**Today:** The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the fourth game in a six-game series at the Great Lakes Loons, High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers. The Loons have won two of the first three games, leaving Great Lakes with a 6-3 overall lead in the 18-game season series.

On the Air: Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa smoothly handle the Nuts' call via StreamGuys, while the heroic Brad Tunney battles through illness to join John Vicari for the call on MiLB TV.

Last Night: Loons 5, Lugnuts 3. A pair of big swings from Virginia Cavaliers: Chris Newell cracked a two-run homer in the first inning and Jake Gelof lifted a three-run homer in the sixth, Wahooing the Loons to the Thursday night victory. The Lugnuts' sole offense came with a three-run rally off a different Cavalier, reliever Brandon Neeck, in the fifth inning. Brayan Buelvas led the offense, reaching base four times with a walk, two singles and a two-run double.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the Loons through Sunday and then return home on Tuesday, May 14th, for a six-game series with the Lake County Captains.

#### Lug•Notes

**A'round the A's System:** 2023 Lugnuts standout **Jacob Wilson**, the 6th overall selection of the draft last season, went 3-for-5 with two doubles in his second Triple-A start, but **Brady Basso** gave up nine runs in 2 1/3 innings in his Las Vegas debut in a 12-7 loss to Round Rock. A level lower, 2024 Lansing Opening Day starter **James González** fanned five batters in 4 1/3 innings and 2024 catcher **Jose Mujica** went 3-for-4 with two doubles in a 9-5 Midland victory over the Dodgers-affiliated Tulsa Drillers. The RockHounds improved to 20-10, the best record in the Texas League.

Streaking: Cam Masterman went 0-for-3 with a walk yesterday, extending his on-base streak to 11 games.

**The Hits Keep Coming:** After opening the season 1-for-23, **Euribiel Angeles** – 2-for-5 last night – has 27 hits in his last 76 at-bats, a .355 average. Euribiel has collected two hits in three of the last four games and has four two-hit games and four three-hit games already this year.

Will the Thrill: 2023 13th-rounder Will Johnston opened the season with the Stockton Ports, dominated the California League, and has continued his pitching mastery two appearances into his tenure with the Lugnuts. Including yesterday's 3 IP, 8-K performance, the former Texas A&M Aggie has fanned 40 batters in 22 innings this season, allowing only nine walks, seven hits and three runs.

Major League Nuts: 2021-22 Lansing Lugnuts infielder Brett Harris notched his first two Major League hits on May 4, his second career MLB game – both home runs in a 20-3 Oakland A's victory over the Miami Marlins. Harris, the 186th Lugnut all-time to reach the Majors, joined Max Schuemann as Lugs to make their MLB debut in 2024; Schuemann also homered for his first big league hit.

Tops on the Team: 1B/3B Will Simpson went 1-for-4 with a walk yesterday; he has now reached base in 26 of 28 games and ranks 9th in the Midwest League in batting average (.326), tied for 1st in triples (3), tied for 2nd in walks (27), 4th in OBP (.472), 9th in slugging (.516), 6th in OPS (.988) and tied for 4th in RBIs (22).

League Leaderboard, Will Excluded: Colby Halter's 24 walks place him 4th in the league; Brayan Buelvas and Henry Bolte are tied for 5th in runs scored (22); Bolte is 4th in steals (12) while Buelvas is tied for 5th (11); Buelvas is also tied for 7th in RBIs (21). Reliever Colton Johnson, meanwhile, leads the league with 11 appearances and is tied for 6th with 3 saves.

**Prospecting:** The Nuts' roster includes three MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 10) and first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 28). In Eric Longenhagen's Top 32 A's prospects for Fangraphs, he gives a nod to Morales at No. 3, Simpson at No. 28 and **Will Johnston** at No. 32. Keith Law placed Morales at No. 7 and Bolte at No. 17, giving a nod to Morales as his sleeper prospect of the organization, writing "Morales is a wild card given his age and lack of experience, yet those also make it easy to dream on the package of stuff and tools, and he offers as much upside as anyone in this system."

**2016:** After Josh Almonte was called out at the plate to end the top of the 7th inning at Bowling Green, Lugnuts manager John Schneider was ejected by home plate umpire Jose Matamoros. Schneider took his time leaving, walking across the field to the clubhouse, located beyond the left-center field wall... and then discovered that the outfield gate was locked. He was locked in. At last, the Bowling Green bullpen in left field allowed Schneider to use their exit, and the game was able to resume. David Rodriguez homered in the bottom of the 9th to force extra innings, and Zacrey Law's RBI single in the bottom of the 11th off Josh DeGraaf lifted the Hot Rods to a 4-3 win.

In a Nutshell: Opened the season as part of a tandem with Opening Day starter James Gonzalez, who debuted in Double-A Midland last night... spent all of 2023 in the Midwest League... making his third appearance on the road today; in the first two, tossed three scoreless innings at Dayton (4/5) and three scoreless innings at Lake County (4/17)... 2.77 ERA as a starter, 3.52 ERA as a reliever... limiting right-handers to .184/.225/.316 w/ 1 BB / 13 K; lefties are hitting .268/.348/.341 w/ 5 BB / 9 K.


**History vs. Great Lakes:** In 2023, went 0-0 with 6.32 ERA in 4 GS: 15 2/3 IP, 21 H, 2 HR, 8 BB, 13 K... in sole start at Dow Diamond, 7/3, allowed one unearned run in 4 IP, K'ing 5... fared rougher at home: 4 R in 3 1/3 on 7/21, 3 R in 4 IP on 8/15, 6 R in 4 1/3 on 8/20... fanned 6 Loons in 3 2/3 IP of relief this year on April 12 in a 9-3 victory.

**Respect:** Mitch posted the No. 3 score in the world in the video game *Super Monkey Ball...* he is also considered the top chess player in the Lugnuts' clubhouse.

**Hometown Hero:** Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

**The Buc Starts Here:** Initially committed to University of Alabama, but coach instability led to Mitch joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).

**Onward to Pitt:** Upon transferring to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five... the last Pitt Panther to appear in a game for the Nuts before Myers was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st pick in the 2016 draft, who made two starts in the Midwest League for Lansing in 2016 and spent 2022 with the Cincinnati Reds.

allowed consecutive singles to open game and a steal of home by Brett Bateman in the 1st inning, but blanked the Cubs' offense over the next four innings... departed with a 1-1 game... Nuts took leads of 4-1 and 6-4 but ultimately fell on a three-run homer by Pedro Ramirez in the 9th off reliever Dylan Hall.

2022 Professional Debut: After signing for \$125,000 as the Athletics' 12th-round selection in 2021, did not appear in a Minor League game until 2022, spent entirely with Stockton... led Ports in starts (22, six more than the closest teammate), innings (124 1/3, 28 1/3 more innings than the closest teammate), and double plays (10)... worked seven innings five times, 6 2/3 innings once, 6 1/3 innings twice, and six innings four times: 12 starts of 22 starts lasting at least six innings... struggled in 12 games, 11 starts, at home (7.11 ERA, .304 avg, 16 HR, in 57 innings) compared to 11 starts on the road (4.14 ERA, .269, 10 HR in 67 1/3 innings)... lefties and righties hit nearly identically: .286/.355/.536 for lefties, .285/.339/.525 for righties, though righties hit 17 of the 26 home runs allowed... struggled mightily in first innings, allowing .353/.402/.627 slash line and six home runs... opposing base stealers swiped 10 bases in 16 attempts.

2023 with the Lugnuts: Opened season as the Nuts' Wednesday starter... tossed first quality start of the year on April 27, allowing two runs (both in the 5th) in six innings vs. Quad Cities April 27... followed up with a second quality start on May 4 vs. Dayton, though he once again received a no-decision... struck on the back of the head by a line drive against Peoria on June 13 and spent two weeks on the Injured List, missing his scheduled start at Wisconsin before returning to action at Great Lakes on July 3... tossed another quality start (6 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 0 BB, 6 K) against Quad Cities on July 27.
