JACKSONVILLE BEATS DURHAM, WINS SERIES

José Devers and Otto López each notched three hits on Sunday as Jacksonville bested Durham 4-2 to win the sixgame series. The Jumbo Shrimp jumped out to the lead with three runs in the second. **Tristan Gray** scored on a passed ball, Devers collected an RBI double and López registered an RBI ground out for the game's first three runs. The Bulls scored twice in the fifth, but could get no closer. Devers tripled to begin the seventh and López plated him with an RBI single to make it 4-2. Jacksonville's bullpen worked 5.0 scoreless innings in the effort.

GRAY'S ANATOMY

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Tristan Gray**, who played 331 games with the Durham Bulls from 2021-23, has been on a tear since returning to the Bull City. The Missouri City, Texas native homered in five consecutive games from April 2-6, the longest such streak for a Jacksonville hitter since Peter O'Brien went vard in six straight games from June 6-11. 2018. Against Durham, Gray went a combined 8-for-24 (.333) with a double, five home runs, eight RBIs, two walks and seven runs scored. During his career with the Bulls, Gray batted .233/.300/.474/.774 with 59 doubles, five triples, 71 home runs, 220 RBIs and 179 runs scored.

THE CHICKS DIG IT

It took into the club's second series of the year to hit their first home run, but Jacksonville launched eight bombs through six games in Durham. In 2023, the Jumbo Shrimp finished in the bottom of the IL in home runs (T-15, 160). Historically, Jacksonville has clobbered more home runs on the road since rejoining Triple-A prior to the 2021 campaign (82 vs 78 in '23, 109 vs 74 in '22 and 81 vs 55 in '21).

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Outside of a 10-0 loss to Gwinnett on March 31 and a 6-2 defeat to Durham on Saturday, all seven of Jacksonville's contests in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp have gone 5-2 in those affairs thus far. Last season, 85 of the club's 149 games (57.0 percent) were determined by no more than three runs, with the club going 39-46 (.459) in those contests. Prior to that, Jacksonville had been over .500 in games decided by three runs or fewer in every season from 2019-22.

SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through nine games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered only 34 runs, in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. Thus far during the 2024 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are a woeful 15-for-81 (.185/.316/.333/.649, ranking 29th, 28th, 25th and 27th, respectively, in Triple-A) hitting with runners in scoring position, stranding a total of 65 runners. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just .247/.336/.400/.736 with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th, 27th and 29th in Triple-A.

TROY MEETS WORLD

Jumbo Shrimp first baseman **Troy Johnston** is coming off an extraordinary season that saw him earn Marlins Minor League Player of the Year. Johnston finished the season leading all of Minor League Baseball in RBIs (116) while ranking fourth in extra-base hits (67), ninth in hits (157), tied for 10th in runs (102), 13th in OPS (.948), tied for 15th in doubles (36) and 17th in slugging percentage (.549). Over 134 games between Jacksonville and Double-Pensacola, Johnston slashed .307/.399/.549/.948 with 26 home runs and 24 stolen bases, becoming the first Marlins minor leaguer since 2008 to post a season with at least 20 homers and 20 steals.

BACK TO WINNING PLEASE?

Thanks to a 75-55 (.577) record in 2021 and an 80-69 (.537). mark in 2022, Jacksonville collected back-to-back winning seasons for the first time since 2013-14. In 2023, though, the Jumbo Shrimp finished just 70-79 (.470) to snap their run of winning records. Jacksonville finished the first half of the season with the International League's worst record at 32-42 (negative-51 run differential) before rebounding with a 38-37 (.507) in the season's second half (negative-23 run

ABOUT PATRICK

-Monteverde is the youngest child from a massive family. He is the youngest of 27 grandchildren on his dad's side and the youngest of 18 grandchildren on his mom's side. Both of Monteverde's parents are the youngest of twelve.

-A native of Pittsburgh, Monteverde started his collegiate baseball career at Divison II Virginia Wesleyan (Norfolk, Va.) for a season, posting a 1.96 ERA in 82 2/3 innings. In 2018, he moved up a rung, transferring to Division II Seton Hill in Greensburg, Pennsylvania, about 45 minutes from Monteverde's home. He had a solid first year there in 2018 (3.04 ERA), but three starts into his second season with the Griffins, he heard a pop in his elbow and underwent Tommy John surgery. Monteverde made just one more start for Seton Hill in 2020 before the COVID pandemic then shut down the season for him.

-Monteverde completed his collegiate career by transferring to Texas Tech University for the 2021 season. He went 7-4 with a 3.75 ERA, leading the Red Raiders in wins, starts (16), innings pitched (86.1) and strikeouts (101).

-Monteverde was promoted to Jacksonville on July 25 from Double-A Pensacola. At the time of his promotion, he led the Southern League in wins (8), ERA (2.44) and WHIP (1.11) while ranking second in both innings pitched (84.2) and batting average against (.207), tied for eighth in strikeouts (90) and tied for 14th in games started (14).

-Made 21 total starts with Pensacola in 2022. Led team in wins (10), innings pitched (114.0), strikeouts (114), double plays (T-1st, 11).

-Led qualified pitchers in ERA (3.32),

-Among the 119 Southern League pitchers with at least 30 IP, Monteverde ranked 40th in stranded runners (71.3%).

2022 SEASON

-Monteverde was promoted to Double-A Pensacola on August 2 from High-A Beloit.

-Over his final 13 starts in High-A, Monteverde went 3-4 with a 2.30 ERA. He pitched 70.1 innings, yielding only 54 hits (.211 batting average against) and striking out 75 against 21 walks.

2021 SEASON

-Six of his seven outings were in a relief role. Prior to that, he had not pitched in relief since 2017, his freshman year at Virginia Wesleyan. Even during that 2017 campaign, 11 of his 15 appearances were starts.
