### FRES-NOTES

**COULDN'T CRUISE TO A WIN:** The Fresno Grizzlies (36-27) were defeated by the Stockton Ports (26-36) 4-3 Tuesday night from Chukchansi Park. Fresno dropped to 29-3 when leading after seven innings (10-2 at home) and 28-10 when scoring first (10-4 at home). The Grizzlies fell to 9-3 in the first game of a series and 7-3 on Tuesdays (both 3-3 at home). Fresno moved to 8-10 in one-run affairs (6-4 at home) and 9-4 when a game lasts exactly or longer than 2 hours and 40 minutes. Fresno clawed in front 1-0 in the bottom of the first when GJ Hill smacked a single to right, netting Luis Mendez. The Grizzlies roared ahead 3-0 in the bottom of the third when EJ Andrews Jr. mashed a two-RBI double off the wall in left field. It was Andrews Jr. fifth multi-RBI game of 2024. In the top of the fifth, Stockton cut the deficit to 3-1 when Ryan Lasko lased a longball over the left field wall. It was Lasko's fourth homer of the season. The Ports grabbed a 4-3 lead thanks to a three-run top of the eighth. Nelson Beltran scampered home on a wild pitch and Myles Naylor ripped a single to left, plating Nate Nankil. With the game tied, the Grizzlies couldn't turn a double play to conclude the inning, allowing Ports' Clark Elliott to waltz in with the go-ahead run. Grizzlies' lefty Albert Pacheco took a no-decision after five and two-thirds innings of work. Pacheco's lone run permitted was from the Lasko solo shot. He gave up five hits and three walks while striking out five, with three of those punchouts landing in the first frame. Cade Denton secured a hold (4) after one and one-third innings of scoreless baseball. Bryson Hammer (2-2) suffered the loss after yielding three runs (all earned). This ended Hammer's earned run scoreless streak at 12 games (started May 7). Welinton Herrera fanned all three batters in the ninth. Grizzlies' Manager Steve Soliz was ejected in the bottom of the sixth by home plate umpire Chad Laguna (interference call on Luis Mendez).

**STOCK-PILING SOME STATS:** The Fresno Grizzlies and Stockton Ports (Oakland Athletics Single-A affiliate) continue their six-game series tonight at Chukchansi Park. This is the third of five series between the clubs in 2024 and the first set in Fresno. The Grizzlies are 71-26 all-time (18-12 last year, fourth most wins all-time in a single-season vs. one team) against the Ports with a 40-8 all-time record (10-2 this year) at Banner Island Ballpark. In 2022, Fresno went 26-4 against Stockton with a +123 run differential (239-116). Those 26 wins broke the team record for the most victories against an opponent in a single season.

**COUPEP NAMED CALIFORNIA LEAGUE PITCHER OF THE WEEK:** Grizzlies' LHP Isaiah Coupet was tabbed by Minor League Baseball as the California League Pitcher of the Week for June 10-16. Coupet's sensational relief outing on Saturday, June 15 versus Rancho Cucamonga guided Fresno to a comeback walk-off win that evening. Coupet piggy-backed starter McCade Brown with five unbelievable innings of relief, facing one over the minimum. Coupet did not permit a hit or run, striking out eight Quakes' batters. He bearded one hitter and issued a walk. Coupet narrowly missed an immaculate first inning out of the bullpen, tossing two extra pitches to Sean McLain, punching out the side. The 21-year-old product from The Ohio State University gives the 2024 Grizzlies their third overall California League award this season (Jack Mahoney and Welinton Herrera). Both Herrera and Coupet won their awards while pitching out of the pen during the week. Fresno won 10 California League honors (Weekly and Monthly) in 2023 and 14 California League honors (Weekly and Monthly) in 2022, a franchise record.

**KANNON WILL COME IN HANDY TONIGHT:** Tonight, the Grizzlies give the ball to LHP Kannon Handy, who joined Fresno on May 30. Handy was selected by the Rockies in the 19th round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Colorado Mesa (D-2 school). He pitched at Colorado Mesa for four seasons, appearing in 46 games (38 starts). Handy went 21-4 with a 4.63 ERA over 213.2 innings. His 263 collegiate strikeouts put him third on the program's all-time list. Colorado Mesa is about a four-hour drive to Coors Field and Handy went to Jordan High School in Utah.

**NO RUN SUPPORT FOR EMENER:** Grizzlies' LHP Austin Emener has made 10 starts this season and has yet to earn a professional win (0-4, 4.65 ERA). A big reason why Emener has not earned a win is from the lack of run support he has received. Fresno has scored 31 runs overall (3.10 runs a game) in contests started by Emener. However, the team has only scored 17 runs (1.70 runs a game) when Emener is still pitching in the game. 12 of those 17 runs were plated in Emener's first two starts of the season, which means he has only received five runs of support in his last eight outings (0.63 runs a game). Four of those eight games included zero runs of offensive support.

**NEW MAN AT THE TOP OF THE LINEUP:** Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has relished his new role as the team's leadoff hitter. Since Hobson has been plugged into the leadoff spot, he has reached base 44 times in 95 plate appearances (20 games). In eight of those 20 games, Hobson has made it on base three or more times, combining to score 22 runs. Part of Hobson's success is in his first plate appearance of the game, where he is 6-for-14 with five walks and one hit-by-pitch. All six hits have been singles with two of them landing as bunt singles. Hobson has also swiped 14 bags, picking up two of them in five of those leadoff games (19 stolen bases on the season).

**TENA IS ON A TEAR:** Grizzlies' OF Felix Tena has reached base safely in 22 straight games from May 18-June 18 and has at least one hit in 21 of those 22 contests (12-game hit streak and nine-game hit streak). Tena is 27-for-85 (.318) with one homer, two triples, seven doubles, 15 RBI, eight runs, five walks, four hit-by-pitches and two stolen bases in that span.

**A+ FROM ANDY PEREZ:** Grizzlies' INF Andy Perez hit safely in his first 18 games and 23 of his first 24 contests to start the season, his longest hit streak while in a Fresno uniform (two seasons). It was the second longest hit streak in the Grizzlies/Rockies affiliation since Drew Romo in 2021 (21 games, July 6-August 15) and it was the longest active streak in Minor League Baseball at the time. Perez went 26-for-76 (.342 AVG/.385 OBP/.579 SLG/.962 OPS) with three homers (one grand slam), three triples, three doubles, 18 RBI, 12 runs, five walks and two stolen bases in that hit streak stretch. Perez's triple on May 31 at San Jose was his 11th in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him two triples shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.
