Amongst all II. hitters, Turang is 2nd in runs (88), T-2nd in hits (150), 6th in stolen bases (34), 8th in walks (64) and 8th in total bases (213). Jon Singleton is 1st in walks (113), T-4th in runs (84), 6th in RBI (86), 6th in on-base percentage (.374), T-7th in home runs (24) and 10th in extra-base hits (48).

Frelick On-Base: With off days on Friday and Saturday, outfielder Sal Frelick's on-base streak stays at 39 consecutive games, the longest active streak in the International League and the longest by a Sound this season.

During the streak, Frelick is hitting .363 (57-for-157) with 36 runs, 8 doubles, 2 triples, 4 home runs, 22 RBI, 17 walks and 8 stolen bases. Since joining Nashville on August 2, Frelick leads the IL with 66 hits, 8 more than the second-most of 58 hits by Rochester's Jake Alu. He also has the best batting average (.365) in that span.
