ROUGHRIDERS WIN FOURTH STRAIGHT BEHIND BRADFORD, OFFENSE:

ROUGHRIDERS WIN FOURTH STRAIGHT BEHIND BRADFORD, OFFENSE:
The Frisco RoughRiders took down the San Antonio Missions 7-3 to capture their fourth-straight win on Friday night from Nelson
Wolff Stadium. The Riders waited until the fourth inning to jump on the board first when **Blaine Crim** doubled home a pair of runs to
make it 2-0. Frisco has now scored first in each of its seven games this season. In the fifth, the RoughRiders put up three more tallies
to take a 5-0 lead. **Kellen Strahm** started the scoring with a sacrifice fly before Crim and **Dustin Harris** added RBI singles. The Missions answered back in the bottom of the sixth with a three-run home run from Brandon Dixon, but it was not enough. Frisco added on a run in the eighth on a **David Garcia** RBI single and another one on Harris's second RBI single of the night in the ninth to make it 7-3. **Cody Bradford** (1-0) earned the win, allowing just two runs over his five innings (which both came across as stranded runners after he left the game) while also striking out five. Matt Waldron (0-1) took the loss, ceding five runs in his 4.2 frames.

KEEP YOU FRIENDS CLOSE AND YOUR ENEMIES CLOSER:

Through seven games, the RoughRiders have won five of their six contests by three runs or fewer. So, through those five close wins the Riders have collected five saves, tying them with the Triple-A Nashville Sounds and Las Vegas Aviators (who have both played 10 games) for the most in all of Minor League Baseball. Though Frisco is 6-1, their run differential is just +12, which is still good for best in the Texas League and third best in Double-A.

YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT:

YOU GET A HIT; YOU GET A HIT:

Over the last five games, the RoughRiders have banged out at least 10 hits in four contests. Their 49 hits in the last five games are more than 26 teams in MiLB have all season. Overall, Frisco is hitting .274/.346/.392 to start the season, a batting average good for second in the Texas League and 12th in Minor League Baseball. The Riders are also averaging 6.3 runs per game (third in the Texas League) while only hitting three home runs this season. Only the Northwest Arkansas Naturals (one) have fewer home runs in the Texas League this season, while the Springfield Cardinals lead the way with 10.

REARVIEW MIRRORS:

Since the 2019 season ended and the standings reset on September 3rd, 2019, the RoughRiders have not been in second place for 956 days. From the season-opening game in 2021, the RoughRiders held first place the entire season and have now been in first place for every game in 2022 as well.

THE COMEBACK KIDS:

After returning from down 3-2 in the eighth inning on Thursday against San Antonio, the RoughRiders have now had three come-from-behind wins this season in six games. On Opening Day, it was **Ezequiel Duran** with an RBI double as the go-ahead hit in the eighth, while **Jonathan Ornelas** played hero on Tuesday with an RBI single. On Thursday, the tying run scored on an error before Jordan Procyshen smashed a three-run home run. When trailing after the seventh inning, Frisco is 3-1.

OUT OF THE GATES:

After starting the year 6-1, the RoughRiders have had their best start to the season since 2016 when the Riders began the year 9-1. In 2021, the RoughRiders began the season 3-0 and raced to a 14-6 record through their first 20 games. The 2016 squad started 17-4 through 21 games and 23-7 through 30 games. After that, they struggled, going 40-69 the rest of the way, finishing the season in third place in the Texas League South.

WELCOME TO THE LEIT SHOW:

Rangers No.1 prospect, RHP **Jack Leiter** was as-advertised on Saturday in his first start of his professional career. Over his three innings, Leiter whiffed seven while allowing just one run on one hit with two walks. The second-overall pick out of Vanderbilt in the 2021 draft, Leiter was a unanimous First-Team All-American in his final season with the Commodores while tying the NCAA lead in strikeouts on the year. The son of two-time All-Star and two-time World Series champ Al Leiter, Jack is ranked as the No. 17 prospect in baseball by MLB.com.

The RoughRiders dominated the Missions in 2021, going 13-5 against them in 18 games. To open their road slate last year, Frisco went 5-1 against San Antonio at Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Stadium and then swept them in a six-game series at home in June. The Riders owned a .711 OPS with 14 home runs against the Missions, but where they really dominated was on the mound. Frisco had a 3.58 ERA versus the Missions 4.70 ERA over the 18 games. Including 2022, the RoughRiders are 17-5 against the Missions and dating back to mid-June of 2018, Frisco is 29-13 against the Missions in their last 42 games head-to-head.

LOOK AT ALL THAT TALENT:

While Leiter headlines the top 30 prospects talent on the squad, the Riders back up him with plenty of players to watch. INF **Ezequiel Duran** slots in as the No. 4 prospect in the organization after the Rangers acquired him from the Yankees as part of the **Joey Gallo** deal at the 2021 deadline. OF **Dustin Harris** is the No. 6 prospect after his incredible 20-20 campaign a year ago. Another trade piece, Harris came to the Rangers when they dealt **Mike Minor** to the A's in 2020. A pair of returners from 2021's team round out the prospects in LHP **Cody Bradford** and RHP **Zak Kent**. Bradford, a former Baylor Bear from Aledo, Texas, led all Rangers farmhands in strikeouts last season while Kent finished third in the organization in strikeout rate (31.9).

ABOUT JACK										

-Leiter was drafted in the first round (No. 2 overall) in 2021 by the Rangers out of Vanderbilt University. With the Commodores, Leiter was a unanimous First Team All-American and a finalist for both the Golden Spikes Award and the Dick Howser Trophy.

-Threw first regular-season, complete-game no-hitter to start SEC play since 1971 against No.16 South Carolina on March 20th, 2021. He walked the first batter of the game before retiring the last 27 he saw with 16 strikeouts on 124 pitches. Followed up that no-hitter with 7.0 no-hit innings in his next start (20.2 consecutive no-hit innings over three starts from March 20th - April 2nd).

-Drafted in 20th round in 2019 by NYY out of Delbarton School (NJ). Named 2019 New Jersey Gatorade POY, striking out 95 in 57 innings as a senior.

-The family lineage is strong with Jack. His father, Al, pitched in 19 MLB seasons (1987-2005), making two All-Star teams and winning both the 1993 and 1997 World Series. His uncle, Mark, played 11 seasons in the majors (1990-99; 2001) and his cousin, Mark Jr., pitched two seasons (2017-2018) with Philadelphia and Toronto. Al now works as an analyst for MLB Network.

2022 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2022 season as the No. 17 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com. He is listed as the No.1 prospect in the Rangers organization as well.

-Leiter dazzeled in his professional debut, striking out seven over his three innings against the Arkansas Travelers on April 9th. The righty helped draw the largest crowd since 2019 at Riders Field for the debut (9,322).

2021 SEASON

-After being drafted second overall in the 2021 draft, Leiter did not pitch in the minor leagues. Instead, he returned to Vanderbilt to workout, continue college and prepare for 2022. Did not finish degree, but got closer.

MORE INFO

-Leiter was high school teammates with Yankees No. 1 prospect (No. 8 in baseball) Anthony Volpe at Delbarton School (NJ).

ABOUT COLE						

-Selected by the Rangers with the 30th overall pick in the 2016 draft. Highest high school lefty taken by the Rangers since they took Matt Purke with the 14th overall pick in 2009 (Purke did not sign). Before that, Kasey Kiker, who was selected with the 12th-overall pick in 2006 was the highest drafted high school lefty by Texas.

-Originally committed to Florida State University before being drafted, Ragans was ranked as the 12th-best high school pitcher in the draft and the 6th-best left hander by Baseball America.

-At North Florida Christian High School, was 9-2 as a senior with a 0.90 ERA. He struck out 104 batters over 90.0 innings while holding opponents to a .122 batting average.

-Ragans studied and modeled his game after Cole Hamels. After being drafted by the Rangers, Hamels, who was a member of the Rangers at the time, took Ragans under his wing. He shadowed him for an entire day, following him around during 2017 Spring Training and learned everything he could from him. Most of all, he learned about what it took on the mental side to be a starting pitche. When he was first promoted to Frisco in July of 2021, Hamels happened to be throwing a bullpen for scouts at Riders Field and Ragans had the opportunity to reconnect with the veteran lefty.

-Ragans was selected to play in the 2021 All-Star Futures Game in Denver, along with teammate RHP Cole Winn. After receiving that news, he was informed a few days later that he would join the RoughRiders and be promoted to Double-A right after the game. He called it, "an unbelievable moment given what he had been through." He enjoyed the emotional moment with his wife over the phone.

2022 SEASON

-Struck out seven over 3.1 innings in 2022 debut on April 10th.

2021 SEASON

-Started the season with High-A Hickory, going 1-1 with a 2.50 ERA over his last four starts (18.0 IP, 14 H, 5 R, 5 ER, 6 BB, 21 K) before being promoted to Double-A Frisco.

-Made Double-A debut in relief on July 18th against Springfield, allowing three runs over two innings of work.

2020 SEASON

-Made return from injury in Fall Developmental League, throwing 13.0 innings, striking out 20 while walking eight. Owned a 38 percent strikeout rate.

2019 SEASON

-Missed season due to second 'Tommy John' surgery.

2018 SEASON

-Missed season due to first 'Tommy John' surgery.

2017 SEASON

-Dominated Short-Season Low-A Spokane, leading the league with 87 strikeouts, and was tabbed as the No. 1 prospect in the Northwest League by *Baseball America*.
