☞ This season, Wood is 4-for-10 with the bases loaded, including 3 grand slams, 2 walks and 19 RBI.

BRING ON THE PAYNE TRAIN!

OF BRAYLON PAYNE was promoted from High-A Wisconsin on Friday and went 1-for-3 with 2 walks and 2 stolen bases in his debut on Saturday... Payne enters today as the Brewers No. 5 prospect per *Baseball America*... Payne ended his time in the Midwest League among the league leaders in home runs (T-1st, 23), OPS (3rd, .930), extra-base hits (6th, 40) and average (10th, .277)... Payne's 23 home runs set the Timber Rattlers new single-season record.

☞ Payne recorded the 6th 20/20 season in the Midwest League since 1988 and the 6th by a teenager in MiLB since 2005.

LOOKING AT THE WATCH

On Thursday, the Shuckers and Blue Wahoos completed their 10-inning game in 3 hours and 36 minutes, the 2nd-longest game of the season... The teams combined for 21 runs, 26 hits and 5 home runs, including 12 runs and 12 hits across the final 2 innings.

☞ Saturday's game (2 hours, 30 minutes) marked the fastest 9-inning home game for the Shuckers since June 7 against Montgomery (2 hours, 23 minutes).

GONE FISCH-ING

3B ANDREW FISCHER recorded his 36th home run of the season on Thursday, moving into a tied for 3rd place for the most home runs by a Brewers Minor League player in franchise history (since 1970)... His 36 home runs mark the most by a Brewers Minor League hitter since 1985.

☞ Fischer needs 4 more home runs to become the 2nd Brewers Minor League player with a 40 home run season... He would become the first since **CF GORMAN THOMAS** (51) in 1974.
