FRES-NOTES

BOOOOOO: The Fresno Grizzlies (12-5) were spooked by the San Jose Giants (7-11) 7-5 Friday night from Chukchansi Park. Fresno took Halfway to Halloween seriously, as not only were they tricked by their ghoulish foes for the second straight game, but the 8,196 fans were treated to bone-chilling weather as if it was late October (18 minute rain delay). The Grizzlies offense supplied 10 hits with Caleb Hobson leading the way (two bunt hits, one RBI, one run, one walk and one stolen base). Brady Hill was a bright spot for Fresno, punching out four in two shutout frames. Bryson Hammer put a spell on batters for three innings, also supplying a quartet of strikeouts.

GIANT AMOUNT OF MATCHUPS: The Fresno Grizzlies and San Jose Giants (San Francisco Giants Single-A affiliate) continue their six-game series tonight at Chukchansi Park. This is the second of six series between the clubs in 2024 and the first of three sets in Fresno. In the first series between the clubs, the Grizzlies enjoyed their first series sweep of the Giants since the California League Playoffs in 2022. Fresno also swept their first series at Excite Ballpark since joining the league in 2021. The Grizzlies are now 52-42 overall in the regular season (2-3 in playoffs) against the Giants since joining the California League.

FROM FRIEND TO FOE: The San Jose Giants have a few names on their coaching staff that the Central Valley may recognize. Giants pitching coach Dan Runzler was selected by the San Francisco Giants in the 9th round of the 2007 MLB Draft. He played for the Grizzlies from 2009-14, appearing in 144 games. Runzler pitched in the majors for parts of five seasons (Giants 2009-12, Pirates 2017) before playing overseas and independent ball. Over 97 big league games, he logged a 4-2 record with a 3.89 ERA over 761 innings. Another staff member fans may remember is Giants hitting coach Travis Ishikawa. The Giants selected Ishikawa in the 21st round of the 2002 MLB Draft out of Federal Way HS in Washington. Ishikawa played eight MLB seasons starting in 2006 and ending in 2015 with time spent in San Francisco (2006, 2008-10, 2014-15), Milwaukee (2012), Baltimore (2013), New York AL (2013) and Pittsburgh (2014-15). Ishikawa wore a Grizzlies uniform in 2008, 2011 and 2014, playing in 175 games. The final coach fans may remember is Giants Manager Yawin Villegas. The always smiling infielder played for the Grizzlies from 2011-14, appearing in 95 games. Villegas batted .208 and had a .962 fielding percentage.

COUPET GETS THE NOD: Tonight, the Grizzlies hand the ball to LHP Isaiah Coupet. Coupet was selected by the Rockies in the 4th round (Pick 109) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Ohio State. The lefty joined Fresno for three games at the tail end of the 2023 season, all in relief. Coupet is known for generating more than 3,000 RPM on both his slider and curve-ball.

JAKE IS DEFINITELY NOT ON THE "SNIDE"R: Grizzlies OF Jake Snider has had an unbelievable month of April, going 16-for-41 (.390 AVG/.634 OBP/.707 SLG/1.341 OPS) with one homer, two triples, six doubles, 12 RBI, 18 runs, 23 walks, six hit-by-pitches and four stolen bases. The Louisville product is ranked first in ALL of professional baseball with a 1.341 OPS and .634 OBP. Snider's triple on April 24th (Wednesday) against San Jose was his 12th in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him one triple shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.

A+ FROM ANDY PEREZ: Grizzlies INF Andy Perez has hit safely in all 17 games to start this season, his longest hit streak while in a Fresno uniform. It is the longest Grizzlies hit streak since Daniel Montano in 2021 (18 games, June 15-July 9) and longest current active streak in Minor League Baseball. Perez is 25-for-72 (.347 AVG/.390 OBP/.597 SLG/.987 OPS) with three homers (one grand slam), three triples, three doubles, 18 RBI, 12 runs, five walks and one stolen base. Perez's triple on April 24th (Wednesday) against San Jose was his 10th in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him three triples shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.

WIMMER IS A WINNER: Grizzlies INF Braylen Wimmer has also had a spectacular April, going 15-for-47 (.319 AVG/.439 OBP/.596 SLG/1.035 OPS) with four homers, one double, 10 RBI, 18 runs, nine walks and two stolen bases.

EJ AND THE SB: Dating back to last season, Grizzlies' OF EJ Andrews Jr. has stolen 14 bases (three this year), one in 14 different games. Fresno is 14-0 when Andrews Jr. swipes a base, with 12 of the 14 games ending within five runs.

2023 (pro): Pitched in just 5 games after being selected by the Rockies in the 4th round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Ohio State...Was ranked as the Rockies #25 overall prospect on MLB.com after the draft...Became the 115th Buckeye to be drafted since 1966 and highest drafted since Dillon Dingler (2020)...6th player to be selected by Colorado and joins Ryan Feltner in the system...Over 2 relief appearances with the ACL Rockies, tossed 2 scoreless innings, issuing 1 walk while fanning 3...Assigned to Fresno on September 5...Struck out a batter and induced a double play in Fresno debut September 5 vs. Modesto...Fanned lone batter he faced September 6 vs. Modesto...Came in with 2 runners on and no outs in a tied game, left both runners stranded September 8 vs. Modesto.

2021-23 (college): Pitched at Ohio State for 3 seasons...Appeared in 33 games (24 starts), going 9-11 with 1 save, a 4.61 ERA and a 1.28 WHIP...In 132.2 frames, allowed 87 runs (68 earned), on 107 hits, 63 walks, while punching out 199 batters...In 2023, was a part of the Buckeyes' starting rotation, making 11 appearances (10 starts)...Compiled a 4-3 record, with a 1.13 WHIP and a team-best 3.55 ERA...Struck out 72 batters in 50.2 innings pitched...Opponents batted .218 against him...On March 17 vs. Dayton, fanned a season-best 11 batters...In 2022, recorded a career-high 98 strikeouts in 64.2 innings pitched...Made 13 starts, going 5-5 with a 5.71 ERA...Opponents batted .197 against him...In 2021, appeared in 9 games, including his 1st career start...Went 0-3 with 1 save and a 3.63 ERA...Fanned 29 batters in just 17.1 innings.
