STARTING NINE- NEWS AND NOTES

- ♦ **Last Time Out:** Down to their final out, the Lake County Captains scored three runs on a double and a throwing error to walk away with a 4-3 win Friday. **Max Rajcic** punched out seven and allowed just one run over five innings of work. **Nathanael Heredia** faced the minimum over 2 1/3 innings. **Chris Rotondo** reached three times and drove in a run to lead the offense.
- ♦ **Rolling Along:** Peoria's pitching staff has carried the load in the month of August. Entering play on Saturday, the Chiefs own a 2.27 ERA in August, the lowest among full-season MiLB clubs. Peoria has posted four shutouts this month. Last week, the Chiefs turned in 25 consecutive scoreless frames against Beloit. Earlier this month, Peoria turned in 30-straight scoreless innings against Quad Cities.
- ♦ **Stuck in Neutral:** Though the Chiefs are 10-5 in August, the offense has been stuck in neutral. Since August 1, the Chiefs have scored 55 runs, second fewest in the Midwest League ahead only of this week's opponent Lake County. Additionally, the Chiefs are hitting just .218 over the course of the month.
- ♦ **RISP-y Business:** For the most part, the Chiefs have been quite reliable with runners in scoring position in 2023. As of late, however, the Peoria bats have struggled to deliver the timely hit. Over their last nine games, the Chiefs are 12-for-84 (.143) with RISP. The Chiefs were 0-for-9 in Friday's tough luck loss.
- ♦ **The Stopper:** Trent Baker will take the ball for game one as the Chiefs look to snap a mini three-game skid. Baker is solid candidate to get Peoria back on track. The right-hander has not allowed a run over 15 1/3 innings this month. Among qualified starters, Baker ranks in the top 10 in the Midwest League in ERA (3rd), wins (T6th), strikeouts (10th), innings pitched (2nd), opponent's batting average (4th) and WHIP (1st).
- ♦ **I've Got Your Back:** Ian Bedell is the scheduled starter for Saturday's nightcap. Bedell, like Baker, has also not surrendered a run in the month of August. The right-hander has been a model of consistency for Peoria but has been especially good against teams from the East Division. In a unique quirk, Bedell has allowed just two runs over 16 2/3 innings against teams from the east.
- ♦ **Church of Nathan:** Nathan Church continues to pace the Midwest League and all of High-A in hits (117). Church is in some rare air among recent Chiefs. His 117 knocks are the most in a single season since 2019 when former first-round pick Delvin Perez racked up 123 hits for Peoria. If Church continues on his 2023 pace, he'll accumulate the most hits in a single season since Magneuris Sierra's 161 back in 2016.
- ♦ **Roadtrip Update:** Peoria still has a chance at a winning road trip if they can win out this weekend. The Chiefs were 8-4 over the course of their first 12-game roadie back in June.
- ♦ **Cardinals History:** Coach Christina Whitlock is blazing a trail in the game of baseball. Whitlock is the first uniformed female coach in the history of the Cardinals organization. Whitlock coached softball for more than two decades and suited up for the U.S. Women's National Team as a player.
