NOTES AND AUGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

The 2026 season has been a roller coaster ride for Omaha but things are trending up, with the Chasers coming off series wins over Toledo and St. Paul.

- After an 0-4 start to the year, the Chasers went 12-5 between April 1 and 21, then went 3-11 from April 22 to May 8 ... Omaha has won 10 of the last 15, since May 9.
- Omaha had a winning April, with a 13-12 record on the month ... last year, the Chasers had just one winning month, going 15-11 in August ... with a 12-10 record in May, the Storm Chasers need to win 2 of their final 5 this month for a winning record in back-to-back months for the first time since July and August 2024.
- A win today would put Omaha's winning percentage back at .500 ... prior to Sunday's win, the Chasers had been under .500 for 29 days, from April 24 to May 23 ... Omaha has spent 18 days at or above .500, 15 of which came consecutively in a 13-game stretch from April 10 to 24.

SERIES SPEAKING

- Last week's series win was Omaha's 2nd straight and the club's 5th of 9 series this year.
- The Chasers have won 5 of their 8 week-long series this season - taking series against Buffalo (4-2), Iowa (3-2), Indianapolis (4-2), Toledo (4-2) and St. Paul (4-2).
- In 4 of this season's 5 series wins, Omaha won the series opener ... in 3 of the series wins - against Buffalo, Toledo and St. Paul - the clubs split the first four games before the Storm Chasers took both remaining contests to claim the series.

COMEBACK KIDS

The Storm Chasers have trailed at some point in each of their last 8 wins, with Sunday's 5-3 victory representing Omaha's 15th overall comeback win this year.

- Over Omaha's last 8 wins (since May 13), the Storm Chasers have trailed for a total of 16 1/2 innings, 6.5 of those innings coming in 4 wins last week in St. Paul.
- Omaha's 15 comeback wins rank tied for the 2nd-most in the International League and tied 4th at the Triple-A level ... the Chasers' 99 comeback wins since 2024 rank 2nd-most in the International League and 3rd-most at the Triple-A level.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN

Stealing bases has been one of the strongest areas for the Storm Chasers this season, led by a quartet of baserunning threats.

- Omaha's 84.1% success rate (58-for-69) ranks 3rd in the IL and 5th in Triple-A.
- John Rave leads Omaha in steals (13) ... Gavin Cross has 11 steals in as many tries, tied for the 2nd-most steals in the IL without being caught ... Kameron Misner has swiped 9 bags, while Tyler Tolbert has 8 steals.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE

A constant in 2026 has been Omaha's ability to go deep in plate appearances.

- The Storm Chasers are seeing 3,993 pitches per plate appearance, 4th-most in the International League and 7th at the Triple-A level.
- Among 182 Triple-A players with 150+ plate appearances this year, Kameron Misner is 3rd in pitches seen/PA (4,440) while John Rave ranks 9th (4,354).

DON'T BRETT, SQUIRES IS HERE!

Chasers first baseman Brett Squires has been on fire across his first two weeks at the Triple-A level, since earning a promotion to Omaha on May 12.

- After a 1-for-15 start in his first 4 Triple-A games, Squires is 15-for-34 (.441) over his last 9 games with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 6 home runs and 14 RBI.
- Combining his Double-A and Triple-A games, Squires is hitting .304 (51-for-168) with 15 doubles, 1 triple, 13 home runs, 45 RBI and a 1.019 OPS ... he ranks tied 2nd among all Minor Leaguers in extra-base hits (29) and tied 6th in the Minors in RBI.
- His 11 extra-base hits since May 16 are the most of any player in baseball (Majors & Minors), while 31 total bases in that stretch the most in the Minors and 2nd-most in baseball ... his 1.633 OPS since May 16 is the best in baseball (min. 30 PA), just ahead of Jack Winnay (1.545, PEO) and Ketel Marte (1.505, AZ).

MAYS-TERCLASS

With one week remaining in the month of May, the Storm Chasers have one of the league's best hitters this month and a trio of strong bullpen arms.

- Luca Tresh has been one of the International League's best hitters in May, hitting .400 (22-for-55) with 7 extra-base hits and 13 RBI in 15 games, for a 1.031 OPS ... 18 hits in games he's caught this month are 3rd-most among MiLB catchers.
- Eric Cerantola, Jose Caus and Ethan Bosacker have all been especially effective out of Omaha's bullpen this month ... Cerantola has pitched to a 1.42 ERA (1 ER in 6.1 IP) while Caus has a 2.07 ERA (2 ER in 8.2 IP) in 9 games this month and Bosacker worked a 2.70 ERA (4 ER in 13.1 IP) over 5 May appearances.

CAREER REVIEW

- Benjamin Henry Sears is entering his fifth year with the Kansas City Royals organization after being drafted in 2022 out of Houston ... he reached Triple-A for the first time in June 2025 but has not yet made his Major League debut.
- Has exclusively pitched out of the bullpen in his professional career, with all 129 career Minor League appearances coming in relief ... 79 of 129 (61%) have lasted longer than 1.0 inning, while 60 of his outings (47%) have been 2.0 innings or more.
- Across the last three seasons (2023-25), his 121 appearances rank 4th among Royals Minor League pitchers ... among 31 arms in the system that have thrown at least 150.0 innings over the last three years, Sears' 2.44 BB/9 ranks 3rd, a 3.26 K/BB is 4th and his 3.92 ERA ranks 9th.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- Spent much of the season with Northwest Arkansas (AA), but also had a stint with Omaha from June 28 to August 4 ... between the two levels, went 3-3 with 5 saves and a 4.33 ERA (30 ER in 62.1 IP).
- 16 of 32 appearances with the Naturals in Double-A were scoreless, with a career-high 11.2-inning scoreless streak from April 19 to May 16 that spanned parts of 7 outings.
- Earned 5 saves with NWA, including 3 in a 6-outing span from August 14 to 29 ... pitched to a 2.63 ERA (4 ER in 13.2 IP) with 11 strikeouts in August.
- 4 of his 9 outings with the Storm Chasers were scoreless ... did not allow an earned run in his 3 longest Triple-A appearances, all longer than 2.0 innings, including 3.0 scoreless innings of relief on August 1 vs. Louisville (CIN).

- Earned a save in 4 consecutive appearances, between May 17 and 26 ... also successfully converted a save in his final 5 save opportunities, between July 4 and August 8.
- Did not allow a home run in a season-high 45.1-inning stretch from April 16 to July 19, making 21 appearances without allowing a home run.

2022

- Assigned to the Arizona Complex League after being drafted by Kansas City and made 1 appearance for the ACL Royals (R) before finishing the year with Columbia (A) ... combined to work a 2.87 ERA (5 ER in 15.2 IP) across 8 games, with 6 scoreless appearances.
