant McCray (13), Vaun Brown (15), Victor Bericoto (19), Adrian Sugastey (23), Jairo Pomares (26) and Carson Ragsdale (30).

Squirrel on the Bump

Righty, and Giants No. 6 Prospect Hayden Birdsong makes the start in game one of tonight's doubleheader. So far this season, Birdsong is 1-1, with a 2.49 ERA over six starts (25.1 IP, 13 H, 14 BB, 35 SO). In his last outing on May 9, Birdsong went five innings and allowed one run in a no-deicision at Erie. He struck out six in the contest. Birdsong split 2023 between three levels, making 12 appearances with Single-A San Jose, eight with High-A Eugene and eight with Richmond. He combined to go 2-5, with a 3.31 ERA between the stops. Birdsong began his pro career in 2022 between the ACL-Giants and San Jose. The Giants selected him in the sixth round of the 2022 draft out of Eastern Illinois. Lefty Nick Swiney will start game two for the Flying Squirrels. It will be his first start as he is 2-1, with a 5.94 ERA over 11 relief appearances. Swiney split 2023 between Richmond and Triple-A Sacramento, going 3-2, with a 4.37 ERA over 32 games. He spent 2022 with High-A Eugene and split 2021 between Single-A San Jose and the ACL-Giants. Swiney was drafted in Round 2C of the 2020 draft from NC State.

2024 Notes: On Fightin Phils Opening Day Roster. Hit around in Apr. 6 loss at Bowie. Allowed eight-earned runs on seven hits in just 2.1 innings pitched. Eight runs allowed were a career high. Struggled in second-straight outing on Apr. 13 vs Portland. Allowed five-earned runs, including two more homers, while suffering second-straight loss. Also racked up season-high four walks and four strikeouts. Four walks was one shy of career-high. Was on Development List from Apr. 14-21. Struggled with comman Apr. 21 at Binghamton, lasing just 2.2 innings and walking four for second-straight outing. Placed on 7-day IL Apr. 23 and activated prior to start on May 8. Best outing of season May 8 vs Hartford, where he tossed season-high 4.1 innings pitched in no-decision.

CAREER TRANSACTIONS: Signed a minor league contract with the San Diego Padres as an International Free Agent on July 8, 2017. Elected free agency from the Padres on November 6, 2023. Signed a minor league contract with the Philadelphia Phillies on December 16, 2023.

2023: Spent the entire season with Double-A San Antonio in the Padres organization. Led the team in strikeouts and innings pitched. Earned his first win since 2019 on May 11 against Corpus Christi, pitching six innings, allowing no-earned runs, and picking up eight strikeouts. Had a 3.88 strikeout to walk ratio (31 SO, 8 BB) in five May starts and struck out 31.8% of the batters faced (34-107) in five June starts. Had at least six strikeouts in seven-straight games from May 23 through June 28, which was tied for the longest such streak in the Texas League. Pitched in one postseason game.

2022: Made all his appearances with High-A Fort Wayne after starting the season on the injured list. Posted a 2.45 ERA (5 ER, 18.1 IP) and a 0.93 WHIP (10 H, 7 BB) in five appearances (four starts) for Peoria in the Arizona Fall League.

2021: Missed the entire season recovering from Tommy John Surgery.

2020: Did not pitch as season was cancelled due to COVID-19 Pandemic.

2019: Spent the season with Single-A Fort Wayne. Went 3-0 with a 2.81 ERA (8 ER, 25.2 IP) and limited hitters to a .194 average (18-93) in five May starts. On the temporary inactive list from June 28 through July 2. In five August starts, went 2-0 with a 2.10 ERA (6 ER, 25.2). Transferred to Single-A Lake Elsinore on September 3 and pitched four-scoreless innings in his lone playoff appearance on September 11 against Visalia.

2018: Began his professional career with the Dominican Summer League Padres (ROK), where he averaged 11.64 strikeouts per nine innings pitched, posted a 8.33 strikeout to walk ratio and struck out 33.8% of the batters he faced (25-74). Transferred to Arizona League Padres 1 (ROK) on June 26 and led the team in strikeouts. Set career highs in strikeouts (10) and innings pitched (7.0) on July 11 as AZL-Reds. Promoted to Single-A Tri-City on August 28. With all three teams, had a 1.09 ERA (4 ER, 33.0 IP) and a 0.88 WHIP (22 H, 7 BB) over nine relief appearances.

2024 Notes: On Fightin Phils Opening Day roster. Made first start of season Apr. 10 vs Portland and earned win over five-innings pitched. It was his first affiliated win since Aug. 11, 2019, while with Fort Myers. Lone run came on a solo home run. Placed on 7-day IL Apr. 16 and activated prior to start on Apr. 23. In first start off IL, went 4.2 IP and earned no decision. Struck out season-best to date six hitters, and allowed three runs on four hits, wiht 72 pitches. Matched season-best to date with five-innings pitched Apr. 28 vs SOM. Struck out a season-high eight batters. Both runs allowed were on solo home runs. Best start of season May 5 at Portland (first road start), where he threw six-shutout innings, but did not factor into the decision. Suffered first loss of season May 11 vs Hartford. Allowed season-high seven hits and matched season-high with three runs allowed.

CAREER TRANSACTIONS: Signed by Minnesota Twins as International Free Agent on November 21, 2014. Released by Minnesota Twins on February 9, 2022. Signed by Philadelphia Phillies as Minor League Free Agent on January 7, 2024.

2023: Made return to competitive baseball during winter of 2023-24 with Adelaide Giants of the Australian Baseball League. Made nine starts and was lockdown in the Giants rotation. Went 6-0 with a 0.94 ERA. Struck out 63 hitters across 47.2 innings pitched. Posted 11.9 strikeouts per nine innings and a 9.0 strikeout to walk ratio (63 SO, 7 BB). Collected multiple accolades for Adelaide and helped Giants to Australian Baseball League Championship. Strong season led him to sign with Phillies during the winter.

2021-22: Did not pitch.

2020: Spent 2020-21 season with Sydney Blue Sox of Australian Baseball League. Made just three appearances and went 1-0 with 1.08 ERA. Struck out 15 across 8.1 innings pitched, which was good for 16.2 strikeouts per nine innings pitched.

2019: Split 2019 between Gulf Coast Twins (Rookie) and High-A Fort Myers. Began season on 7-day Injured List and remained on until June 30. Made one rehab appearance for Rookie-Level GCL Twins on June 24. After activation from IL on Jue 30, remained with Fort Myers for the remainder of the season. Posted 4.09 ERA over nine appearances and eight starts and went 2-5. Struck out 7.2 batters per nine innings and posted a 3.25 strikeout per walk ratio.

2018: Did not pitch as he remained on the injured list for the duration of the season.

2017: Split the season between GCL Twins (Rookie) and High-A Fort Myers. Began season with Fort Myers and was placed on the 7-day injured list on July 1.
