### RIDERS WIN ON JULY FOURTH IN FRONT OF RECORD CROWD:

The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the Arkansas Travelers 7-6 on Thursday evening from Riders Field. Frisco (6-4, 50-29) erupted for six runs in the bottom of the first inning in front of the second-largest crowd in franchise history (12,051), notching five hits as they sent 10 batters to the plate against Arkansas (6-4, 42-36) starter Reid VanScoter (4-7). Josh Hatcher delivered the first run, plating **Alejandro Osuna** with an RBI triple. **Aaron Zavala** gave the Riders a 3-0 lead with a two-run single before **Maximo Acosta** doubled to bring Zavala across the plate. **Cooper Johnson** drove in a pair of runs with a single to left center before the RoughRiders advantage to 6-0. **Nick Krauth** cruised through the first two frames, but surrendered a run in the top of the third when Cole Young roped an RBI double to put the Travelers on the board, 6-1. The Riders got that run back in the bottom of the fourth inning when Hatcher pushed a perfect bunt down the third base line, allowing Johnson to score to make it a 7-1 lead for Frisco. In the top of the fifth, the Travelers notched four consecutive hits against Krauth. Brock Rodden provided an RBI single before scoring on a double by Alberto Rodriguez. Victor Labrada capped off the inning with a single, bringing the score to 7-4 and chasing Krauth from the game. **Skylar Hales** (3-0) worked 1.2 one-hit frames before handing the ball to **Robby Ahlstrom** who spun a scoreless seventh inning. Arkansas cut the Riders lead to 7-5 with an RBI single from Rodden in the eighth. They were able to get the game within one when Kaden Polcovich grounded into a fielder's choice that brought Hogan Windish across the plate. Owens worked out of the jam, earning his team-leading sixth save of the season while allowing two runs on three hits across 2.0 innings. Offensively, Hatcher and Johnson each snagged multi-hit performances. Hatcher, Zavala and Johnson all recorded two RBI in the win. With their win tonight, the RoughRiders became the first Double-A team to reach 50 wins and just the fourth in all of minor league baseball to do so this season.

### HAPPY FOURTH:

The Riders beat 7-6 Arkansas last night for the Fourth of July, hosting an Independence Day game for the 12th time in their 21 years as a franchise. The Riders are now 14-7 on Fourth of July, that was their sixth game against the Travelers on the Fourth of July in franchise history, most of any team in the Texas League. The 12,051 fans in attendance was the second-largest crowd in franchise history and their largest July 4th crowd.

### I WANT TO BREAK FREE(MAN):

**Cody Freeman** blasted a go-ahead home run in the seventh on Friday, giving him the team lead with nine this year. While he slowed down slightly at the plate in June (batting .253/.298/.437/.735), he has clubbed three home runs in his last 10 games with two of them being game-winners and drove in the only runs that the Riders scored on July 3rd with a two-run double in the first. This season, he has a career highs in average (.272), slugging percentage (.452) and OPS (.778) while being on pace to set new career bests in RBIs (62) and home runs (16).

### DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The Riders have the second-fewest errors in all of Minor League Baseball (46) while also ranking third in fielding percentage (.983) in the minors. Frisco's 79 double plays are tied for the most in the Texas League, second among non-Triple-A teams and ninth in all of Minor League Baseball. Frisco have allowed the third-fewest stolen bases in MiLB (56), throwing out 29 percent of total base runners against them.

### THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen has been the best in the Texas League this season, owning a 2.87 ERA, which is also the second-best in all of Minor League Baseball. In their last nine games, the bullpen has a 2.35 ERA (10ER/38.1IP). In their last five series, spanning 35 games, Frisco's bullpen has a 1.88 ERA (27ER/129.0IP). In June, **Steven Jennings** was fantastic, only surrendering two runs over his nine outings, throwing 18.1 innings (0.98 ERA).

### FIRING BLANKS:

In their last 25 games, the Riders have allowed just 67 earned runs over 229.1 IP (2.62 ERA). On Saturday, the Riders allowed seven runs (six earned) for the first time in 12 games (8 allowed on 6/5 at CC). Frisco has not allowed double-digit runs in 34 games (5/23 vs. MID). In their last 37 games, the Riders have allowed more than three runs in a game just 13 times and 10 times in the last 25 games.

### HICKS IS THE PICK:

**Liam Hicks** has been on fire at the plate for the Riders over his last 40 games, batting .304 (42-for-138)/.411/.420/.831 with seven doubles, three home runs, 18 RBIs, 19 walks, 20 strikeouts and 25 runs. In June (21 games), he hit .333 (25-for-75)/.440/.520/.960 with five doubles, three home runs and 11 RBIs, reaching in all but three games in the month. He paced the Texas League in BA (.333) and OPS (.960) in June. Two Fridays ago in Corpus Christi, Hicks collected two home runs for his first multi-home run game of his Minor League career.

### WE'RE GOING DANCING:

Tuesday marked the first day of the second half. After a Midland loss on two Sundays ago, the RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

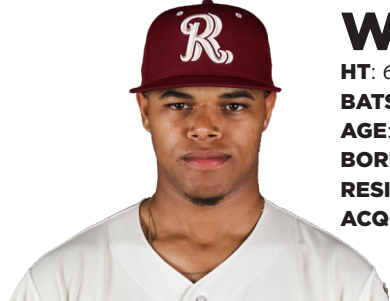

- Signed by Rangers for \$10,000 in 2019.
- Worked on increasing his fastball velocity from the low 90s when he signed. He spent the fall of 2023 at the Rangers spring training facility and working out in the biomechanics' lab where the velocity was up to 99 mph.
- Looking to become the first player born in Payita to make MLB debut.

### 2024 SEASON

- After the graduation of Wyatt Langford from MLB Pipeline's Rangers Top 30, Santos went from unranked to No. 15.
- Named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week on April 23rd after striking out 12 in 5.0 scoreless innings during 5-3 win over Greensboro on April 19th.
- Owned 0.44 ERA over four April starts, striking out 31 over 20.2 IP to just seven walks.
- After striking out just 19.9% of batters in 2023, he recorded a 30.5% K-rate with Hickory in 2024.
