Last Game Recap...Riley Maddox threw five scoreless innings and Wilmington topped the BlueClaws 5-1 on Saturday night at Frawley Stadium...Wilmington scored three times in 3.1 innings off Jersey Shore starter Ryan Dromboski...Sunday's game was rained out and the teams will play a double-header on May 20th.

BlueClaws in Home Openers...The BlueClaws are 8-16 all-time in home openers, including 3-2 as a High-A affiliate (since 2001)...The BlueClaws lost nine of their first 10 home openers and are 7-6 since then...They have never won three home openers in a row, but can with a win today after wins in 2024 (3-2 over Aberdeen) and 2025 (8-3 vs Aberdeen).

The Claws and the Clones...The BlueClaws welcome in Brooklyn for a six game series to start the season...Jersey Shore went 15-14 against the eventual league champion Cyclones last year...They met in the final series of the regular season in Lakewood – the BlueClaws won the first four games, and after the fifth was cancelled, Brooklyn won the last game 5-2 scoring four times in the ninth.

25th Anniversaries...Both the BlueClaws and Cyclones are celebrating their 25th Anniversaries in 2026...Both teams have been in the High-A South Atlantic League since 2021, with the BlueClaws in the Low-A South Atlantic League from 2001-2020 and the Cyclones in the short-season NY-Penn League from 2001-2020...Both teams have won three titles, the BlueClaws in 2006, 2009, and 2010, and Brooklyn in 2001, 2019, and 2025.

An Opener to Remember...The 19 runs scored by Jersey Shore on Friday bested the previous club record of 18 set in 2024 at GBO and 2011 at ASH...It also marked the most runs scored by an MiLB team (full season league) in their season opener since at least 2005...Trent Farquhar's five runs scored matched the team record previously set by Alan Schoenberger on 8/9/2010 at WV...Additionally, the 3 hour and 50 minute game was the longest 9-inning BlueClaws game in the pitch clock era (since 2022).

Two for Tello...Raider Tello is the only BlueClaw with at least two hits in each of the first two games of the season...He smashed the first BlueClaws home run of the season, a three-run shot on Friday in Wilmington...Tello hit eight home runs with Clearwater last year and seven at Iowa in 2024...His five RBIs on Friday were a career-high (had a high of three last year)...His five RBIs in the opener matched the most by a BlueClaw last year (5x).

Hot Starts...Seven of the nine BlueClaws hitters had at least two hits on Friday night, including three each by Devin Saltiban, Nick Biddison, and Trent Farquhar...Brady Day, Raider Tello, Joel Drago, and Jose Colmenares each had two hits.

Salti-pop...Devin Saltiban had three hits in the season opener on Friday (he had four three-hit games with the BlueClaws in 2025) returns to ShoreTown Ballpark where he spent the 2025 season...The #21 prospect in the system was a 3rd round pick of the Phillies from Hilo High School in Hawaii in the 2023 draft...The youngest player on the BlueClaws Opening Day roster in 2025, Saltiban is also the youngest player on the Opening Day roster in 2026, having just turned 21 on Valentine's Day...He hit .190 with five home runs and 19 steals with the BlueClaws last year, but hit 17 home runs with Clearwater in 2024.

Hoosier Fever...OF Carter Mathison was a 5th round pick of the Phillies in 2024 out of the University of Indiana...He hit 42 career home runs at Indiana including 19 as a freshman...Mathison is of three Hoosiers with 40+ home runs in first three collegiate seasons (Kyle Schwarber and Alex Dickerson)...Former IU BlueClaws include 2013-14 LHP Joey DeNato and 2012-13 manager Mickey Morandini.

Familiar Faces...Of the 30 players on the BlueClaws Break Camp Roster, 22 are returning to the BlueClaws and only eight are making their BlueClaws debuts...By comparison, last year, 13 players on the Break Camp roster made their BlueClaws debuts...The new faces: LHP Juan Amarante, RHP Ryan Degges, RHP Adilson Peralta, RHP Danyony Pulido, RHP Giuseppe Velasquez, IF Brady Day, IF Raider Tello, and OF Carter Mathison.

Let's Start Quick...The BlueClaws are looking for their first April winning record since becoming a High-A affiliate...They were 6-14 in 2022, 8-9 in 2023, 9-13 in 2024, and 8-14 in 2025...In 2021, the first year the BlueClaws were a High-A affiliate, the season started on May 4th and the BlueClaws went 9-18 in May.

Power Index...Devin Saltiban (17 in 2024 with Clearwater) and Brock Vradenburg (10 in 2024 between Jupiter and Beloit in the Marlins system) are the only two BlueClaws with a 10 home run season...Last year, the BlueClaws did not have a player hit 10 home runs, the second time in franchise history the BlueClaws did not have a player reach double-digits (Jordan Dissin in 2024 and Zach Arnold in 2025 led the team with nine).

Mr. 900...The BlueClaws entered the season having used 894 different players in their club history, and technically, RHP Danyony Pulido, who threw a scoreless eighth inning on Saturday, was the sixth player to appear in a game this year that had not yet done so before the season, making him the 900th player to play in a game for the BlueClaws.

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws had three walk-off wins last year – a 9/4 win over Brooklyn when Dante Nori scored on a 10th inning wild pitch, an 8/7 win over Hub City on a 9th inning single from Avery Owusu-Asiedu and a 5/6 win over Aberdeen on a home run by Kehden Hettiger...The BlueClaws had three walk-off wins in 2024 – July 23rd vs Abedeen (Keaton Anthony RBI single), plus July 9th against Hudson Valley (Emaarion Boyd 2-run single) and April 5th against Aberdeen (Opening Night, Boyd scores on wild pitch)...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3rd, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen.

The Big Five...The BlueClaws have two pitchers from Big Five schools in Philadelphia...RHP Luke Gabrysh went to St. Joseph's and RHP Ryan Dromboski went to the Univeristy of Pennsylvania.

College Teammates...The BlueClaws have two pairs of college teammates in IF Trent Farquhar and 1B Brock Vradenburg, who played together at Michigan State, and C Kodey Shojinaga and RHP Reese Dutton, who played together at Kansas.

Just Grand...Bryan Rincon's grand slam on May 20, 2025 vs Brooklyn was the BlueClaws first since Jordan Dissin's on June 11, 2024 at Greensboro...The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they hit three grand slams in two weeks in 2024 – one by Justin Crawford (May 30th), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9th), and one by Jordan Dissin (June 11th)...These were the only three grand slams hit by the BlueClaws in 2024.

From The Shore to the Show...130 players have now gone *From the Shore, to the Show* including two to debut Opening Week with the Phillies...Justin Crawford (2023-24 BlueClaw) made his debut in the March 26th season opener while Andrew Painter (2022 BlueClaw) debuted on March 31st in the fifth game of the season...RHP George Klassen (2024 BlueClaw) debuted on April 6th with the Angels...Two former BlueClaws made debuts in 2025 – RHP Mick Abel (2022 BlueClaw) and UT Otto Kemp (2023-24 BlueClaw).

Mycal Jones Takes Over...Mycal Jones, in his seventh year in the organization, takes over for Greg Brodzinski as the new BlueClaws manager and is the 18th manager in BlueClaws history...Jones was a coach with Reading last year and with Clearwater the two years prior...He played in the Braves system and was originally a fourth round pick in 2009.

On the Staff...Ryan Buchter returns the BlueClaws as the pitching coach...Buchter went to Highland Regional High School in Blackwood, New Jersey...Darnell Sweeney, with the FCL Phillies last year, is the hitting coach...Ryan Wroblewski makes his coaching debut after playing four years in the Astros organization, serving as the position coach and assistant hitting coach...Orlando Munoz returns to the BlueClaws position coach...Marissa VanHassel is the Athletic Trainer while John Sweeney is the Strength & Conditioning Coach.

Season Notes: On Opening Day Roster.

Career Notes: Began last year with Clearwater, where he went 3-7, 4.80 over 18 appearances...Joined the BlueClaws in August and made six starts, going 2-1, 3.77 (17 K/9 BB in 31 IP)...Threw six no-hit innings on 9/4 vs BRK in his final start and was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week...Made pro debut with Clearwater in 2024, allowing five earned runs in seven innings over three appearances, with five walks and 10 strikeouts...Spent five years at NC State, earning Third-Team All-ACC as a senior in 2024...Pitched 7.1 scoreless innings, allowing just two hits, while besting Jack Leiter and Vanderbilt in the 2021 College World Series, then went 3-4 against Vandy in the next game while playing first base...Dad (Tyler), Mom (Paige) and Grandfather (Joel Gibson) all attended NC State, while Gibson pitched for both the White Sox and Phillies...Nickname: "The Mayor"

Going Deep – Since the BlueClaws became a High-A affiliate in 2021, they have had 22 starts in which their starting pitcher threw at least seven innings.
