### Today's Game

The Fightin Phils remain home and finish a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators on Sunday night. It is the sixth-of-12 matchups between the teams this season and final-of-six games in Reading. The Fightin Phils went 7-5 against Harrisburg in 2024, including a 4-2 record at home and 3-3 record on the road. Following this week, the Fightin Phils head to Harrisburg from June 3-8. Harrisburg leads the season-series 4-1.

### Game 24 Recap

Harrisburg clinched the series with a rain-shortened six-inning 9-1 win over Reading on Saturday night. Gabe Mosser started and allowed seven runs (five earned) on 10 hits over five innings of work, while striking out six batters. Reading scored their lone run in the bottom of the first inning when Keaton Anthony and Felix Reyes recorded back-to-back doubles. Cole Roberts had the other Reading hit and also drew a walk in the loss.

### Back in the Win Column

With their win on Thursday night, the Fightin Phils snapped their 10-game losing streak. It was the Fightin Phils longest losing streak since losing eight in a row from July 22-30, of the 2022 season. It was Reading's first 10+ game losing streak since dropping 12 in a row from June 17 to 29, of 2014.

### Miller Gets on Base

After going 0-2 on Saturday night, Aidan Miller's season-best 16-game on-base streak was snapped at 16 games. Over the on-base streakm Miller had a .352 on-base percentage, recorded 14 hits and walked 10 times. It was the longest active on-base streak in the Eastern League entering play on Friday night and ranks as the longest on-base streak for any R-Phil this season.

### Awesome Anthony

Entering play on Sunday, Keaton Anthony has a team-best 10-game hitting streak (since 4/18) and 15-game on-base steak (4/12). Over his 10-game hitting streak, Anthony is slashing .324/.400/.471 (.871 OPS), with three doubles, one triple and four RBI. Anthony's 10-game hitting streak is the second-longest active hitting streak in the Eastern League and his 15-game on-base streak is tied for the longest on-base streak in the Eastern League, with Kyle Karros of Hartford. Additionally, after his double on Saturday night, Anthony is now tied for second in the Eastern League in doubles with eight.

### Where is Moore Playing?

Robert Moore made his professional debut in center field on Saturday night. In the game, Moore recorded two putouts at the new position. According to Moore, it is the first time he has ever played outfield in his life.

### Rolling Reyes

Felix Reyes has now been with Reading for 10 games this season and is slashing .300/.333/.533 (.866 OPS), with four runs, four doubles, one home run and four RBI. So far this week, Reyes is slashing .444/.455/.667 (1.122 OPS), with two runs, two doubles and three RBI. He has additionally only struck out one time.

### Hitters Park

FirstEnergy Stadium is known as a hitters park and the Fightin Phils have the numbers to back that up. Over 14 home games this season, Reading has hit 13 home runs, which is tied for second in the Eastern League for home home runs. When on the road, the Fightin Phils have hit just two home runs across 10 games, which is the least amount of road home runs in the league.

### On Deck

Following this week, the Fightin Phils head back on the road to Binghamton to take on the Rumble Ponies. Reading faced Binghamton from Apr. 15-20 and after winning the first two games of the series, the Fightin Phils dropped the series to the Rumble Ponies 4-2. This week, Binghamton is in Erie, and entering a doubleheader today, the team's have split the first four games of the series in Northwestern Pennsylvania.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

**May 4, 2021:** After a 607-day hiatus without baseball at FirstEnergy Stadium due to the Coronavirus pandemic, the R-Phils returned home in front of 2,620 fans. Despite the Opening Day loss, the offense gave the fans plenty to cheer for, as Arquimedes Gamboa, Luke Miller and Dalton Guthrie all went deep.

### Coming from the Capital

Harrisburg enters tonight with a 13-13 record, sitting tied for third place in the Eastern League Southwest Division. In 2024, the Senators finished with a 68-70 record, which was the third best record in the Southwest Division, and didn't qualify for the playoffs. Harrisburg's roster features seven of the Nationals' top-30 prospects: Jarlin Susana (2), Cade Cavalli (7), Daylen Lile (9), Cayden Wallace (10), Yohandy Morales (12), Marquis Grissom Jr. (23) and Kevin Made (27).

### Throwing for the Senators

Righty, and Nationals' No. 2 prospect, Jarlin Susana makes the start tonight for Harrisburg. So far this season, Susana is 0-1, with a 3.91 ERA over five starts (23.0 IP, 19 H, 17 BB, 35 SO). Susana last pitched on Tuesday at Reading and struck out nine, while walking six, over 4.1 innings pitched with three runs and four hits allowed. Susana split 2024 between Frerdictsburg (A) and Wilmington (A+), combining to go 4-10, with a 4.34 ERA over 24 starts. He struck out 157 batters over 103.2 IP, good for a 13.63 SO/9.0 IP ratio. The 21-year old signed with the San Diego Padres as an international free agent in 2022 out of the Dominican Republic. He was traded to Washington in 2022 as a part of the deal that sent Juan Soto to the Padres.
