RIDERS RETAKE FIRST PLACE WITH VICTORY:
The Frisco RoughRiders staved off the Midland RockHounds 4-3 on Thursday from Riders Field. Midland (24-18) jumped out to a 2-0 lead after Brennan Milone stung a solo homer in the top of the first inning and another solo shot in the top of the third inning. Frisco (24-17) countered in the bottom of the third when **Theo Hardy** scored on a wild pitch, trimming the RockHounds lead to 2-1. In the bottom of the fourth, Hardy hit a game-tying single and **Tucker Mitchell** rolled a two-run single to propel the Riders to a 4-2 lead. Midland then countered in the top of the eighth when Milone slammed his third home run of the game, setting a career best and pulling the RockHounds to within a run. In the bottom of the ninth, Frisco reliever Gerardo Carrillo struck out his first two batters, then allowed back-to-back singles before punching out Drew Swift to secure a 4-3 victory. He is the ninth different RoughRider to earn a save in 2025. Frisco starter **Josh Stephan** (3-1) snatched the victory, allowing two runs while striking out six across five innings. Midland starter James Gonzalez (2-2) took the loss, allowing four runs across his five innings.

On Thursday night, **Gerardo Carrillo** became the ninth different Riders pitcher to record a save in 2025. Frisco and Low-A Palm Beach (Cardinals affiliate) are the only two teams in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat this season. Current Triple-A Round Rock pitcher Robby Ahlstrom leads the Riders with four saves while Skylar Hales and Gavin Collyer both have two saves. Frisco leads the Texas League and is tied for sixth in MiLB with 14 saves

KNOCK THAT STARTER OUT ASAP:

The RoughRiders have been much better against the bullpen on offense than they have been against starting pitchers. Against starters, the RoughRiders are slashing .244/.319/.381/.700 with the second-fewest RBIs in the league (71). When the Riders face opposing bullpens, they are hitting .250/.345/.384/.729 with 111 RBIs (2nd) and 20 HR (T2nd).

The RoughRiders overall are hitting .234 with runners in scoring position, but have struggled over their last 24 games. In that stretch, the Riders are just 12-12, batting .186 (38-for-204)/.267/.289/.556 with RISP. Their .186 batting average is last in the Texas League and 28th among 30 Double-A teams.

ABIM-ELECTRIC ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. While having reached in his last 12 games, Ortiz is hitting .370 (17-for-46). 473.652/1.125 with four doubles, three home runs and 13 RBIs. Last Wednesday, he clubbed the first walk-off grand slam in franchise history while driving in six runs. His six RBIs were the most in a game since 2022 (**Josh Stowers**). On Friday, he hammered a game-tying home run in the bottom of the ninth before the Riders eventually won 6-5 in 11 innings on a **Josh Hatcher** RBI single. He is 10th in the Texas League in May average (.304), third in RBIs (16), tied for third in home runs (four) and seventh in OPS (.982). For his efforts and three home runs, Ortiz was named Texas League Player of the Week.

MAY FLOWERS AND HOMERS:

The RoughRiders have both hit and given up their fair share of long balls this month. They have hit 14 this month, which is eighth in the league and have allowed 24, which is the most. Frisco's 4.45 ERA is fourth in the league during the month while they are just 9-8 in May.

Aaron Zavala has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .299 (23-for-77)/.444/.494/.938 over his last 23 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (34) and is second in OBP (.426) while leading the league in walk rate (24.1 percent), a mark which also ranks 2nd in Minor League Baseball (min. 130 PA). His 14game on-base streak ended Thursday, batting .367 (18-for-49)/.516/.551/1.067 with 15 runs scored, a double, a triple, two home runs, 11 RBIs and 15 walks. During the streak, he reached multiple times in 11 of the 14 games. In May, he is hitting .316/.458/.474/.932, ranking eighth in average and OPS in the Texas League.

HOUND HUNTING:

The Riders struggled against the Midland RockHounds a season ago. On top of being knocked out the postseason by Midland last year, they went just 6-12 during the regular season against the A's affiliate. Frisco was held to a .219/.291/.305/.596 slashline against the RockHounds. Since 2015, the Riders have had just one winning season against Midland, going 97-126 (.434) against the As affiliate.

BRATT SUMMER IS BACK:

Mitch Bratt has been one of the stronger arms for Frisco to start the year. Through his first seven starts, his 2.21 ERA is second in the Texas League. His 4.1 percent walk rate is the best in the Texas League while 7.83 K/BB is also first.
